All stakes will be walking. Judges and bird planters will be on horseback and/or ATV's.

Participants must be on time at the line with their dogs for their braces – five-minute rule applies.

COURSES AND BIRDS

Quail, chukar, pigeons and/or pheasants will be released in all stakes except Open Puppy. All stakes are single course without a bird field. Horseback handling will NOT be permitted in all stakes. A blank cartridge will be fired in all stakes except Open Puppy. **All stakes are non-retrieving.**

SCRATCH POLICY AFTER CLOSING DATE

Entries will be refunded in full only for dogs that have an injury or illness that prevents running in the registered stake or that are deceased prior to running in the registered stake. Club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate.

Camping with electrical hookups: Available at the Yellowstone Drag Race parking lot near the trial site. Cost \$30.00. Restrooms may/may not be available depending on the weather. Fill out the MEAL/CAMPING form below to reserve a spot.

Fire prevention: bucket, shovel, water, and fire extinguisher: recommended for each vehicle.

Hotels: There are many hotels in the Billings, MT area. **Reserve your room early!**

Racetrack Trial Grounds: Respect this public land! We appreciate your participation in keeping the grounds clean. We ask that all participants park and camp in designated areas. Only the host Club shall be allowed to operate motor vehicles and ATVs within the course limits.

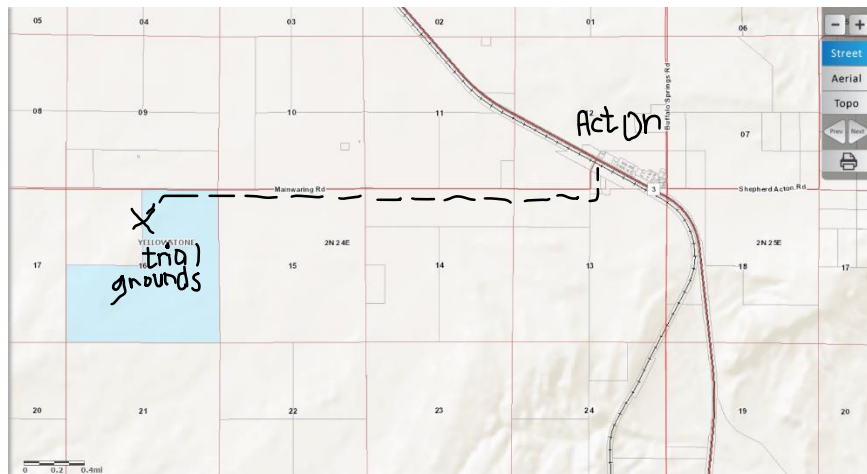

Directions to Racetrack Trial Grounds: From I-90 in Billings take the 27th St. exit. Turn north onto 27th St. and follow it to the top of the hill heading towards the Billings airport. At the top of the hill, you will hit a round-about. Go left through the round-about onto Highway 3 towards (Broadview) and Acton. Acton is about 14 miles northwest of Billings. At the small town of Acton, turn left onto Mainwaring Rd. Go about 3 miles west and follow the signs to the trial grounds on the left. If you get to the Yellowstone Drag Strip gate, you have gone too far. **Map: The trial grounds are on the blue (State Land). Section 16, R2N, T24E. Waypoint: 45.92606, -108.74489**



Cell Phone Service: Is marginal/poor at the trial site.
