Allamuchy Valley Luke Dead



Allamuchy Valley Luke, grand old man of the Brittany world succumbed to old age in June. He was twelve years old, having been whelped in this country on August 17, 1937 from a mating that took place in France. Luke, like Koer de Cornouaille and Jeffrey de Klemanor, two other old timers, had the misfortune of living and winning in the early days before field trials carried championship points. However, to those who knew them, they were true champions.

Luke's owner and constant companion, Howard Clements of Chicago, is offering an "Allamuchy Valley Luke Memorial Trophy," to be won three times for permanent possession. This trophy was offered for the first time at the Illinois trial on October 22, and will be in competition each year until won outright.

Second Brittany Spaniel Futurity Run On Native Quail in Illinois

Carbondale, Illinois was the grand site of the Second Annual American Brittany Club Brittany Spaniel Futurity on Friday, October 21.

The trial was run over the Crab Orchard Federal Wildlife Refuge, located in Williamson County about ten miles east of Carbondale, Illinois. These grounds are controlled by the local Crab Orchard Field Trial Club, who so graciously offered us the use of the club house and the courses, sixteen in number, which are well marked and so arranged that the judges, trainers and dogs can continue brace after brace without loss of time, starting and ending in the morning and again in the afternoon at the club house.

During the war years, this huge tract of land and its many installations constituted the Illinois Ordiance Plant. Approximately 66,000 acres were in the original grant set aside for this wartime purpose, and after the war was over, the present members and officers of the Crab Orchard Field Trial Club, seeing the immense possibilities this area offered for field trials and as a refuge for upland game and migratory birds, made a determined effort that both the land and water should be set aside for that purpose.

This Crab Orchard Refuge, as it is now called, was originally acquired by the Department of Interior as a refuge for ducks and geese, and was immediately placed under the direct supervision of the Fish and Wildlife Service. A short time later, the Fish and Wildlife Service realizing that the natural features of this area favored the propagation of quail, have worked with the members of the Crab Orchard Field Trial Club in carring out investigations and experiments for improved propagation.

Quoting from a recent issue of AMERICAN FIELD describing these grounds: "The 23,000 acres of actual preserve embrace one of the finest potential trial grounds this country boasts. Picture, if you can, an area of the mentioned immensity, where wildlife has full sway; where one-third of a bountiful harvest each year is left in the field to feed upland game and migratory birds; where lespedeza grows so luxuriantly it actually carpets hundreds of acres; where other natural foods and cover are found in superabundance; where skilled technicans are bending every effort, exercising every skill and knowledge in the rearing and propagation of quail. Then, frame that picture inside a cyclone fence with entrances and exits carefully guarded 24 hours a day by a cordon of watchmen, with lookout towers and two-way radio-equipped

The drawing was held at the Franklin Hotel, Carbondale, Illinois on the night before the running, Thursday, October 20, at 9 P. M. The members of the Crab Orchard Club, under the leadership of President Tom Mofield, R. A. Scott,

Reid Trautman and W. A. Brandon, were most gracious hosts.

Of the 37 dogs eligible, only 20 were drawn to run. Both the original entry and number of final starters were under last years figures of 42 entries and 33 starters.

Paul Dawson of Garden City, Michigan and James Tallmadge of Jeromesville, Ohio, well known as judges of pointing dog trials, occupied the judicial saddle. In spite of the inclement weather, they followed each brace with intense interest in each contestant, and their decisions had the unanimous approval of all present.

W. A. Brandon of the Crab Orchard Club acted as Marshal and was most helpful in unraveling the skein of the continuous courses. John Lee, Bill Kull, Walter Kleeman and Jack Whitworth helping out as needed. Kull in particular, proved to be a most able dog-getterupper and no time was lost.

While, unfortunately, heavy rainfall during the preceding week and most of the day of the running undoubtedly deterred most of the dogs in their work, the judges were well pleased with the class of the derby entrants under the conditions at the time of the trial. Having had no frost in southern Illinois, the cover was exceedingly heavy; but the little Brittany kept boring in to produce most pleasing races. At one time during the day, due to the torrential downpour, it was necessary to stop the running for more than an hour, causing one brace of dogs to start twice.

As is true in all continuous course trials, run on native game, some courses were better than others. Some had an abundance of game and others practically barren. Some courses were very difficult for dogs and handlers and one in particular was as smoothe as a golf course.

The 16 courses were designed for horse back running and not too well suited for a foot dog trial. No braces were able to complete the course within the time limit and many were picked up around the half way mark, perhaps missing the best part of the course. The least that can be said is conditions are never uniform in continuous course trials, even tho the trial is run in such a perfect setting as this.

The Running

- Ist Brace—Patsy of Edough—Stop of Paradise.

 Both started slow due to heavy cover with Patsy soon taking the outside. She found one covey of quail, handled in derby fashion and continued strong the balane of the heat. Stop, while looking good at times, had a tendency to swing to rear. Three contacts with game, nothing definite developing.
- 2nd Brace—Ashurst Jerry—Sioux Bee, Jr. Both fair ground heats with Jerry on the outside. Sioux being a bit friendly at times. Neither dog contacted game.
- 3rd Brace—Loufel's Handsome Harry—Wrangler of Richmont. Harry broke away strong and utilized open course to good advantage, but

- seemed inclined to seek easy footing at times. Wrangler, while looking good at start, had nothing left at finish. Both dogs failed to contact game.
- 4th Brace—Paw Paw's Toffee—Buccaneer de Klemanor. Both fair ground heats on heavy course. Paw Paw pointed tentatively, birds flushing to rear of dog while dog still in motion. Buccaneer's handler had a beautiful find on two quail, displaying perfect manners at opposing handler's shot.
- 5th Brace—Allamuchy Valley Slim—Brown June of Paradise. Slim, exceptionally good ground covering heat in driving rain. One definite point on covey of quail along hedge row, styling up beautifully, chasing boldly at shot, continuing strong to finish. June, not taking to well to adverse weather conditions, seemed to weaken in middle of heat and not much left at finish.
- 6th Brace—Chow Chow Toffee—Cherrystone Jerry
 Jerry, very restricted in range. Toffee, fair,
 but not responding too well to handler. No
 birds contacted by either dog.
- 7th Brace—Pontac Trena—Doc's Duc de Lafayette.

 Doc ran a slashing, strong and bold ground heat, pointing far to right, nothing resulting.

 Later, finding covey, chasing at shot. Trena, more restricted, but hunted hard all the way.

 Found and chased remaining singles in brace mate's covey. Later over-ran covey at finish.
- 8th Brace—Ashurst Bonnie—Momentum. Both showing good range considering heavy cover, with Momentum literally a ball of fire and hunting hard all the way. Made game along railroad bed, snapping into point as covey flushed. Bonnie, although as wide as brace mate, showed traces of sociability. No finds.
- 9th Brace—Allamuchy Valley Winnie—Sans Souci of Leeway. Both dogs very restricted in range on a heavy course. Sans had one good find and was steady to shot and wing. Winnie, failed to impress on this occasion.
- 10th Brace—Busher de Klemanor—Frank's Laddie Boy. Both dogs ran very good races with Laddie Boy a little inconsistent at times. Both dogs failed to take advantage of birds ridden up on course.

TOP FIELD WINNERS AND PRODUCING BRITTANY SPANIELS

of

1947-1948 and Spring of 1949

This chart is patterned after the one that appeared in the American Field. However, it is by no means a copy. This one was compiled from the records of Brittany Field & Bench, and is, we hope, complete in every detail. We found in checking the American Field chart that at least three Brittany trials were not included. This no doubt was due to the failure of the Field Trial Secretaries not sending in reports of their trial to the American Field, which means they had no record of these trials.

Our chart covers all the Brittany Spaniel A.K.C. Licensed (championship point) Trials run during 1947, 1948 and the spring of 1949. We have not included Amateur Stakes, Sanctioned Stakes or wins made in Pointer and Setter Shooting Dog Stakes. Only such wins as were made in a recognized Brittany trial are shown in this chart.

The chart is easily understood after a few minutes are spent in study. As an example, column 1, gives the name of dog in (CAPITAL LETTERS) and name of owner in (Small letters). Column 2, gives the name of Sire and Dam. Columns 3, 4, 5 and 6, show the type of stake in which the wins were made (upper figures are the number of wins made by the dog named in

column 1——lower figures are the wins of his or her progeny made in the stakes as indicated). Columns 8, 9, 10 and 11, show the number of first, second, third and fourth place wins of both the dog and his progeny. Again the upper figures represent the dog and lower figures the progeny.

The facing page shows the breeding combinations that produced these winners. The dogs name is given first (CAPITAL LETTERS). Then the name of the dog he or she was mated to (also CAPITAL LETTERS). Under that is shown the names of the progeny they produced (in small letters). If the dog produced from more than one mate, the next mate and progeny follow in the same order.

We feel these records can be of tremendous help to Brittany breeders. Naturally, we all know that it is not essential for a stud or a bitch to have a record of wins before they can produce good progeny. But we must not forget the fact that the dog who has won, has proven that he has winning qualifications. And if that dog or bitch has produced offspring that also won, we do know he or she is passing it down to their puppies. Those two facts alone will eliminate a great deal of the guess work in breeding better Brittanies.

How Many Real Champions????

We continually receive letters from members asking about Brittany Show Champions. They want to know how many are real champions and how many are "cheese champions". That is something no one can answer. We saw in last issue that 564 Brittanies were entered in shows and 13 completed championships. There is no way to tell how many of these dogs are

really outstanding and how many are merely the best dog owned by an individual breeder.

At every show there has to be a winner, and just how good that winner has to be depends entirely upon how good the competition at that show happens to be.

Some dogs have completed show championships by defeating only their own kennel mates.

The requirements for a championship are that (continued on page 21)

How Many Real Champions????

a dog must win 15 points and not less than 6 of those points must be won in two 3 point or better shows, under different judges and some one or more points won under another judge. But the dogs can be the same group of dogs all the way through. The number of points awarded the winner is based upon the number of dogs shown. In Brittanies, if two dogs of the same sex are shown, the winner receives 1 point; three dogs 2 points; four dogs 3 points; the dogs 4 points; fourteen dogs 5 points. A dog can become a champion by defeating three of his kennel mates in five different shows.


Some people call him a "cheese champion", perhaps he is, but at least he has to be good enough to beat those three dogs five times under different judges. A dog would have to be better than average to do that. Even when top dogs are judged against each other, not all judges agree, and any dog that completes a championship, even if against his own kennel mates, has to be a pretty fair dog, or five or six judges will not put him up.

The fault does not lie with these breeders who are showing their dogs, it lies with you for letting them get away with it. If you have a better dog then all you have to do is show it and stop this man from making a champion out of his inferior dog.

Brittanies are no different than other new breeds. At first not many are entered in shows and championships are easy. Later as the breed becomes more popular, it gets tougher. However, for the past seven years Brittany owners and breeders have had a way in which they could prove and test their champions, as well as their dogs. By that I mean the Annual Specialty Show. Here you will find all the competition you need.

To Train For

Field Trials and Shooting Dogs

Have trained pointers and setters for a number of years and enjoyed considerable success on the field trial circuit. This year, I tried out a few Brittanies and was greatly impressed with their possibilities. Would like a full string this winter to get ready for the spring trials. Puppy and Derby Stakes Get Points—Why Not Amateur???

As most of you know 1949 will be my last year as Secretary of the American Brittany Club.

During the seven years I have been in office the club has grown from 16 members to over 400. Of that, all the directors and former officers should feel very proud.

However, I regret one thing, and that is, we were not able to get the new field trial rules approved by A.K.C., which would have given us points for our Amateur Stake.

Various reasons have been given as to why A.K.C. would not approve these rules. My own guess is the reasons were:

- The rules were too long and too many hard to enforce details. Just too much red tape that didn't mean anything.
- Certain members and officers did not want Amateur Stakes to carry championship points, and they managed to let this become known to A.K.C.

Frankly, I think those who have tried to fight the Amateur Stake have not bothered to find out the score.

In the first place the club has little to offer the "little-one-dog-owner", and the success or failure of the club lies in these members, who cannot afford to spend hundreds of dollars a year with professional handlers. If we want them as members, then lets give them something for their money. Let's give them a trial in which an ordinary working man has a chance to win. A trial in which professional handlers are barred, and in which championship points may be won.

We give points to puppies and derbies, why not amateur handlers.

Why Not Points For Amateurs'??

We are not asking for Amateur Champions, we only ask that the winners receive points to apply toward a championship, the same as puppies and derbies receive. A dog would still be required to win in OPEN all-age stakes before he could become a champion.

The following amendment to A.K.C. rules, would in my opinion be fair to the amateur, the professional and to the wealthy kennel owner alike. I say we can get it approved if we stop fighting and present it as a decision of all the club members, for the good of the club.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT APPLYING TO A. K. C. RULES, CHAPTER 13, SECTION 2.

RECOGNIZED STAKES

Open Puppy Stakes

Puppy Stakes shall be open to any Brittany Spaniel not exceeding eighteen months of age. Age calculated up to and inclusive of the day advertised for running the stake.

Open Derby Stake

Derby Stakes shall be open to any Brittany Spaniel not exceeding thirty months of age. Age calculated up to and inclusive of the day advertised for running the stake.

Open All-age Stake

Open All-age Stakes shall be open to any Brittany Spaniel of any age.

Amateur Handler's All-age Stake

Amateur Handler's All-age Stakes shall be open only to amateur handlers, but open to any Brittany Spaniel of any age. An amateur is any person who has never received, either directly or indirectly, compensation for training or handling field dogs, and has not accepted any prizes, or other valuable considerations for handling dogs other than his own in field trials.

Shooting stakes

Shooting Stakes may be open or amateur. Rules shall be as required for each specific stake, except birds must be shot and dogs shall be required to retrieve.

Championship

Brittany Spaniels shall become field trial champions of record after having won 15 points at field trials of member clubs of The American Kennel Club or at field trials of non-member clubs licensed by the American Kennel Club to hold field trials. Of the required 15 points, 6 or more points must be won as a FIRST PLACE winner in two different 3-point or better OPEN ALL-AGE STAKES. Points shall count in all recognized stakes, but only two may be used from puppy stakes.

A second place winner in an all-age stake shall be credited with 1 point in a 3-point stake; 2 points in a 4-point stake; and 3 points in a 5-point stake. A third place winner in an all-age stake shall be credited with 1 point in a 4-point stake; and 2 points in a 5-point stake.

The number of points toward a field trial championship to be credited to the winning dogs shall be based on the actual number of dogs competing in that stake, according to the schedule of points determined by the Board of Directors of The American Kennel Club.


