TOP SHOW WINNERS AND PRODUCING BRITTANY SPANIELS

of the

Eight American Brittany Clubs' Specialty Shows From 1943 to 1949

Compiled By Jack Whitworth

The following charts show every award made to a Brittany spaniel in the eight Specialty Shows sponsored by the American Brittany Club from 1943 to 1949 inclusive. Breeding and combinations of blood lines that produced winning progeny are shown.

The charts are easily understood after a few minutes are spent in study. The name of the dog and owner are shown in column 1. Sire and dam in column 2. Columns 3 to 11 show the wins of the dog in upper figures and wins of progeny in lower figures. Column 12 shows the total number of dogs defeated by the dog and by his or her progeny. In all cases the upper figures represent the dog named in column 1, and the lower figures represent the progeny of that dog. When no upper figures are shown, the dog had no wins. When no lower figures are shown, the progeny had no wins.

The facing pages show the breeding combinations or families that produced these winners.

The name of the dog is shown first (CAPITAL LETTERS). Next comes the name of the dog he or she was mated to (also CAPITAL LETTERS). Under that is shown the names of any winning progeny they produced (in small letters). If the dog produced with more than one mate, the next mate and progeny produced follow in the same order.

Naturally, all the Brittany spaniels in the country are not represented in these charts, since all were not entered in these shows. But just about all the blood lines are represented. Quite a number of champions are missing. Some were entered and didn't place. Others were owned by people residing in distant parts of the country who found it impossible to attend these shows. However, it is safe to say that any dog who has produced outstanding progeny, be it north, south, east or west, have some of their sons and daughters represented in these charts.

In case all our readers are not familiar with the workings of shows, we will explain briefly, that a dog is first shown in a class. Each sex has six classes: Puppy—6 to 9, Puppy—9 to 12, Novice, American Bred, Limit and Open. Males are always judged first and each class is judged separately. The judge places the dogs 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each class as he rates them until all six classes have been judged. Then the winners of each of the six classes compete against each other for what is called "Winners." Only undefeated dogs compete for winners. Defeated dogs are eliminated. After the judge has selected his "Winners Male," the next best male is called "Reserve Winners Male," which means second place, or runner-up. The same procedure then

takes place with females until a "Winners Female" and "Reserve Winners Female" are selected. Both the "Winners Male" and "Winners Female" are awarded championship points based on the number of dogs they defeated, as already explained in the September, 1949, issue of this magazine.

The "Winners Male" and "Winners Female" then compete against each other for what is called "Best of Winners," or the right to compete for Best of Breed or Best Dog in Show.

Champions are usually entered in a class called "Specials." Since they are already champions, they have no need of the championship points, so compete only against the other champions and the one dog that defeated all the other class dogs. However, if an owner so desires, he can enter his champion in the open class.

From the "Specials" class and the "Best of Winners Dog," one dog is selected as "Best Dog in Show" and the best dog of the opposite sex is selected as "Best of Opposite Sex." If a male is selected as "Best in Show," the best female is naturally the "Best of Opposite Sex," or vice versa. The dog defeated for Best of Winners can compete for Best of Opposite Sex but not for Best in Show, due to having been defeated.

The winners of the two puppy classes (dogs not over 12 months of age) in males and females compete for "Best Puppy in Show."

All the placings of the dogs from 4th in a class to Best in Show are shown in these charts. If they produced puppies that placed, that too is shown. About the only thing impossible to show was the names of dogs these winners defeated. This is important because we all know there are times when a dog may place fourth yet actually defeat better dogs than another dog did by placing first in a different class.

The following is a brief history of the eight Specialty Shows:

The first show was held at Ravenna, Ohio, on November 27, 1943. Fifteen males and fourteen females were entered in the classes. No champions competed in Specials this first year, but Ch. Jeffrey de Klemanor was wrongly entered in American Bred class and disqualified.

The first judge was Mr. Jerome N. Halle of Cleveland, Ohio. He selected Patrice de Sharvoged as Winners Male, Best of Winners and Best Dog in Show. This win completed Patrice's championship. Winners Female and Best of Opposite Sex went to Madam Patricia, who later completed her championship in All-Breed shows,

then contacted distemper and died soon after. The Reserve Winners Male was Avono Jack of Karomish. Reserve Winners Female was Benedictine Mac Eochaidh, who later won a championship in All-Breed shows.

The second show was held at Cleveland, Ohio, on November 11, 1944. Thirteen males and twenty-four females were shown in the classes. Five champions, Ch. Patrice de Sharvogue, Ch. Benedictine Mac Eochaidh, Ch. Brit of Bellows Falls, Ch. Ogma Mac Eochaidh and Ch. Aotrou Mac Eochaidh were entered in Specials.

Mr. Ed. Dana Knight of Charleston, West Virginia, officiated as judge and selected Ch. Patrice de Sharvogue as Best Dog in Show. For Best of Opposite Sex, he selected Ch. Benedictine Mac Eochaidh, who was Reserve Winners Female in the first show. Benedictine was killed in an accident the following year.

Avono Happy was Winners Male and Best of Winners. Jule of Loufel was Winners Female. Jule completed her championship in All-Breed shows a short time later. Chasseur d'Oiseaux de Beauch was Reserve Winners Male and Best Puppy in Show. Reserve Winners Female was Allamuchy Yankee Girl who later won a championship in All-Breed shows.

The third show was held at Detroit, Michigan, on November 9, 1945. Twenty-one males and twenty-eight females competed in the classes. Three champions, Ch. Patrice de Sharvogue, Ch. Brit of Bellows Falls and Ch. Jule of Loufel competed in Specials.

Dr. Clyde Leeper of Cleveland, Ohio, judged the classes and winners. Mr. Maxwell Riddle of Ravenna, Ohio, judged Best in Show and Best of Opposite Sex. Mr. Riddle also selected Ch. Patrice de Sharvogue for Best in Show. This was Patrice's third consecutive Best in Show win. Ch. Jule of Loufel, who was Winners Female last (Continued on page 7)

year, was selected by Mr. Riddle as Best of Opposite Sex.

Dr. Leeper selected Avono Happy as Winners Male. This was Happy's second consecutive Winners win and he completed his championship a few months later in an All-Breed show. Tess of Chippewa was Winners Female and Best of Winners.

Duffy of Chippewa was Reserve Winners Male and Best Puppy in Show. He also later won his championship in All-Breed shows. Sorcha Mac Eochaidh was placed Reserve Winners Female, but this caused some confusion when it was later discovered that Gwennec's Fanchette had defeated her in the Open class.

The fourth show was held at Smithville, Ohio, on November 8, 1946. Twenty males and twenty-three females were entered in the classes.

Seven champions, Ch. Avono Happy, Ch. Angeliq de Bretagne, Dual Ch. Brit of Bellows Falls, Ch. Aotrou Mac Eochaidh, Ch. Jule of Loufel, Ch. Gold Flash and Ch. Duffy of Bellebrit competed in Specials.

By popular request, Mr. Jerome Halle, who judged the first show, was asked to officiate at this fourth one. This was the only time the same person judged two shows. He selected Ch. Avono Happy as Best Dog in Show and Ch. Angeliq de Bretagne as Best of Opposite Sex. Buck of Chippewa was Winners Male and Best of Winners. But the win was cancelled by A.K.C. when they found his date of birth had been omitted from the entry blank. The charts give Buck credit for this win because we felt Buck's punishment was a little too severe and so informed A.K.C. Buck later won a championship in All-Breed shows. Pepper of Loufel, who placed Reserve Winners Male that year, was awarded the points Buck lost and is also credited with the win in

the charts. Pepper too, soon completed his championship in All-Breed shows.

The Winners Female that year was Janey. She won other points in All-Breed shows, but was sold by her owner before completing a championship. Reserve Winners Female was Georgette of Leeway. Georges of Leeway, a litter mate to Georgette was selected as Best Puppy in Show.

The fifth show was held at Pontiac, Michigan, on November 28, 1947. Twenty-nine males and twenty-eight females were shown in the classes. Eight champions, Dual Ch. Aotrou Mac Eochaidh, Int. Ch. Fun Galore Chummie, Ch. Angeliqne de Bretagne, Ch. Longque de Bretagne, Dual Ch. Brit of Bellows Falls, Ch. Kaerson of Loufel and Ch. Mac of Paradise were entered in Specials.

Dr. George Andree of Rensselaer, Indiana, was the judge. He selected Avono Retta, a class dog, for Winners Female, Best of Winners and Best in Show. This was the first time a class dog had been placed over champions. It also was the first and only time a female won Best in Show.

Retta later completed her championship in All-Breed shows. Best of Opposite Sex went to Ch. Longque de Bretagne. Winners Male was Lucky de Rosevere. Best Puppy in Show was Jessica of Pasatrou. Reserve Winners Male was Spud V Rensselaer and Reserve Winners Female was Susan Lengelen.

The sixth show was held at Rensselaer, Indiana. Thirty-one males and twenty females were shown in the classes. Six champions, Dual Ch. Avono Happy, Ch. Avono Retta, Int. Ch. Diane de Beauch, Int. Ch. Fun Galore Chummie, Ch. Angeliqne de Bretagne and Ch. Kaerson of Loufel competed in Specials.

The sixth judge was Mr. A. W. Brockway of Chicago, Illinois. He selected Dual Ch. Avono Happy as Best Dog in Show and Int. Ch. Diane de Beauch as Best of Opposite Sex. Winners Male and Best of Winners was Ace of Bald Ridge. Buck's Allamuchy Julie was Winners Female. Reserve Winners Male and Best Puppy in Show was Potic II de Beauchamps. Reserve Winners Female was Buckeye de Klemanor who won her championship in All-Breed shows the following year.

Chummie, Ch. Suzanne de Beauch and Ch. Fun Galore Louella competed in Specials.

Monsieur Allaire selected Dual Ch. Avono Happy as Best Dog in Show. Allamuchy Valley Flo II, a class dog, was Winners Female and also Best of Opposite Sex over four female champions. Winners Male was Whit of Loufel. This win completed his championship. Reserve Winners Male was Allamuchy Valley Samba. Reserve Winners Female was Buck's Allamuchy Julie who was Winners Female in the last show.

Ch. Avono Happy was Winners Male in 1944 and 1945, and then never defeated in Specials after completing his championship. He too, had three consecutive Best in Shows. Patrice and Happy never met on equal terms due to a difference of over six years in age. By the time Happy reached his full prime, Patrice was beyond his.

The other two Best in Show dogs, Ch. Avono Retta, who won in 1947, and Ch. Tudor du Roc 'Hellou who won the last show. Both came up from the classes and each defeated eight champions for Best in Show.

It is interesting to note that the charts prove beyond all doubt that Kaer de Cornouaille was the greatest producing sire of all time. The chart of field winners that appeared in the September, 1949, issue of this magazine also proved him to be the greatest producer of field winners, which makes it of double interest to we Brittany breeders.

The two charts, the first a record of field winners and the second a record of show winners, show that a great many of the top producing sires and dams were the same dogs in both cases.

The value of these charts to Brittany breeders does not lie in the record of wins of the individual dogs, but rather in the records of the progeny they produced.

A great deal of breeding information is given in these charts. A careful study of these records can eliminate some of the guess work of breeding.

My records show that fifty-two Brittany spaniels were imported and that almost one hundred have won championships. But the fact they were imported or the fact they have champion in front of their names does not necessarily mean they are producers of good progeny.

These charts enable the smart breeders to look back and find out something about the parents of their contemplated litter of puppies. They can learn what breeding combinations have produced

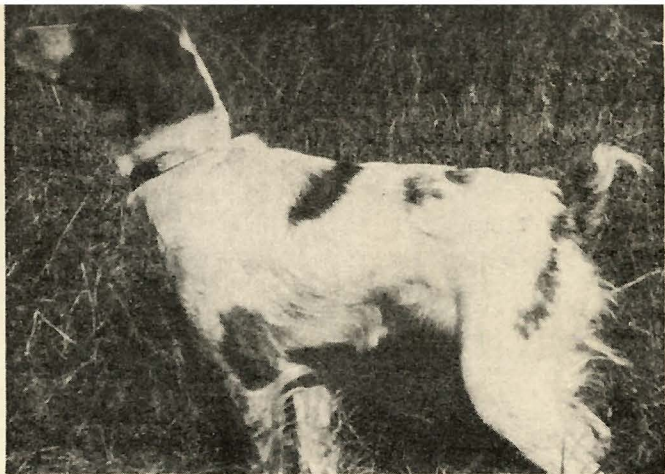
winner and which lines have failed to produce.

Far too many of our Brittany owners represent themselves as breeders, when actually, they are only managers of harmful puppy factories. They purchase a bitch or two and with no thought and study as to a proper mate, began breeding and peddling worthless puppies. It is not accidental when a few breeders continue to produce champion after champion, while others have

failed to produce even one champion of which they are the breeder.

I do not claim that your bitch will produce winners if mated to the best sire represented in these charts, nor do I claim that the best producing bitch shown in these charts will produce from your stud. I am only trying to show that certain dogs and certain families have produced winning progeny, while other dogs and other breeding combinations definitely have not produced as well.

We can only play the percentages and these charts can help us find the highest odds.

OHIO BRITTANY CLUB'S SPRING FIELD TRIAL

Ohio Entry Breaks All Records For An All-Brittany Field Trial With Almost One Hundred Dogs Competing

With 98 dogs entered the Ohio Brittany Club held the largest Brittany trial ever held in America on Saturday and Sunday, April 1 and 2, at the Ravenna Arsenal grounds, Ravenna, Ohio.

Judges were Mr. Cal Barry of Wayland, Ohio, and Mr. Hugo Blasberg of Hawthorne, New Jersey, and their decisions were given after careful consideration and received with evident approval. They kept things moving, losing little time between braces, riding steadily despite adverse weather.

A great deal of credit for a successful trial must go to a couple of our Ohio lady members, Mrs. Mima Millar, who carried the load of secretary, and Mrs. Lee Gaebelein who gave her plenty of help. Harold Reed, chairman of the Field Trial committee, and Field Marshal Lee Gaebelein also found plenty to do in getting 98 dogs run in two days.

Conditions ranged from cool, crisp, clear weather to cold driving rain within the first half day, then seemed to become more settled for the balance of the two day trial. Sunday was fair and mild.

The enormous entry along with the grand site, the very good accommodations, the hospitality extended by the Arsenal personnel, and the hard work of the field trial committee made it a trial to be long remembered. The drawing was held at the Ravenna Hotel on Friday evening with a very large group present and early Saturday morning found handlers, judges and a surprisingly large group of spectators on hand.

The grounds were only a short distance from the hotel and the 25,000 acres of rolling country

afforded cover of every kind. It has been a game refuge for years, completely fenced in and game of all kinds was plentiful, particularly rabbits. The one course trial laid out in a horse shoe pattern for the puppies, was later extended into more of an "S" shape for the other stakes with scarce waist-high weeds at the breakaway leading toward the first draw where ground grass became heavier and the return trip towards the bird field had a considerable amount of briars. These Ravenna grounds offer one of the finest potential field trial courses to be found in this section of the country, but it was believed by the committee and those present that a much better course can be laid out for future trials.

George Millar, husband of the secretary, also deserves a large bouquet of flowers for the way in which he made visitors feel welcome and helped strangers become acquainted with the rest of the gang.

PUPPY STAKE

The Puppy Stake with 29 entries led off on Saturday morning. No birds were released for the puppies which I am afraid was a rather poor decision on the part of the Ohio club. Now that age limits have been raised to 18 months, bird work will become a very important part of this stake. If the clubs cannot afford to release pheasants for a \$5.00 entry fee, the fee must be raised so that birds can be planted.

The pups in this case, however, did very well without birds and many of them drew favorable comments from the judges and gallery.

The nod for first place went to Remarkable de Fontaine Vallee, owned by David Clough and handled by Ralph (Buck) Bissell. Remarkable broke away hard and fast, driving steadily all the way, with plenty of range, always going ahead, had a flash point on a rabbit, then turned and went hunting.

Second place went to Mac, handled by his owner Ernest Dickson, with long independent casts to objectives in which he was searching all the time and clearly indicating he was hunting.

My Gracious, owned by Olive Baebelin, handled by Q. L. (Pat) Watts, was placed third. Her pep and style of movement was beautiful to

see. She hit every briar patch either going thru, under or over and merrily bounced over the ground, however her range was short compared to the other winners.

Meadowink Jim, owned by W. P. Yant and handled by Tom Cox, was fourth. He showed speed, independence, beautiful style and high head. The hardest running brace of pups was Belloaks Ezra, owned by J. P. Bell, Jr. and handled by Tom Cox, and Pierrot de Fontaine Vallee, owned and handled by Mrs. L. S. Clough. They cut the course in long casts and were going away at the finish. Rensselaer Sandy was nearly as wide and perhaps searched a bit more. Many others were worthy of praise in this large stake but space does not permit dwelling on each of them.

It was decided to run six braces of the Open All-Age Stake on Saturday to help out the time situation on Sunday when so many dogs were due to run. These braces, started at the close of the Puppy Stake. A large crowd enjoyed a delicious dinner at the commissary on the Arsenal grounds, under the supervision of Mr. Wince, who, I understand is placed there by the National Foods Concessions of Chicago, Ill. Our hosts, Colonel James W. Freeman, Major James H. Kelley, Major Clifford Hathaway and Captain Edward S. Nilsson, of the Ravena Arsenal Staff, were introduced and thanked for their hospitality and kindness in granting us the use of the grounds. Using four of his own dogs, Cal Barry entertained with a short retriever act. This concluded the first day's activities.

The second day found the committee all set up to run two courses simultaneously, and Harold Reed and Tom Cox were pressed into service as judges for the Amateur Handlers Stake.

OPEN ALL-AGE STAKE

In the Open All-Age Stake first place went to Ch. Buckeye de Klemanor, owned by W. B. Kleeman and handled by Tom Cox. She was called

back for a short second series at the conclusion of the stake on Sunday, after running an outstanding ground heat Saturday afternoon in which she went birdless. In her second series, she ran without a brace mate, and the bird was planted in sight of the handler which caused a great deal of criticism from the gallery.

However, there was no question as to Buckeye earning the win. She made a very beautiful point quite a distance from the bird and did it without directions from her handler. Her head was high and style and manners perfect.

This win completed her dual championship, making her the first female and fourth dual champion in American history.

Second place was taken by Rem of Aotrou, owned by Dr. R. H. Young and handled by Bill Kull. Rem had an excellent find on a running bird which she pinned way out in front. Her manners were perfect all the way. Her race, although not as wide and fast as the winner, was thorough and acceptable.

Ch. Angeliqne de Bretagne, third place winner, owned and handled by L. L. Tice, had one good find with perfect manners. She had a second point but her handler could not produce the bird. A minute later she backed her brace mate who may have pinned her bird. Just before the take-up she again snapped on point, and as her handler threw up his hand calling point, she broke point and continued hunting.

Georges of Leeway, the fourth place dog, was owned and handled by John W. Lee. He had a medium searching race with a perfect find in the bird field. He was solid and tense on point, giving him the nod over Torchy of Lionheart, owned and handled by Marion F. Baker of Woodland, California. It was a pleasure to have Mr. Baker and his dog with us. Torchy was a merry, stylish worker with one find in the bird field, took one jump and was stopped by his handler. F.T. Ch. Avono Hapte, Ch. (B) Basbleu's Sandy of Loufel and Roger of Edough ran meritorious races but failed to score on game.

OPEN DERBY STAKE

The judges took very little time for lunch and changed horses to ride at once, so the stake of 24 derbies could be completed on Sunday. Competition was again keen with first place going to Frank's Laddie Boy owned by Frank Mowbray and handled by Lee Holman. Laddie Boy ran a wide searching race, hitting the outside with plenty of flash and style, had three finds and was steady on two of them.

Rem of Aotrou, the second place dog, was the same dog who won second in the All-Age. She had three good finds, two on the back course and one in the bird field, plus a stop to flush on a bird and a rabbit. While her bird work and manners were perfect, range and application were only fair for a derby.

Third place choice was Boots of Edough, owned by L. D. LaFleur and handled by Lee Holman. Boots ran a good hard race, had a very good find on a running bird, did not chase but turned to shot.

Fourth was Wippy de la Vallee Bourrauel, owned by R. R. Machlett and handled by Buck Bissell, with one find. Slow to start but gained all the way. Other derbies under consideration for their good ground work were Murph's Tom Boy, My Gracious, Bobbie of Marvan and Allamuchy Valley Wave.

AMATEUR HANDLERS ALL-AGE STAKE

The Amateur Stake is creating more and more interest, especially in Ohio, and without a doubt is going to be one of the popular stakes at all future trials. As noted before, a second course was set up for Sunday, because of the large entry for a two day trial. The Amateur Handlers Stake was being run on the second course throughout Sunday. Bird work was plentiful in

this stake and handlers and spectators seemed to enjoy it all immensely.

The winner was Ch. Avono Jake, owned and handled by D. L. Benjamin. Luke's Beau Fort, owned and handled by Howard Clements, was second. Domino de Klemanor, owned and handled by W. B. Kleeman, was third with Madam Duchess II, owned and handled by Raymond Baldrige, coming in fourth.

Many of the other dogs had very good ground heats in this stake and good finds in the bird field, but failure on the part of their handlers to produce the birds (later found by other dogs or ridden up by the judges) caused much ribbing and gay comment from the gallery and helped to provide the touch of fun in rivalry among good sports to make a perfect ending to a perfect two-day trial.

Maxwell Riddle Discusses New Dog Disease

Demands Action Against European Hard Pad Disease

American dog owners should begin punching at Congress, the Department of Agriculture and the American Veterinary Medical Association.

We need immediate protection from European hard pad disease, a usually fatal disease which has swept across Europe and Great Britain in a form hitherto unknown to dogdom.

The virulent form of the disease now has appeared here. We need special quarantine and isolation rules in America, and we need quarantine laws to prevent more cases from being imported to our dogs.

This department has urged such action before. Unless action is taken now, you can expect anguished cries from those in authority—as usual, after it is too late.

The way to prevent hard pad disease from killing our dogs is to prevent it from entering this country. We aren't doing that. Ten days ago at Fort Worth, Tex., six dogs died, apparently after exposure to a British import.

A form of hard pad disease apparently allied to distemper has been known for many years in this country, but relatively rare. The present epidemic in Europe is however of a somewhat different form and seems to have a much higher mortality rate.

British veterinarians first noticed the similarity in the early stages of the disease to distemper, but no distemper treatment was of any aid. Dogs which apparently had a solid lifetime immunity to distemper died quickly of hard pad disease.

So far, veterinarians have been unable to isolate the virus, explain how the disease is transmitted from dog to dog or even plot the incubation period.

We need, therefore, to set up quarantine stations at every American port of entry for Euro-

pean dogs. And we need similar action in Mexico and Canada. Until we know more about the disease, a quarantine period of four or more months should be required.

The British quarantine all dogs entering Great Britain for six months. So does Australia. Even American Army war dogs were quarantined.

Should we do less now in trying to protect ourselves from one of the deadliest diseases ever to afflict the world's dogs?

But it's a cinch we won't get any protection unless we prod the agencies mentioned above into action. If we don't get it, you can expect millions of American dogs to die of the disease in the next few years.
