



When we went to the line, the sun rode the eastern rim of the world in fiery splendor. Each stem and blade of grass glistened with dew. The air was cool, and the breaths of horses hung about us like smoke. It was a day to be alive.

The dog broke away well, took a look to see where were going, and made the long edge to the left in one fluid burst of speed. It swung to the right, searched a likely corner and then crossed to the front again, now to the left, running with drive and purpose. It hit the gap to the left front and went out of sight, and the hair began to rise on the back of the man's neck. The other dog had bulled away to the right from the start, with his handler hard after him. The man rode on toward the fence line gap alone, ahead of the rest of the party.

Through the gap was a weed field, with the ground rising gently to a ridge before dropping away to a level bottom land. The man came through the hedge line and saw the dog at once standing in the cover halfway up the slope, poker stiff, high head thrust forward and its eyes wide and glazed.

The man approached to within ten yards before he dismounted. He handed the reins up to the marshal, drew his pistol, and made the first brisk circle in the cover before the dog. No bird. He turned a wider circle and as he swung back, he saw that the dog had loosened and its eyes had come back into focus. Their eyes met and the dog's said clearly that the game was moving away on the ground. It wanted to relocate and said so by dropping its nose slightly and raising one foot. "You stay"

The man had just turned the far edge of the loop, fifty yards or so out, when suddenly two pheasant were in the air. He popped the pistol and walked back to the dog that stood there relaxed now but proud. As the man took its collar, he felt it surge forward, eager to be free. The man stroked it twice, said something no one else could hear, led it ahead a few yards and cast it away.

The dog cut up the cover immediately ahead in three quick slashes and piled off the ridge into the bottomland to the front. It was running hard now, trying to search the whole weed grown field rather than running an edge. With every stride water spun from its coat in a silver spray against the early morning sun.

Just then the other handler and his charge regained the front. Both dogs cleared a treeline gap to the right and disappeared in weedy cover. After two minutes the man asked his scout to ride the treeline paralleling the path to the left-no need to leave the dog there on point, he thought. But the dog soon showed to the front, crossing from left to right and digging into the edge of a slough, still running hard. It swung on to the front.

Moments later it hit a brushy field holding many objectives and for the first time its pattern began to suffer. The man did the best he could to get it straightened out, and had just succeeded when

the dog whirled to its right and in a moment stood as though carved from stone.

Again the ride to the point. No problem with flushing this time, however, for as the man approached the dog two pheasant rose from the cover before its stand. The dog acknowledged their flight by lifting its head slightly to watch them go. The man popped his pistol again and thought with relief that this time at least he did not need to run up the birds.

When the dog was sent on the other handler was well to the front, and the dog set out after him on the double. It did not like for anyone to ride before it, any time, any place. The two dogs hunted as a team then, for a minute or two, one to each side of the trail.

Then the most hazardous part of the course was approached. The path crossed a ditch, that to the right rapidly became a marsh and then a wooded swamp, edged with cattails all the way. It was a place for deer. The dog took that edge, well to the front, and vanished at once. When the man made the crossing he asked his scout to ride the swamp edge, then continued down the trail, that bore away from the swamp by about 45 degrees.

A minute or two went by, and the dog did not show. The man was singing to it now, and he put a new note of urgency into his call. He pleaded a bit, and commanded a bit. "Come out of there, little man," he was saying, in tone and emphasis if not in words. Still no dogs. The man could hear ducks rising from the hidden swamp. The call deepened and roughened as the man laid his voice far into the thicket. Suddenly the dog appeared, leaving the swamp, running for the front, showing some fatigue now but still striding with strength and purpose.

The dog went quickly to the front with the man loping his horse just behind. Once there the dog resumed a searching pattern, but some of the spark was gone now, and suddenly the man realized that this day he was not going to lose this dog. He could see the car gallery now, at the pick up point a quarter-of-a-mile to the front. Soon the marshal was beside him saying that time was up. It was just a few yards then to the dog wagon.

The man let out his first full breath in 30 minutes and took a look at the beautiful day all about him. The dog settled down in a strawfilled box, thinking whatever thoughts dogs think at times like these.

For half-an-hour the two had lived together in a very special world. (Reprinted from the American Brittany, Mar., 1974)

End note: the dog was field champion Kate's Elias Russ, the judge covering its bird work was Eugene Brown of Pontiac, Illinois, and the stake was the Illinois Brittany Club's open all age, in the fall of 1973, held at the Green River Conservation Area, in Bureau County. Some of the readers will be able to identify the course as the first half-hour of the morning, leading east from the club house, crossing Pump Factory Road and hooking back to it for the pick-up. Rusty was placed second in an entry of 35 dogs.

(I had the pleasure of spending an hour visiting with David when I was in St. Louis this week. We so enjoyed talking about some of the wonderful times we've had over the years with our friends at field trials. I told David I was enjoying typing his stories for the magazine as he paints a picture that comes to life in my mind's eye. On one of his tables he has a cover of the ABC Magazine framed. It is a hunting scene as he so often took snapshots on his hunting outings. He reminded me to always remember and make sure others remember that the Brittany is a hunting dog first and foremost and we must always strive to keep him that way.) Mary Jo



2010 ABC Region 19 Amateur All Age Championship

The region 19 Amateur All Age Championship began on September 24th and concluded mid day three days later, on the scenic Dave Tech ranch near Bonesteel, South Dakota. People arriving the day before hit the tail end of a big rain, leaving the entry to the camp a mudhole, and thinking "Here we go again". But the sun came out and pleasant temperatures prevailed for all three days.

Ringneck Brittany Club, small in numbers, hosted the championship. Stalwart workers were Kenny Seivert, myself, Randy Walth, helped out by Chad Holman who marshalled a few braces and Jimmy John, who drove the dog wagon.

As always, we attract the amateurs that attended the Chicken Championship in nearby Bassett, Nebraska, and with the Pheasant Championship to follow on the same grounds just following this stake, there are three one hour all age stakes in two weeks for Brittanys to try for points towards the Purina All Age dog of the year. Purina supported the stake with donations of their fine product as well as much appreciated cash towards keeping stakes of this calibur available to those who compete with all age dogs. Participants travel far and wide for this event; people from Georgia, New Jersey, Illinois, Iowa, Missouri, Minnesota, Idaho, Oklahoma, Texas, Ohio, Tennessee, and Saskatchewan, Canada took part in the stake. The cream of the current crop of competitors always finds their way to Region 19, making for a very exciting competition.

Three one hour courses were available, with ample wild bird populations augmented with released pheasants. During the stake, sharptail and prairie chicken, quail and pheasant were produced in front of the dogs. 31 entrants were turned loose to challenge the big prairies with their endless draws and rolling hills. The rugged terrain made a challenge that could not be met by anything but a superbly conditioned athlete.

A ditch just past the artisian wells that is normally a dry barren piece of ground this year had become saturated with recent rains, and became a hazard to be faced each time around on the 2nd course. It could have been a dangerous situation, with horses bogging down and scrambling to get firm footing on the opposite bank. Many dismounted and crossed on foot.

Judges were Wes Felt, who has addresses both in Texas and Nebraska, and Jack Murphy, Oklahoma. Both have been competitive in Brittany circles for many years, and each man has numerous championships judged to their credit. They commented on how close it was between the four dogs in the winner's circle, and that it was a quality stake.

The champion came from the third brace of the first day. Adios Shaq Attack,

a young orange roan male, owned and handled by Bo Ackerman of Gainesville, Georgia, won his first championship with this title. Heavily scouted, Shaq went to the extremes of the third course without let up for the entire hour. He capped off the hour with a stylish find at time.

Runner up, Kinwashkly Dakota Molester owned and handled by Ken Seivert of Sheldon lowa. Lester ran an extreme race to the far front on course two. He was stopped to the flight of sharptail at the top of horse killer hill. A few minutes later, he had a find on prairie chicken at the edge of a steep draw. From that point, he was seen vanishing over a hill and not seen again until found on point at 50 several hills over. The first attempt to flush was unsuccesful. He relocated well, but when the bird flushed over his head, he gave a hop, which cost him the championship. Lester disappeared to the front following this find. During the grace period after the hour, he was found on point with a covey of quail lifting.

Third place in the championship went to Shadow Attack, owned by Phil Dangerfield, from Florida, and handled by Jessica Carlson from Idaho. Tack was wide, forward, fast throughout his hour as he ran course one. He had a stylish find as well as a stop to flush. At all times, he seemed like he was on a string handling with ease... Fourth place went to RuJem's A Touch of Bourbon, owned by Jerry and Ruth McGee, Illinois. "Chug" had a very good race going on course one, with range and speed and excellent application. Once we dropped into the pasture that course one concludes in, Chug had the misfortune to meet up with milling black Angus cattle strung across the course, which shortened him up. At 53, he had an excellent find on prairie chicken.

The American Brittany Club's prestigious Prairie Chicken Championship commenced Saturday, September 18, 2010 headquartered at the Ted Morton ranch near Bassett, Nebraska. There were sixty seven dogs entered and sixty six went to the line.

The winner was TM'S TENNESSEE TWISTER owned by Brooke Caviness and Lisa Pollock of New Jersey. Sway is a white and orange seven year old female. She is a product of frozen semen from Rimarda's Trademark X Lane's End Bowtie Annie. Sway is the reigning ABC National Amateur Champion for 2009 and was runner-up in the ABC National Open Championship also in 2009. She glided across the prairie ably handled by Lisa to her two finds with forward application.

DAKOTA LUKE was named runner-up. Luke was handled by Justin Kalina of Nebraska and is owned by Dick and Cindy Mantler of Texas. Luke is an eight year old male with numerous hour placements to his credit. His sire is Wichita X Kansas City's Luscious Lucy bred by Ed Wild.

Third place was awarded to TJ'S PRAIRIE BLIZZARD a seven year old male handled by Ed Tillson, N.M. Blizzard was bought about two years ago by Vickie Rankin of Oklahoma. He has amassed many hour placements since that time. Blizzard is by NFC Tequila's Joker X The Prairie Tornado.

JAY HAWK'S GEORGIA GIRL was placed fourth. Gigi is owned by Paul Rosevear of Kentucky and handled by Tom Tracy of Virginia. She is an eight year old female sired by Lea's Running Jayhawk X Hi Scor Sally Rand. Gigi carded two covey finds and a stop to flush.

The first ABC Prairie Chicken Classic was held in 1964 in Wisconsin on established grounds for the preservation of the prairie chicken. Rotating the event began in 1975. It was held north of Burwell, Nebraska. Mo Valley Brittany Club members, Dr Cloid Green, Loyd Budd and Ron Curtis did the preparation to share this event. Since 2001 the event has been held in Nebraska. Sadly, this past

June Ron Curtis passed away. His presents and guidance will be greatly missed at an event that he loved. The backbone of the Nebraska Brittany Club, Stan and Claudia Truksa do the pretrial, during and after cleanup work for this event. They are helped by Jerry McGee, head marshal along with Ed Tillson and Wade Haines opening and closing gates. To the other gate closers we thank you. Dog wagon drivers Claudia Truksa and Jim Chase and co-pilots were always on time.

Many people do not have the opportunity to see native Greater Prairie Chicken. They range in the grassy meadows of the sand hills as with other prairie chicken species from Oklahoma, Kansas through North Dakota and into Canada. Only four states allow hunting of this game bird.

Bassett, Nebraska is a small community with a big welcome for visitors. We thank the Rock County Chamber of Commerce for providing the coffee and donuts for the morning break. The club hosted a steak dinner at Jeanna's Coral Bar for participants who attended from across the country and the landowners: Curtis Luther, Butch Fischer, Jack Bair and Wade Dearmont who allow us to ride across their land. We are greatly in their debt for their generosity.

Nestle-Purina has long been a supporter of the performance dog. Their research of pet foods is ongoing. They provide dog food for the winners along with monetary support to aid in running a quality event. Tri Tronics has also been a sponsor of bird dog events. Our judges for this event were Jim Micholetz of Decatur, Arkansas and Ken Chenoweth of Fair Grove, Missouri. Jim has pointers and setters which he has campaigned in different venues of the country. Ken runs German Shorthaired Pointers and has judged most other breeds. Both men have experience with "chickens" and a keen eye in seeing the wily birds fly. They were a pleasure to ride with.

The Running:

ACE'S DI, Holman and CEDAR VALLEY BANDIT, Tracy. Overcast skies with light mist at 47 degrees. We headed south through the second pasture of the morning. Both dogs were slow to start. Before the gate a covey of chickens lifted with a late flying single going over Di's head and she wanted a closer look. Bandit circled near the windmill and a single flushed which he honored. He made a wide swing going across the hay meadow. In the second half of the hour he shortened and was leashed at 53'.

KD'S SLIP AND SLIDE, Tillson and JUSTAS WELL BE THE GUNNER, Kalina. As we went through the next gate and Gunner pointed in a swale. The handler flushed well in front of the dog as Gunner released himself and roaded forward. He was leashed on site. Sly ran to some likely places for birds. At 42' Sly began making game. He roaded in a bit to close causing a single to lift, the rest of the covey flushed and left the country.

MARJO'S WHAT WAS I THINKING, Luisi and LANE'S END TURK, Holman. Both dogs were slow to start going in to a head wind. Turk had a hard time maintaining the front. Marjo would make some good moves then return to quartering to the handler. The brace ended without any bird contact.

EARLY TIMES, Tracy and MAXWELL'S GUNSMOKE, Patterson. Away after lunch on the former morning course we headed east. Both dogs were slow to start, Pete turned to the tree line and was retrieved. Earl ran wide with the wind direction. Both dogs made good moves during the hour but were not rewarded with any bird work.

SHADOW ATTACK, Tillson and UNCLE KRACKER, Tracy. We left the "new" gate/road crossing headed west. At 16' Tack stood in a swale with high grass. Nothing could be produced. Kracker crossed this pasture and hit the fence line where he turned north and was not returned to judgment. Tack was credited with a stop to flush along a fence line and another unproductive. He hunted forward at moderate range during the hour.

GRAND JUNCTION JAKE, Holman and TM'S TENNESSEE TWISTER, L. Pollock. We took a coffee break near a windmill in the pasture. Both dogs started strong headed to the right. Jake swung back and Sway stayed out to our right. At 5' point was called for Sway as she stood atop a ridge. Upon approach the handler ran forward and flushed a covey that was well forward from the dog. Everything was in order. Jake was erratic in his application and was leashed shortly. At 49' Sway pointed along a fence line in the hay meadow. Nothing was produced and she was sent on. At 57' she was on the north side of the course and swung around and pointed staunchly. A few birds were flushed with more lifting after. She stood rock solid through all.

PRIMETIME OUTLAW JOHNNY, Kalina and TRADEMARKS ICEMAN, Holman. Sunday dawned with temps of about 50 degrees and a light mist. The horizon was hazy causing some difficulty is spotting a big running dog. This pair hit the edges making some nice moves. Through the big hay meadow and around to the south Cash was out of pocket at the big woods. Timmy headed forward with good range. At 55' birds lifted from a pasture and Timmy stopped. Cash was returned later in the hour and leashed.

DIAMOND HILL'S RECKLESS ENDEAVOR, L.Pollock and LOST CREEK TIMBER RIDGE, Tillson. Both dogs moved nicely across the hay meadows. At 15' Rowdy pointed, as the covey lifted he turned and went on. He was taken to the dog wagon. Rex was having a hard time maintaining the front and his handler elected to pick him up.

MARJO'S RED RUM, Luisi and OAK HILL'S TIME TO BURN, Holman. Both dogs were using the prairie well. Bernie pointed at 9' and Johnny pointed at 10' in Bo's meadow but nothing could be produced in front of either dog. Each dog had another non productive. Johnny was leashed and Bernie finished the hour showing his heels.

SOVEREIGN'S GIT-R-DONE, Tillson and ADIOS SHAQ ATTACK, Tracy. Overcast skies had stayed with us in the afternoon. Larry was slow getting untracked and Shaq started wide being lateral in some of his moves. Larry was leashed at 20'. Shaq continued to be a handful. At 41' we saw a single lift and as we rode over a ridge he stood in the tall grass swale. Handler approached and more birds lifted from in front of the dog. He was fired over and taken on. He finished the hour strong and forward on the ground.

RU-JEM'S A TOUCH OF BOURBON, McGee and HIGH POINT BET'N HE'LL ROCK. We left in the pasture at the roadside, headed west. Over a ridge we see Rock under a single at 7'. Chug had a find on sharp-tail's at 19'. We were in a square pen/windmill area. The covey lifted and he stood staunchly. A find at 25' on a covey. A find at 30' on a single. A find at 44' in tall cover on a single will pointed-with range between finds. At 52' Point was called as he stood in tall cover. Handler flushed to no avail... took the dog on and he began to rode in, traveling thru the tall cover and at 57' he pointed. A single was put to flight by the handler with all in order. He finished the hour with a strong cast forward and hitting it hard.

HAVAPAL RENEGADE BILLY BOY, Thomas and DAKOTA ALLEY CAT, Tracy. Both dogs started slow, each reaching as we covered ground. This pair made some nice casts using the country. At 50' the tracker was called for as Tiger had been absent beyond the big woods east of the house. Billy traveled forward along the ditch being sighted forward. He finished the hour across the hay meadow without bird contact.

CAST-A-BRITT MICRO SAMMIE, Burchett and DAKOTA LUKE, Kalina. Monday morning dawned with wind and warmer temps. By coffee break jackets came off. Sammie made wide casts from the start. Luke started slow and gained momentum through the hour. At 6' Luke was credited with a stop to flush. At 9' amid the cattle he pointed and a single was flushed with all in order. A nonproductive at 12' for Luke. Sammie is fast on the ground covering a lot of real estate. At 43' she was across the fence where she stopped. Point was called by the handler. Birds lifted and she released herself. Luke had a nice find at 37'. Birds were flushed in front of him as he stood high and tight. The wind continues to be a factor this morning. Luke finished the hour forward in the next pasture.

WINDTUCK'S ROCKET RED GLARE, Milam and ACE'S PATCHWORK, Holman. Patch was the wider of the pair using the country. Rocket worked to the wind. We went into Bo's meadow where Patch pointed a covey. The birds lifted as the handler approached. Patch's posture suffered and he was leashed. Shortly, Rocket had a chicken flush, circled and pointed as another one left the country. His bird work wasn't crisp and he was also leashed.

SPANKY'S LITTLE PILL BANDIT, John and BRITTMONT THE HAWK, Gorrow. This pair was not consistent in their application and were leashed midway in the hour.

ROCKLAN'S KID ROWDY, BURCHETT and ALMADEN'S RIVER OF SHADOWS, Tillson. The wind is to increase this afternoon with sunny skies. Both dogs were forward off the breakaway. Rowdy continued to be the wider of the pair. River was a bit erratic in his application. They ran the hour covering the terrain but were not rewarded for their efforts.

SHADYWAY RED TAIL HAWK, John and CORREDOR DORADO, Tracy. At about 3 minutes into this brace the wind kicked up another notch with the temperature climbing. At 17' Dorado was credited with a stop to flush on a covey. Hawk was not running an all age race and was leashed shortly after. Dorado had a nonproductive in tall grass at 28' and was leashed.

KINWASHKLY DAKOTA MOLESTER, John and WINDY HILL BEN, Burchett. Lester started slow, making some good moves. Ben had two nonproductive's in the first half of the hour and was leashed. Lester had slowed and also was leashed.

JOKER'S JACKPOT, John and HI PROOF WHIZKI, Gorrow. Tuesday morning dawned cool with partly cloudy skies. The temperature was 50 degrees. Jack started slow gaining in the hour. Whiz was off with a flourish. He was wide and used the country that we could see. He was absent about midway in the hour. The tracking device was called for at 42'. The dog was sited at 42 and a quarter. Jack did not have any bird contact during the hour.

T&W'S DIAMOND JIM, Kalina and TJ'S PRAIRIE BLIZZARD, Tillson. Jim ran a wide prairie race without bird contact. Blizzard had a stop to flush on a single at 29'. He pointed in Bo's meadow at 32'. As the handler approached, birds lifted well in front of the dog. Blizzard made some nice moves using the country during the hour.

ODESSY'S ACE OF HEARTS, Holman and TWO RIVERS SKYHAWK, John. This pair was slow to start. Ace was up midway in the hour. Sky continued on making a few swings through the country. She did not have any bird contact during the hour.

JAYHAWK GEORGIA GIRL, Tracy and ROCKLAN'S WHIZZLE STOP, Burchett. The sun is trying to peek through the clouds at lunchtime. This pair covered some country. At 9' Gigi was credited with a nice stop to flush. Whiz is sickling around the pastures. At 52' point is called for Gigi as she stands at a fence line. A large covey lifted as the handler approached. She was fired over and taken on with all in order. At the far side of the slough Gigi pointed. She was relocated several times through the tall reeds. Soon a pair of chickens were flushed from the grass with all in order. Whiz did not have any game contact in the hour.

JACK'S TEQUILA JAKE, John and BLACKCREEK TIM, Holman. Jake was the wider of the pair. Tim made some moves early in the hour. He shortened to moderate range for his time on the ground. At 36' Jake pointed in a swale. The handler began to flush and Jake released himself and was leashed.

Wolf RIVER'S WINNING TICKET, Gorrow and TEQUILA'S BARBED WIRE, Tillson. This pair was slow to start. Trouble made a few nice moves then settled in to a hunting mode. Cash couldn't get untracked and was leashed early in the hour.

TLM FREQUENT FLYER, Milam and DIAMOND HILL DEUCES GONE WILD, Pollock. Wednesday dawned with fog until late morning with a light mist coming down. We held off until noon and released dogs. Through the first gate at the road crossing we headed East while the dogs headed West. Upon return they settled in

at moderate range and were leashed.

RU-JEM'S FISTFUL OF DOLLARS, McGee and RICOCHET'S CHANTILLY, Burchett. Into the hay meadow we headed east. At the big woods Dollar pointed at the edge of the tree line. A turkey was sighted leaving in the brush. At 19' Tilly pointed a covey of chickens with all in order. She covered the country at moderate range. Dollar had a non productive at 54'. He made some nice moves using the country.

BRISCO'S MR STUB, Trimble and SANDY PINES CHASE THE WIND, Holman. Overcast skies and upper 60's. We headed toward Bo's meadow. Brisco pointed at 6'. A small covey was put to flight as he stood staunchly. At 10' he had a nonproductive. Chavy made some nice moves being lateral at times. Brisco sighted a flushing chicken and wanted a closer look at 23'. Chavy had a hard time maintaining the front and was leashed. The fog had rolled in. We waited in the meadow for 30 minutes for the fog to lift or call the running for the day....... we headed to camp.

THE CRASH SCENE, Tracy and MOKAN DURAMAX, Boydston. With rain during the night and again before daylight and breezy. Temperatures were about 58'. Crash had a nonproductive at 4'. Max had a hard time maintaining the front. Both dogs were up early in the hour.

STARLIGHT'S BLAZING SIRIUS, Thomas and TRADEMARK'S ATM, Holman. Both dogs made some good moves during their time on the ground. Sy pointed at 46'. During the flush he released himself and was leashed. Cash couldn't keep the good moves consistant. At 59' he pointed in a swale where birds flushed at the approach of the handler. He was fired over to end the hour.

KISS THIS, Gorrow and ROUSTABOUT SNIKSOH SADIE, Tracy. Smooch had a hard time maintaining the front and was leashed early. Sadie had a nonproductive at 10' and 43' and was leashed.

BLACKCREEK DEACON, Holman and DIAMOND HILL SHE'S GONE, Pollock. She's Gone was a no show so Deacon ran as a bye. Deacon made a few nice swings during his time on the ground. He had nonproductive's at 15' and 32' then was leashed.

TLM COMMANCHE CHIEF, Milam and SHAMROCK'S SIRIUS, Holman. After lunch it was breezy and overcast with intermittent light showers. Both dogs went west as we turned east. Sy returned to the front and Chief ran parallel to us. At 24' Chief hand a nonproductive on the dike that we cross, relocated, nothing was found. Sy continued to reach to the edges. Both dogs finished the hour without bird contact.

JAKE ACRES IN DISQUISH, Gorrow and MUSTANG SALLY VIII, Tracy. Sally was making some strong casts. At 26' she ran over a bird and didn't get stopped in time and was leashed. Jake had bird contact at the same time in Bo's Meadow. Jake then had a very nice find on a single chicken at 30' in Bo's Meadow. He made some strong moves, having a flat spot about 45'. He finished the hour forward.

COUNTY LINE ACE'S HIGH, Gorrow. The wind had become gusty about an hour ago. Ace started strong but had a hard time maintaining the front and was leashed midway in the hour.

This Brittany Classic series has had many locations since it's revival in 2005, but none have been as successful as the Union County Bird Dog ranch. We would like to thank Bob Burchett for inviting us back to lowa, and for volunteering to chair the event this year.

There are always many people to thank for their efforts in putting on any event. First and foremost, we would like to thank Purina and Pat Lamantia for their continued generous sponsorship, providing many pounds of dog food to fuel the champions of these events. As secretary and reporter, I would personally like to thank all those who pitched in to help at this year's events. Especially Terry Hilliard, who accompanied me on the long drive from New Jersey, and acted as dog wagon driver, coffee break marshal and lunch chef. Also to Tommy Thomas and Bob Burchett for early morning bird planting. Other dog wagon drivers, Linda Thomas and Marvin Stout, and Jerry McGee for marshaling the courses. Professionals Tom Tracy and Ed Tillson also pitched in to help with all these duties during the Amateur Championship. Without dedicated volunteers like these, the events could not take place.

The weather this spring all over the Country has been anything but predictable. An early spring snowstorm that hit southern Kansas three days earlier had almost stranded half the competitors in Eureka. Fortunately, everyone could be pulled out in time to get to lowa. The weather for Tuesdays start was just perfect. Early morning temperatures in the mid 30's, rising to almost 60 degrees by mid afternoon.

Judges for this year's Open Classic were Mike Martin from Bella Vista, AR and Peter Wilkin from Olathe, KS. These two men gave all the entries their full attention, even when conditions on Wednesday became wet and soggy. This

year's winner was Ru-Jem's a Touch of Bourbon, owned by Ruth and Jerry McGee, and handled by Jerry. This was Chug's second time winning the International, and he is no stranger to the winner's circle. Runner-up was Ricochet's Chantilly, a three-year-old female owned by Julie Nelson and handled by Bob Burchett. This young female is really starting to come into her own, as this was her second hour placement this spring. The third place dog was another young entry. Joker's Jackpot, owned by Steve Ralph and handled by Jim John caught the judges attention for his wide application of the course. Forth place went to Cedar Valley Bandit, owned by David Webb and handled by Tom Tracy.

Brace 1 BROADWAY JOE IV (Tom Tracy) and ROCKLAN'S WHIZZLE STOP (Bob Burchett) Both dogs broke strong to the front. At 5, Whiz had a find in the orchard, all in order. Joe had not been seen since he disappeared over the horizon into the orchard, and was next seen rimming the forward edges just past the old barn. Both dogs took to the alfalfa field together and were found standing at the far end. Birds were flushed and Whiz was unable to contain himself. Joe was sent on and had a second find two minutes later by the pond at. He was sent on and hunted hard from the gun dog breakaway to the orchard. He increased his range as we left the orchard and headed back toward camp. He was gathered at the road crossing and again set loose at the all age breakaway, where he went on to finish the hour with 3 more finds.

Brace 2 TM'S TENNESSEE TWISTER (Lisa Pollock) and SOVEREIGN'S GIT-R-DONE (Ed Tillson) Dogs broke from the white house and pushed hard to the front. Sway was seen going over the terrace and through the keyhole. Larry took some time to hunt the keyhole. Sway was next seen making her way toward the road crossing. She was gathered, along with Larry as they crossed the road back toward camp. Sway was seen heading for the orchard and again after the double creek crossing. At 30, she scored a find while rimming the field past the barn. Larry was ahead on the left side of the alfalfa field as handler called point.

As Sway was catching the front, she came in to investigate, stole point, releasing Larry. Both dogs were done.

Brace 3 TJ'S PRAIRIE BLIZZARD (Tillson) and HAVAPAL'S RENEGADE BILLY BOY (Burchett). Blizzard broke to the feed strips on the left and Billy disappeared in the cedars on the right. At 6 point was called for Blizzard in the orchard. All was in order and he was sent on. Billy was seen to the front as we headed toward camp. Both dogs were gathered as we crossed the road and headed for the all age breakaway. Blizzard was found standing at 19 on the backside of the keyhole. Billy made a move to the left of the keyhole and was pushing further out. Handler took some time to gather the dog to get him back on course. Meanwhile Blizzard carded another find at 22 below the terrace. Billy dug in as we rounded the Church corner and took some time to come around. Blizzard did not range as wide and recorded his forth find at 36 in the keyhole. Back across the road, Billy was more manageable, but still running strong. Unfortunately, he had no bird contact.

Brace 4 EARLY TIMES (Tracy) and ROCKLAN'S KID ROWDY (Burchett) Both dogs got off to an erratic start and needed to be gathered before entering the orchard. Earl had a find at 6 in the orchard, while Rip was sent forward. At 10, Rip had a mishap and was leashed. Earl scored a find at 14 on the right side before the barn. Sent on, he worked the edges of the alfalfa field and gun dog breakaway nicely. He showed well after the orchard headed back toward camp. Across the road, he cast the left edge to the front and next seen past the keyhole, making his way to the center edge below the terrace. Point was called at time, as a heard of deer was seen coming out the back edge of the draw.

Brace 5 ELEET'S COLORADO BLUE (Tracy) and RICOCHET'S CHANTILLY. Dogs broke from the Church corner gate, and took some time to settle. Blue went wide right and was seen at the feeder below the terrace under a bird. Tilly was straightened out and gathered as she crossed the road back toward camp. She was sent on toward the orchard, and wasn't seen for some time. At 37, as we rounded the pond toward the gun dog breakaway, scout was heard calling point on the left side of the alfalfa field. Tilly stood in the ditch as birds were flushed. She scored a second find at 41 off to the right before the creek crossing. Tilly showed well as we entered the big fields heading back toward camp. She was gathered as we crossed the road and finished on the left side as headed for the keyhole.

Brace 6 MUSTANG SALLY VII (Tracy) Sally broke from the Church corner and began hunting hard. She scored 3 finds with incredible style and manners. In addition to the three finds on quail, Sally was steady to the flush of a cat, and turkey. She unfortunately went into hunt mode and was leashed before the end of the hour.

We woke Wednesday morning to a steady, bone chilly rain.

Brace 7 DIAMOND HILL DEUCE'S GONE WILD (Lisa Pollock) and WINDY HILL BEN (Burchett) Both dogs broke well. Cooter worked the left edge, and then met up with Ben as both dogs were seen driving hard for the orchard. At 5, both dogs were seen standing tall at the orchard. All was in order and both dogs were sent on. Cooter retrieved a wet bird from the center draw after the double creek crossing. Meanwhile, Ben was found standing at the right hand draw before the barn. Ben went on to have another nice forward find before the alfalfa field, only to go missing at 35.

Brace 8 CEDAR VALLEY BANDIT (Tracy) and STARLIGHT'S BLAZING SIRIUS (Burchett) The rain got heavier, and the temperatures seemed to drop a few degrees. The reporter was seen heading to the trailer to warm up and dry off. The judge's report was that these 2 dogs had many finds, and backing opportunities, which they both handled.

Brace 9 RU-JEMS A TOUCH OF BOURBON (Jerry McGee) and KD'S SLIP AND SLIDE (Tillson) This brace broke from the gun dog parking area, and went off well. Chug ran a very consistent forward hour with 4 well-spaced finds. Splash suffered a mishap on a bird half way through.

Brace 10 DAKOTA ALLEY CAT (Tracy) and RICO G'S BLAZIN CYCLONE (Burchett) Both dogs were lost early.

Brace 11 CEDAR VALLEY AYSA (Tracy) and CAST-A-BRITT MICRO SAMMIE (Burchett) These 2 must have taken notes from the previous brace, as they also went missing.

Thursday morning brought the sunshine and seasonable temperature back to the area, however there was some wind to contend with that made things difficult for some.

Jack continued to show well and carded a find in the orchard at 23. He was seen covering the edges of all the fields as we headed toward camp and the road. He was gathered to cross the road and sent on to take the left edge of at the all age breakaway. He continued at this pace, rimming the Church corner and all the feed strips along the road. Jack went on to finish as we headed toward the keyhole, using all the outside edges.

Brace 13 DIAMOND HILL RECKLESS ENDEAVOR (Pollock) and TJ'S THUNDER (John) These dogs broke from the road at camp. Rex, a bit directionally challenged, broke to the right, and eventually worked his way forward through the thick woods. Thunder had a find at 6 in the orchard. Rex caught up after Thunder's first find, and cast himself to the front. At 10, Thunder had a find in the center draw after the double creek crossing. Rex was seen working wide right. After Thunder was released, he joined Rex in some inappropriate bird work in the right hand draw before the barn.

Brace 14 ROUSTABOUT SNIKSOH SADIE (Trace) and SHADY WAY RED TAIL HAWK (John) These dogs broke from the barn. Deer were seen coming from the cedars on the left. Beau was quickly returned to judgment from the mishap, while Sadie was seen to the front. Sadie had a find at the hay bales. She stood patiently as birds were flushed from a distance. Beau went on to have a mishap on his first piece of bird work on the right side before the creek crossing. Sadie went on to have another nice find, but got hung up in a few places. She was leashed at 45.

Brace 15 CORREDOR DORADO (Tracy) and TWO RIVERS SKY HAWK (John) These two young dogs had some problems with direction, neither made the hour.

Brace 16 LOST RIVER TIMBER RIDGE (Tillson) KINWASHKLY DAKOTA MOLESTER (John) This brace broke at the gates by the Church, and was history at the feeder below the terrace.

The Replacement Pup

"I'm so sorry, but I don't believe in wasting people's time or money and you need to know. Daisy won't ever make a good bird dog."

Well, darn. I finally get a real dog and then she turns out to be useless. It wasn't as if I hadn't done my research. I read lots of articles and talked to lots of hunters. Go to the kennels in Midland, they said. Pick a good prospect and then put him in training at Anderson's . You'll have a fine dog, one you can hunt with, one that will do you proud.

I did it. I called the kennel, talked with James and bought a sweet 2-year old named Daisy. With a great pedigree full of the right credentials, she was sent to Anderson's School for training before I even brought her home. With my lack of dog knowledge, it seemed better that I not contaminate her.

I hadn't had a dog in all my adult years. Jobs that required extensive travel as a way to build my career, responsibilities of providing supervision to that cadre of young professionals I hired, travel to major conferences to learn and teach others all the innovative techniques I was using to help abused, neglected, and mentally ill children; all these and more left precious few evenings at home and when one did occur, my wife and family wanted my full attention. There was no room for a dog.

However, lives and relationships and responsibilities change. My wife declared that my lengthy absences and the fact the children had lives of their own meant the house was lonely. Virginia wanted a dog, someone to patrol the house in the evenings and meet strangers at the door and perhaps ride with her to the local post office. I resisted, because I thought we were too busy to enjoy a dog and it would be only a responsibility soon relegated to an outside chain and house. Then, as I made my weekly itineration of 700 + miles, it began to dance through my mind. A dog. Hmmm. When I was in high school, I had enjoyed hunting with my pals on crisp autumn Saturdays in October. And I remembered that those events inevitably included a dog or two. Well, surely a dog wouldn't be too bad. He could provide company for my wife and protection for the house.

Okay, so now what type of dog should join us? The only dogs that I remembered much about were of the hunting persuasion, setters and pointers and Labradors and bird dogs. And we might just as well make this dog be a multi-tasker. If I were home on a weekend, it might be fun to get together with some of the guys and go pheasant-hunting. Okay, so what is a good kind of hunting dog? Back to the research. Those Brittany

Spaniels sure are a good looking lot.

After all that effort, now my investment turned sour. Daisy couldn't be a hunting dog.

When I contacted the Breeder, he told me that he had a replacement pup if I would like to return Daisy. I think. I tell him that I'm going to pick up Daisy and would like the replacement pup so that I will actually have a hunting dog. But I don't want to return Daisy. After all, I work with a lot of foster children and I see what happens to kids who are returned from failed adoptions over and over. I can't do that. Daisy will live with me. But I do want that replacement pup. I want a dog that will hunt. Please ship me the pup.

When I get to the Bird Dog Training Academy, I learn that Daisy is not really gun-shy: she is absolutely terrified and intolerant of any loud noise.

I am intrigued; after all, I am a behavioral counselor specializing in helping clients overcome maladaptive behaviors. Daisy had maladaptive behaviors. Using behavioral principles that I implement to help people overcome their phobias and neuroses, I developed a simple plan to build sequential tolerance to loud noises. It took 4 hours and it changed Daisy.

The gun-shy dog who left the field at the first shot now was able to tolerate gun noise and concentrate on that bird. The trainer was impressed. Daisy and I were ecstatic! Well, after having shared that moment of overcoming a neurosis with a canine client, I couldn't possibly return her. It went against all my psychological beliefs. You facilitate healing within the client and are in it for the long-haul. No short-term relationships here. You expect and demand loyalty. We heal within loyalty. No, I didn't want to return Daisy. I will keep Daisy. Daisy is mine. She will stay at the school and learn now. She is able to learn now.

When I got home from Daisy's Triumph at the Bird Dog Academy, I was met by a small bundle of energy promptly christened Bungie due to the incredible projectile ability of those back legs. Fresh from my experience with Daisy, I knew that if I wanted this dog to be a good hunter, he would have to have a good foundation. A bright and emotionally healthy pup who could hunt; that was my goal. He was given a lovely dog-house for daytime when Virginia was at work. He will be given good food and enjoy being in the house at night. And when he is old enough, he will be enrolled in Hunting 101 at the Anderson Academy.

As the weeks went by, I realized that Bungee was relegated to the outside pen

frequently and spending way too much time being bored at home. I decided that if I wanted to spend time with him, my schedule dictated that he might just as well be keeping me company. So, he joined me on the road.

The dog magazines make it clear: choose a pet or choose a hunter, you can't have both. A pet will be social, but can't hunt, and a hunter will be great in the field, but no fun in the house. Bungee and I disagree with that idea.

By taking an ever-increasing array of training aids (rope, collars, decoys, whistles, etc) and scheduling stops every hour (or 2 hours, depending on his bladder), he is able to get in some 35-minutes of training – playtime. We generally have 3 sessions a day of 30-45 minutes each.

We eat on the road and while I'm sure the pet food companies would like you to believe that he dined on their product, the truth is that the majority of the time, we do fast food for lunch and dry kibble with steamer veggies for dinner followed by a couple of rib bones for an evening snack.

I believe that traveling with me has given him a job. He has built-in dog training and play time. He has a family to watch over, several houses to patrol and numerous places to inspect every week. He does therapy with the mental health clients as they pat him and tell him secrets, and he hunts quail on the weekends as we practice. He endures long meetings with associates, while usually lying patiently at my feet. Although, if someone leaves the room, he frequently takes their chair. I've discovered it speeds up meetings if you know the dog will take over if you leave. I've seen his smile as he watches children at play and races through the field on a Saturday at dawn. He seems to understand and enjoy that life has rhythms, that all is not work, all is not play.

I would encourage anyone who is looking for a true companion, one that works and plays well with others to invest time and money in a Brittany pup. The return on your investment is three-fold: a great hunting dog, a great house dog, and most important, a great canine companion.

Daisy can now enjoy hunting quail and pheasant and the camaraderie of the hunt. She has had a dandy litter of eight and is enjoying hunting on weekends when I'm home. Since she was a hunter first and didn't spend time in the house, that's my next goal. I want her to learn to be a house dog I want her to develop those skills. I know she can. I can help her and I already know that she's capable. After all, she's a Brittany.

- American Brittany Futurities shall be open to every purebred Brittany bitch and her progeny whelped during the calendar year of January 1 - December 31 and whose litters have been enrolled with The American Brittany Club.
- · Bitch must be owned or leased by an American Brittany club member.
- All dams nominated and all sires bred to must be registered or eligible for registration.
- Nominations of dams must be made within 30 days after the bitches have whelped. A sum of \$30.00 must be paid at this time. This payment will entitle each puppy of this particular litter to be entered in the ABC Futurities (Field and/or Bench) after the dog has been properly registered in a recognized stud book.
- Late litter nominations will be accepted with the following current fee schedule:
 Late fees are: \$30.00 for 31-60 days, \$60.00 for 61-90 days, and \$100.00 for any nomination received more than 90 days after whelping. No nominations will be accepted past 180 days of whelping. Additional late fees may be imposed from time to time by the ABC Board of Directors. The postmark will determine the fee for late nominations.
- Dogs will be eligible to run in the designated futurity to be held in the Spring of the second year following the year of whelping.
- A final nomination fee will be due by September 15th of the year following whelping.
 Entry fees will be paid by the owner of the puppy for each Sectional Futurity field or bench event the dog enters.


