




History of the ABC National Obedience Trial

In 1979 ABC's 3rd Vice President, Wayne Fessenden, recommended that an Obedience Trial be held in conjunction with the National Field Trial and Specialty Show. The first ABC National Obedience Trial became a reality in Little Rock, Arkansas, in 1981 and was won by the first Brittany Obedience Trial Champion, *CH OTCH Turner's Crossroad Samantha*,. This was a significant event since the ABC for the first time was sponsoring all three types of competition at the Nationals required to win the elusive AKC triple championship.

Many fine Brittanys have won the National Obedience Trial. *Ch. Prince Valiant's Spring A'rival, UDT* won the National Specialty Show in 1987 and the National Obedience Trial in 1988. *CH, OTCH, AFC Lafayette King Trooper, UDT* won the National Obedience Trial in 1983, 1984, 1985 and 1986 and is the leading winner with four wins. *Little Egypt Catapult Cathy, UD, SH* and *CH, OTCH Chilcote's Credit Check UDX, AX, AXJ, JH* have both won the National Obedience Trial three times.

The new venue of Rally was added in 2005.

INTRODUCING THE NORTHEAST GUN DOG AWARD

The Northeast Gun Dog award was started by Marge Fitzpatrick and Marcelle Bell in the mid '50's. The initial winner in 1956 was a young male named Belloaks Gunner handled by his new owner Richard Fox. This award was much sought after and hotly contested in the Northeast.

An excerpt follows from the Book of the American Brittany, "blue book", Nicky Bissell editor. "The Northeast Gun Dog was promoted by some of the Northeastern clubs for the purpose of encouraging participation in amateur stakes. The winners of amateur stakes in trials held by participating clubs received points that were totaled at the year's end with the top dog receiving a very beautiful trophy."

Marge Fitzpatick of the Eastern New England club kept the statistics through the mid 2000's. She was always the first person on the phone when a trial secretary walked through the door to get the results from the amateur gun dog stake so she could forward the current statistics on to the next field trial secretary. Unfortunately, upon her passing this time honored tradition went by the wayside for a few years.

Many of the original clubs have united to re-introduce this prestigious award with the same intent; to encourage amateur stakes.

The generosity of our sponsors: Tritronics and Purina is most appreciated. The Champion was the recipient of a Pro 500 collar and all the winners received "champion fueling" Purina Pro Plan Performance food.

Putting on an event takes the help of many. Field trial secretary Margaret Horstmeyer did all the preliminary paper work, judges and trophy acquisition. Karen Nelsen served as the invaluable meal coordinator- keeping us fed with breakfast burritos, cooking and serving lunch with the help of Mike Frane and setting up for our catered Mexican fiesta. Carl Porter, a local GSP pro, was our chief bird planter. He was assisted by Tom White, Paul Doiron, David Kirk, Bill Leffingwell, Wayne Hale and Joe Waitman. Every brace had multiple bird contact.

18 dogs and 6 handlers came to the starting line with hopes of being the 2010 Chukar Champion. Judges Ellis Herz and Nick Nickols were impressed with the performances of all the dogs and making the final decision was difficult. But, in the end, the

winning dogs went places and made moves that others didn't and that was the deciding factor.

FC/AFC Megasmoke Grand Finale (AI) emerged as the 2010 ABC Chukar Champion. He is owned by Myra Dawn Ellis and handled by Paul Doiron. Al was on a mission and hunted hard to the front, finding birds and pointing with style and intensity. His impeccable three finds and spectacular finish along the ridge of Gun Dog Mountain garnered him the win!

Littermate DC/AFC Megasmoke Limited Edition (Ted) was Runner Up. He is owned, bred and handled by Tom White and Margaret Horstmeyer. Ted had a fast forward running first half and after the second water barrel he took off towards the face of Bald Mountain and was out of sight until the scout called point. The flush was all in order and Ted was released forward. On the way down from checking out a rocky outcropping a chukar stopped Ted in his tracks as point was called. Ted was running stronger as the hour progressed and he charged up the face of Gun Dog Mountain and disappeared over the top. As we reached the top, Ted was pointing a chukar on the down side of the hill. After the bird was worked, time was called.

Third and fourth placers are both seasoned veterans. Third place DC Quail Rock Tough Enough (King) handled by Paul Doiron started his bird conquest by having two finds and a non productive on Chukar Alley. The first was a divided find with fourth place DC/AFC TJ'S Single Shot of Scipio (Emme) handled by Tom White. Both dogs were found standing in the rocks and stood tall and tight as the bird was flushed. King went on to the second half of the course, hitting the hills and rock outcroppings and hunting hard. His

persistence paid off and produced five more finds!

DC/AFC TJ'S Single shot of Scipio continued on after the divided find to run the ridges along Chukar Alley and then cross over to the left and check out any chukar possibilities along the ridges of Limb Find Mountain. After being seen forward in the flats, Emme was found on point on a rock pile. The bird was worked with all manners in order. Emme climbed the face of Gun Dog Mountain and was rewarded with a find at the top. The bird flew off the top and, after the shot, Emme was released to finish her conquest far forward.

The Horn Hunting Chronicles: Brittanys and Snowmobiles

I started looking for moose antlers about twenty years ago after I found my first one lying on a snowmobile trail in Maine early one morning. I had befriended two trappers from Maine who showed me where and how to find the antlers. Ever since then I've been hooked on finding them. Basically, all I had to do was put the time into looking for them. Speaking of time, I should mention it helps to go out into the woods a couple of hours before sunrise to start searching as the first person over the trails gets to find the horns. In case you're wondering, yes, I do refer to them now as horns although they are really antlers. Most people who look for moose antlers like to refer to it as horn hunting. I guess it just rolls off the tongue better!

Around 1993 one of the trappers started to train a young black lab pup named "Spike" to help him to find the horns. Soon Spike became very good at locating horns buried underneath the snow. He truly was inspiring to watch. That was also around the same time I got my first bird dog, a beautiful 9 month old female Brittany named "Spooky." She was a long legged girl, a Brittany who hunted real well with the best of them. She also loved to hike with her "dad" (me) as well. I tried to get Spooky interested in the horn hunting but she didn't take to it. No worries though, as she more than made up for it with her abilities to find and point woodcock and partridge and I remained happy to get up at "O' dark-thirty" to look for horns on my own. Speaking of dogs and horn hunting, I should also mention that Spike, the black lab, loved to ride on the snowmobile with his master. This was also something I could never get Spooky to do.

Over the years I've continued to search for the coveted matching set of moose antlers without much success. Don't get me wrong, I've found plenty of horns over the years, but just never a matched set from the same bull.

After sixteen half wonderful years with Spooky, it was time for her to leave us for that happy hunting ground on the other side. We spent six long months without a Brittany in our lives until we were rewarded with our new pup "Nash dog" from J & A Brittany's of Acton, Maine. Nash was born January 5,



2008 and came home to live with us the first week of March that year.

We'd already been snowmobiling in northern New Hampshire in the Colebrook area and I'd discovered some good areas to find horns in. The first time we brought Nash dog for a trip to our snowmobile camp he was just nine weeks old and boy! Didn't he just love the snow! He couldn't get enough of it. When Nash came back home I started to let him chew on some small moose horns that I had found over the years. He really loved chewing on them and I remembered this was the way the black lab, Spike, started his training. I began to bury some of Nash dog's horns about six inches under the snow and trying to get him on the scent. Having that good Brittany nose on him it didn't take very long for him to catch onto the game of finding the horns for dad, the only thing I couldn't get Nash to do was ride on the snowmobile with me, so together we would hike out to areas to look for horns.

I would also like to mention that Nash has two terrific hunting seasons now under his collar and does quite well pointing pheasant, partridge and woodcock the three upland game birds we pursue here in the northeast.

Lets fast forward another six months: not being content with just one Brittany, we picked out another one, a little tri-colored female who we call Starr, also from J & A's Brittanys. She was born June 13, 2008 and has also become a very important member of our family.

Starr didn't hunt that 2008 bird season because of her age but she had a terrific first year horn hunting. That winter following the dogs through the woods, I stepped over a blow down and saw a single tine sticking out of the snow. What we uncovered was the biggest horn I had ever found, un-chewed and in perfect condition! Pretty remarkable as coyote, porcupine, mice and other vermin love to chew on the horns after they fall on the ground. This horn measured three feet



long and weighed sixteen pounds. Both Nash and Starr enjoyed mouthing and licking the horn a little before I strapped it onto my back pack. Entering a way point on my G.P.S., we were soon back on the hunt for the left side horn to match the right side we had just found.

After about an hour I came up over a rise and found Starr digging in the snow. I walked around in front of Starr and saw what she was digging for; it was another horn. I was hoping it was going to be a match to the first horn we found. With help from Starr I managed to dig the horn out of the snow and ice and found that it was a much smaller horn from a different Moose. We looked around a while longer that day but had to settle for the two horns.

The following weekend we were back at doing something I truly love to do, being in the woods with my Brittany's and watching them running and hunting and just having fun. If we could find a horn it would be a bonus, after losing another foot of snow that week, things under the snow would start to become visible.

I set out on my snow shoes that morning with Nash and Starr with high hopes of finding that elusive left side horn. Using my G.P.S. I navigated back to the original spot where we found the right side horn and began to search from there. Within an hour we found another horn, still mostly covered with snow and ice, and started to dig. It took a good fifteen minutes to get the horn out of the ice. When it came out I was pretty sure it was the left side horn we were looking for! I wouldn't know for sure though until we returned to camp and compared it to the right side of the other horn so I strapped it on my back and continued hunting. We found one more that morning. Throughout the course of that month (March 2009) we found horns from seven different bulls in this one area alone. Most important, and after more than fifteen years of searching, I finally found my first matching set of moose horns!



So far in 2010 we've only found three horns, but more importantly is the fact that the biggest horn of the year was found by my boy Nash dog and it was another beauty; close to three feet long with eleven tines - way to go Nash!

This year we also discovered that Starr likes to ride on the

snowmobiles! Next winter, if the good Lord is willing and the snow gods bless us with good snowfalls, don't be surprised if you see some crazy guy on a snowmobile with a little tri-colored Brittany on his lap with a big orange and white Brittany bringing up the rear on foot, that is of course unless I can convince Nash to ride with us. We'll have to wait and see!



AKC Delegate Report

March 8-9, 2010 -

Field Trial and Hunting Test Committee:

Discussion was held on Canadian Rye as a "mean seed". A plan is needed for research in order to support the goal to collect hard data so that AKC Staff and outside lobbyists can move forward to explore steps to eliminate all "bad seeds" from CRP (Conservation Restoration Program) listed land. A volunteer or hired graduate student in agriculture is needed to see what is within the public domain in plantings of Canadian Rye across the country. The CRP in the Department of Agriculture needs to provide a list of "bad seeds" (Canadian Rye is a recommended seed by CRP). It was suggested that hard data is needed regarding the number of dogs affected over the last 5-7 years. A 501C3 fund needs to be established for this project — AKC Humane Fund would set up a sub-fund — mean seeds fund. The fund would receive donations for the purposes of funding research, administrative costs and related endeavors relating to the goal of elimination of so-called "mean seeds" from approved seed mixes for the US Department of Agriculture CRP lands. The sub-fund would also make appropriate disbursements from such sub-fun for the foregoing purposes.

Doug Ljungren, AKC liaison to the Field Trial and Hunting Test Committee gave a 2009 year end report on performance events. Pointing Breed field trials are down 3% in terms of entries, primarily in hunting tests. Retriever trials are down 1%; Spaniel events are up 2%; Beagle entries are up 2% with a total increase of 1% for the year.

Ken Marden confirmed that the compliance rules were changed as follows: Any club that holds its specialty show with its field trial no longer has to do double compliances even though they would undoubtedly be out of their home territory.

Canine Health Committee:

Over 140 breeds contributed over 10,000 blood samples. Other organizations are looking to get samples from AKC. It is felt that if they obtain samples from AKC, then they must contribute to the cost. CHIC for cancer research is looking to increase their data base.

On the 2010 grant cycles researchers can apply online. 90 proposals have been received and they will pick the best from them. Unfortunately they cannot fund them all. For \$200, clubs can become members of the Canine Health Foundation. The number of genetic diseases that have been investigated is 18. The genetic research grants that this program has paid for is over \$800,000. A donation does not have to be large. The Committee suggested breeders take \$5.00 from each puppy they sell.

It was discussed with the Health Committee that health titles be added to the dog. The Committee suggested that breed clubs do independently. If the titles are given, who has the responsibility if the pup has a problem? The Committee felt would cause the animal rights groups add more things to the list of legal compliances.

Crop and Dock:

The bill in New York has not moved because a Bill Of Particulars must be files and it has not been to date. The Agricultural Committee has control. California had a law passed about not docking tails of cows. If this can be done with cows, it will only be a matter of time to incorporate the law for all animals. This political movement is not about the welfare of animals.

Legislative Committee:

Sheila Goff, AKC Government Relations Department, advised that there were 950 State and Federal bills introduced last year. Of those, 700 are bills held over from last year. She went on to describe all the active fights in many of the states. Patti Strand, NAIA, advised that the purebred dogs are under attack from animal rights activists. Before that, it was agriculture — monkeys, spotted owls, flipper. PETA does not speak on actual animal welfare but on how to be an activist and marketing their cause. We can counter some of this by speaking on the AKC Canine Health Foundation and what they do.

Pet Finders is the biggest seller on the internet. The USA has the highest dog ownership in the world. AKC is the leader in promoting responsible dog ownership. We ALL need to promote AKC at every opportunity. Make sure every puppy you sell is registered. Information can be obtained from AKC. Also, visit the website of NAIA for more information and press releases.

Delegate Meeting:

- 1. The vote on the proposed splitting of the groups has gone back to committee
- The proposal to change Chapter 11, Section 6, of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows Dog Show Entries . . . eliminates the use of telegrams to change or cancel entries as telegrams are now obsolete.
- 3. The vote on the Duties and Responsibilities of Show Veterinarians has gone back to committee.
- 4. The first reading of Chapter 14, New Paragraph, of Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedures for Pointing Breeds ...establishing minimum standards for National Championship events. (This would not affect The American Brittany Club as we already have standards in place for our National Championship events.)

June 2010 -

All Breeds Committee:

It was recommended that clubs hand out either a green ribbon or cards that identify the dog has won Grand Champion points. On a card, the club could put their logo plus the date of the show. Clubs also need to train ring stewards. It will be the responsibility of the handler to check the tear sheets at the Superintendents table to see the points awarded. An ad slick is available with the Show Superintendents explaining the program. Show reps will also do exhibitor briefings during the show. Results will be posted online. At the Eukanuba Championship, all the Grand Champions will be listed and the date they finished.

Regarding AKC privileges, the wording is changed from losing the AKC privileges to has lost <u>any</u> AKC privileges. This is helpful to clubs in keeping persons as members.

Field Trial and Hunting Test Committee:

Ken Marden reported that the AKC Gun Dog Championship held at Camp Robinson, NE, was a great success. The same GSP won both the Retrieving and Non-Retrieving stakes. It was the first time the same dog had won both stakes.

Doug Ljungren reported that entries to date were down 3.3%. This was mostly due to very bad weather in different parts of the country. The breakdown is as follows: Field Trials and Hunting Tests down 6%; Retriever trials down 5%; Beagles down 4% and Spaniels up 3%. Spinoni's have asked to have a water test for Senior and Master Hunter titles. This will go to AKC BOD and probably be instituted in January of 2011.

In Spaniel hunting tests, if you pass a higher level in the hunting test, you cannot go back to a lower category.

There is a new sporting breed coming in as of 1/1/11 – Drentsche Patrijshond (Drent) – retriever.

The committee continues to work on setting up a "mean seed" research program. A botanist, Wm Lavenroth, friend of a committee member, has offered to assist. He will work with the AKC Canine Health Foundation who felt this project was worthy of a grant that is figured to be a 3-6 month project. Fundraising to date for this research is \$6,300 which is in a 501c3 sub-fund of the Humane Fund. It is estimated that \$10,000 to \$15,000 is needed. I would like to recommend the ABC Board of Directors consider a donation of at least \$2,000-\$1,500 to this fund designating it only be used for the "Mean Seeds Fund." The program is also looking to a possible donation from Purina. There is a

copywrited article written by Cathy Lewis that we are obtaining permission to print in the different sporting dog breed magazines in order to obtain more case studies.

AKC will be making a presentation to the delegate body, September 2011, explaining field trials and hunting tests. They will be obtaining field video from all the different breeds, cut and splice together for the presentation. The Field Trial and Hunting Test Committee will go over the video before it is presented.

Some small breed specific events, AKC will now acknowledge the parent club's performance events that previously had just been acknowledged by the parent club, i.e. Bloodhound working certificate

Legislative Caucus:

It is advised that anyone who talks to Animal Rights people, be careful what you say as they will try to get us to say something detrimental, i.e. "yes, we have a problem with hips." Or "We have some breeders that don't take proper care of their puppies." AKC is now in the mode of creating materials teaching breeders/exhibitors how to handle such questions. .There is a link on the right side of the AKC website — Canine Health resource which gives suggested responses. It is suggested that clubs become members of the Canine Health Foundation by donating \$200. The club will receive a banner from the Foundation to hang up at the club's specialty show where photo's can be taken and advertised showing the good the breed clubs do. Hint — this would be a compliance when the picture with a short write-up is put in a local newspaper.

A delegate reported that in Connecticut, the VMA elected a president of the association that does NOT like breeders and all and does not like purebred dogs. To combat the discrimination on a dog's appearance the vet students are taught, a breeder can advise what the dog was originally bred to do and the reasons for the dog's structure, coat, etc. They can educate the vet that they are preserving a heritage.

There is a 2 page letter that can be used by all of us to print, sign and mail or hand to their personal veterinarians. I have attached this letter and recommend that it be printed in the ABC magazine with the recommendation that all members give it to their veterinarians. This letter is also on the NAIA website.

Delegate Meeting:

AKC has a new Club Relations webpage. A club's By Laws can be sent in when amended. It has listed the AKC Code of Ethics. This website allows for an electronic

update of club officers and membership.

If a club suspends a person within the club, it does not affect AKC privileges.

Lisa Peterson, Director of Communications advised that clubs should have a disaster preparedness plan — an award can be handed out to clubs or persons that excel in this area. There is a form available that has questions regarding disaster preparedness.

This webpage also has club publicity tools. Clubs are encouraged to use the AKC logo. There is also a section on public education and school education.

The proposed amendment to Chapter 14, of Field Trial and Standard Procedure for Pointing Breeds – Rules for Pointing Breed Field Trials, which would add verbage establishing minimum standards for National Championship events was passed.

The following was read, printed in the GAZETTE and will be voted on at the September Delegate Meeting:

- 1. AKC's Charter and Bylaws, which would eliminate Board term limits.
- Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Dachshunds Entry Requirements and Eligibility.
- Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Basset Hounds Entry Requirements and Eligibility.
- Beagle Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Large Pack Field Trials – Entry Requirements and Eligibility.
- Beagle Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Small Pack Option and Two-Couple Pack Hunting Tests Field Trials – Entry Requirements and Eligibility.
 - #2-#5 will specify a minimum age of 6 months.
- Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Dachshunds Judges and Their Decisions – which would delete wording to allow officers of the club to judge.
- Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Basset Hounds which would require clubs to retain entry forms for 1 year.

Dear Dr.

As a concerned pet owner, I am extremely worried that in just a few short years, I will no longer be able to enjoy life with my pets. Under the guise of "animal welfare," animal rights groups are systematically chipping away my right to own pets and enjoy the human-animal bond.

There is a huge difference between Animal Welfare and Animal Rights.

Animal Welfare is a philosophy that advocates that people who keep and utilize animals have a moral responsibility to assure their well-being, and to protect them from abuse and unnecessary suffering. Animal Rights is a philosophy that advocates animals should be viewed as legal persons, not property, and that they should not be used in any way.

Groups such as PETA (People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals) and HSUS (Humane Society of the United States, no direct affiliation with local humane societies) conduct major political lobbying at the state and federal levels and spend millions of dollars annually to promote their agenda and to elect candidates that favor their agenda. That agenda, while couched in terms of animal welfare, is, in many cases, designed to restrict and eliminate a pet owner's right to own animals.

Eliminating the right to own pets will severely affect your veterinary practice...

Animal Rights organizations spend millions of dollars a year lobbying politicians. Breed restrictions, early spay and neuter, crop and dock bans, are all examples of legislation which limits and eliminates pet ownership, community by community, state by state. These groups feel pet ownership, livestock, food animals, hunting, medical research, zoos, circuses, rodeos, horse shows, dog shows, cat shows, bird shows, guide dogs, service dogs, police dogs, and search and rescue dogs are all "exploitation" of animals and attempt to end them. They also chip away at the rights of pet owners and their veterinarians to determine the proper veterinary treatment of their pets' health and welfare.

Laws banning ear cropping, tail docking, debarking, declawing, or enforcing early spay and neuter protocols attempt to dictate how you practice medicine. These are surgical procedures that should be decided on a medical case by case basis in the best interest of the animal patient, between you, the veterinarian, and me, the pet owner - not a politician.

I believe that veterinary medical decisions should be made by veterinarians and pet owners, not by politicians...

Animal Rights groups encourage politicians to enact both drastic and seemingly insignificant changes to current legislation. They play to our emotional, not factual based decisions.

The "owner" vs. "guardian" issue is a perfect example. While on the surface, replacing the term "owner" with "guardian" in legislation seems to be innocuous, kind-hearted, and a gentler term to use, in reality, it takes away a pet owner's property rights to own, breed, and even provide veterinary care for their pet. Once a pet owner is deemed a "guardian," it opens the door for third parties to step in, on behalf of the pet, and override decisions made on behalf of the pet, including veterinary care.

Imagine having to get permission from not only the pet owner, but a third party "guardian" whenever you recommend a medical procedure. Imagine having your medical

protocol questioned in the local courts when a "guardian" decides to intercede and files an injunction on behalf of the pet to prohibit your recommended course of treatment.

Continuing to allow Animal Rights groups to influence local legislation is harmful to our rights as pet owners and your rights to determine how you practice veterinary medicine.

This directly affects your ability to both practice veterinary medicine and earn a living. Without a pet population, veterinary medicine would be severely limited, if not totally destroyed.

As a veterinarian, and a respected member of our community, your involvement is crucial in the fight against anti-pet legislation.

Two great sources of information on how to battle this type of legislation are the NAIA (National Animal Interest Alliance) and the American Kennel Club.

The NAIA (www.naiaonline.org) is an association of business, agricultural, scientific, and recreational interests dedicated to promoting animal welfare, supporting responsible animal use, and strengthening the bond between humans and animals. Their members are pet owners, dog and cat clubs, obedience clubs, and rescue groups, as well as breeders, trainers, veterinarians, research scientists, farmers, fishermen, hunters, and wildlife biologists. Through the NAIA and the NAIA Trust (www.naiatrust.org) whose mission is to promote the welfare of animals, strengthen the human-animal bond and safeguard the rights of responsible animal owners, enthusiasts and professionals through education, legislation and the courts. Their websites are filled with facts, figures, and sample talking points to help you become an expert advocate.

The American Kennel Club (AKC) Government Relations Department (www.akc.org/canine_legislation) is dedicated to protecting the rights of all dog owners, recognizing that advocacy works best when those who are directly affected by the legislation take the lead in working with policy makers. With 125 years of experience in the study and welfare of dogs, the AKC is a leading expert on responsible dog ownership, care, well-being, and public policy issues that pertain to dog ownership. The primary role of the AKC in the area of canine public policy is educational and informational. There is a wealth of information available to you to support the fight against anti-dog legislation.

Animal Rights legislation affects all of us that love our pets. Not only does it affect the pet owner, but the pet industry as a whole, including veterinary medicine, groomers, trainers, pet stores, and breeders.

We can't let the benefits of the human and animal bond be taken away from us. We must all work together to preserve our life with animals. As pet owners, we rely on you, our veterinarian, to be there for our pets' medical needs, and to counsel us on their health and well-being. We are already engaged in this battle with the Animal Rights groups. We need your help!

Grass roots efforts at the local level are what win the battles against this type legislation. Get involved. Go to your city or county commission meetings. Facts and figures coming from you, the veterinarian, create far greater impact than from pet owners alone. After all, most city commissioners, county commissioners, and legislators own pets, and trust their veterinarian. You are the expert on veterinary care. They will listen to you.
