Obedience had 10 dogs entered with 16 entries. Rally had 6 dogs entered, with a total of 9 entries. Agility had over 30 dogs entered, with 21 handlers participating.

A new feature this year was a Pictorial of previous Best of Breed Winners of the NSS, organized and executed by Peggy Snider.

Wednesday morning was busy with the completion of the show setup. The afternoon Rally trial was judged by Mrs. Helen Smith. Rally High Combined and High Triple was Ch Brookewood's Just Give Me a Chance CD REA TKI CAA CGC BN bred and owned by Cindy Miller, Russ Walborn, & Karen Brown. Following the trial, there was an obedience/rally pizza party, sponsored by Ann Harris and Cindy Miller in honor of their dogs winning High in Trial and Rally High Combined in 2018, respectively.

Thursday morning had some well-behaved Obedience trial entries, with High in Trial going to GCHG Hope's Exceeding The Speed Limit UDX OM2 owners Nancy Hewitt and Douglas Tighe under judge Mrs Helen Smith. Congratulations to handler/trainer Nancy and the talented Cruise!

Following the obedience trial, breeder/judge Mrs. Jessica Carlson evaluated the Sweepstakes entries. Tough to sort through many lovely entries, but Mrs. Carlson decided to award Best in Sweepstakes to the lovely female Tonan Magicbrit Hope Sassenach At Show Me, bred by Nancy & Anthony Morabito, Douglas Tighe, and Peter Marsh, owned by Robert P Crisler & Joy Crisler, and lovingly owner/handled by Pat. Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes was awarded to Sovereign's Judge N Jury, bred by Dawn & Joe Droel, owned by Marcia Lawrence, and beautifully handled by Colleen Walsh. Sweepstakes was followed by a fun "toss the duck" game, played in the ring, several winners received dog toys and dog beds.

Friday started with the ABC Town Hall Meeting, a great place for folks to ask questions about the American Brittany Club.

The Regular Dog Classes started with life-long breeder/judge Mrs. Debbie Melgreen presiding. There were 24 class dogs in 5 classes. Mrs Melgreen found her Winners Dog in the bred-by class, Hope's Pushin' The Limit bred by Douglas Tighe & Clint & Karen Livingston, owned by Nancy Hewitt & Doug Tighe, and wonderfully handled by Doug. The non-regular dog classes are always fun to judge. During the lunch break we had another fun game, the collar toss, with more fun prizes. Then Mrs. Melgreen continued on to the Regular Bitch Classes, from which she had 33 females to choose from. Nutritional Do's & Don'ts For Bird Dogs

DO ADJUST THE AMOUNT OF FOOD BASED ON THE SEASON. During the winter months, a dog need nearly 7 percent more calories for every 10 degrees the temperature drops below the mild temperatures of spring and fall. Likewise, in the summer, a dog needs about 7 percent fewer calories for every 10-degree rise above spring and fall's moderate temperatures.

DON'T FEED BEFORE EXERCISE. Because complete digestion takes from 20 to 24 hours, you should feed your dog the night before a hunt or training and conditioning session. A dog fed six hours or sooner before exercise results in the body's fat-burning enzymes not being optimized, which contributes to reduced endurance and energy generation.

DO FEED A PERFORMANCE DOG FOOD YEAR-ROUND. It is best to feed your hardworking dog a performance food year-round to help maximize training and conditioning, though you should reduce the amount fed if your dog's activity level decreases during the off-season.

DON'T ALWAYS FEED THE SAME AMOUNT OF

FOOD. During the first four to six weeks of conditioning, food quantity should increase but then level off and decline slightly. Each dog is an individual, so you should always adjust the amount of food fed to maintain your dog's ideal body condition.

DO FEED ONCE A DAY. This allows a dog time to completely digest his or her food. A young dog or high-maintenance dog requiring a larger portion of food can be fed twice a day with a slightly smaller portion in the morning.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT IDEAL BODY CONDITION. Always feed your dog an appropriate amount of food to maintain ideal body condition, meaning you should be able to feel the ribs and see an abdominal tuck from the side.

DO PROVIDE PLENTY OF WATER. A dog should be well-hydrated, as exercise is a heat-producing activity, and water is required to dissipate heat. Water also is needed to remove the byproducts of energy metabolism, which is essential to endurance and performance.

The Mid-Florida Brittany Club was pleased to host the American Brittany Club 72nd Field and 57th Show Futurity at the Perry Plantation January 12 - 13, 2020.

We were honored to host our wonderful Brittany Breeders and owners and to watch these beautiful young dogs compete in the Show and the Field.

The road to the Futurity begins with a Breeder's thoughtful planning and research long before a litter is ever whelped. It begins with hopes and dreams for their breeding program and the desire to better and preserve our breed. It then comes to be in the whelping box with a nominated litter.

Finally, all the thoughtful planning and work come together and can be seen in a Breeder's next generation of young dogs. The Futurity events give these breeders the opportunity to showcase the future of their Breeding program in both the show ring and the field.

We would like to thank all of our Breeders for recognizing the importance of thoughtful and purposeful breeding. THANK YOU for your participation in the time-honored practice of a Futurity Program.

We held the ABC Eastern Futurity Show on Sunday afternoon, outdoors on the grounds of the Perry Plantation in Gainesville, FL. It was a beautiful set up to see these young sporting dogs in a large, outdoor ring.

Futurity Show

The judge for the ABC Eastern Futurity Show was Dr. Mary Lynn Jensen, PhD. Dr. Jensen has been active in the sport of purebred dogs for over 30 years, as a breeder, handler, instructor and judge. She has bred a long list of Champions and performance dogs from her own kennel and is active in several non-sporting, sporting and hound breeds. She is regularly invited to judge at sweepstakes and specialty events. She has been a long-time mentor to many junior handlers and continues to teach conformation class at her local kennel club, in addition to her career in the field of education. We were pleased to have her judge these young dogs and appreciated her eye for form AND function in our breed.

We had a nice line up of young dogs in the ring, three lovely young males and a large, competitive line up of female dogs. Seven of the dogs ran in the field the next day and were contenders for the Dual Dog Award.

All three of the young males were beautiful dogs and made for tough judging. The two junior males, Sovereign's Judge N Jury "JJ" (owned by Marcia Lawrence and bred and handled by Dawn Droel) and Turning Points One Way or Another DS "Wayland" (owned and handled by Meredith Kendall and bred by Julie Nelson) went head to head in the Junior Males class and were placed in that order.

Next in the ring was the liver and white Senior Male, Ch Labyrinth Head Over Heels "Tumble" who quickly caught the attention of the judge. (Owned by Erica Behnke and bred and handled by Karen Hanson). He placed 1st Money Male ahead of 2nd Money Male Sovereign's Judge N Jury and 3rd Money Male Turning Points One Way or Another DS.

We then had a beautiful line up of females enter the ring. There were just two Junior Females, Sigbrit's Oh the Possibilities "Leia" (Owned by Bobbie Sigmund and Suzanna Hofert Larson, bred and handled by Bobbie Sigmund) who also competed in the field portion of the Futurity, and Labyrinth Sandridge Singing in the Rain "Agnes" (Owned by Karen

Hanson and Reva Dickson, bred and handled by Karen Hanson). After careful examination, the judge placed Agnes ahead of Leia in the Junior Female class.

There were three lovely females entered in Intermediate Class, all of whom were also entered in the Field trial. Rebel flame Victory Bullet "Tori" (Owned and handled by Mary Tyson, bred by Christopher Fjeld) was awarded 1st Place in the class, followed by the snappy tri-colored female Diamond Hill Magnum Martini "Lizzy" (Owned and handled by Lisa Pollock, bred by Laurie O'Donnell) for 2nd place in the class and Kinwashkly Surprise 4 Sigbrits "Sunny" (Owned and handled by Bobbie Sigmund, bred by Leslie Andreas) for 3rd in the class.

It was another competitive class in the Senior Females, with Shamrock's Just Like Fire - "Alli" striding to 1st place in the class (Owner Nancy Jurkiewicz, breeder Darlene VanHoeve). She was followed by Ch Labyrinth Champagne Wishes of Shinoak - "Glitter" (Owned, bred and handled by Karen Hanson), and Pursuit's Li'l Phoenix - "Phoebe" (Owned by Jay Hallaron, bred by Beverly Haynes) in a tight race for 1st place.

It was a hotly contested round of judging for the Female Money placements. The 1st place dogs in each of the classes are brought back in, followed by the reserve of each placement, always with three under judgement at one time.

It was a lovely line up, but at the end of the day, 1st Money Female was awarded to Rebel flame Victory Bullet - "Tori" (Owned and handled by Mary Tyson, bred by Christopher Fjeld) from the Intermediate Class, 2nd Money Female went to Shamrock's Just Like Fire - "Alli" (Owned by Nancy Jurkiewicz, bred by Darlene Van Hoeve) from the Senior Class, and 3rd Money Female was awarded to Diamond Hill Magnum Martini "Lizzy" (Owned and handled by Lisa Pollock, bred by Laurie O'Donnell), also from the Intermediate Class.

Once the dogs were all placed, it was time for the final placements and the awards of Best in Futurity Show and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Futurity Show. Gun Dog Futurity

As dawn broke and the day started, the weather was very warm for this time of year with little breeze blowing on certain parts of the course. The sky was partly cloudy for most of the day but was warm for the dogs when the sun did shine. Dogs, handlers, and the judges were eagerly ready to get the running started. The Gun Dog Stake was the first stake to start around 8:00 am, while the All Age Stake started around 11:00 am with the day getting warmer fast.

BRACE 1: Sovereign's Judge and Jury "JJ" handled by Dawn Droel and Turning Points One Way or Another "Wayland" handled by Meredith Kendall. Both dogs started the brace looking to be on a bird finding mission. JJ had his first bird along the first tree line on the left with nice intensity and a few excited steps at the 1-minute mark. Working along

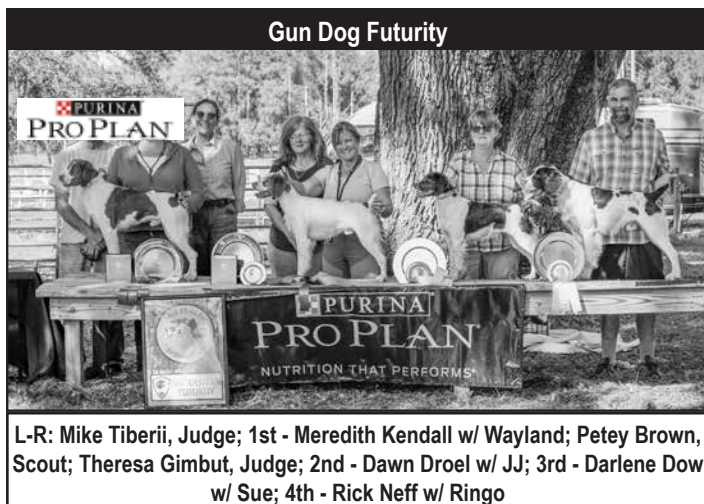
the same tree line JJ worked hard on scent to locate the bird standing with good style on point. Moving forward along the course JJ was seen up ahead on a very intense point at 14 minutes at the end of the first pines. At 22 minutes along the end of the second pines JJ slammed on point, bird went up before the handler arrived to flush and JJ went with the bird for a bit before coming back to Dawn. JJ shortened up a bit after the last bird to hunt for more, then handled well and cast out to hit the last edge moving forward going away.

Wayland had a good start like a nice running derby should do. Moving ahead quickly and hitting the edges close, Wayland was awarded with a very intense hard point at 13 minutes on the uneven hill. Along the hill just before the right turn to the first pines, Wayland was looking really nice on his second bird with a tight intense point, then held for his handler to flush the bird at 14. Going along the course quickly reaching to the front, at 16 Wayland was again seen on a stylish point where birds were produced. Then sent forward on the course, Wayland went with a wild flush into the woods, and got hung up a bit before handling kindly back to his handler, then quickly racing back to the front. Running in a snappy animated fashion along the course, Wayland slammed on point at 26 minutes at the end of the second pines. Birds up and away, slight delayed chase with Wayland coming back with a bird to retrieve to hand for his handler. Wayland was then sent on where he was seen finishing with a strong forward race to the finish.

BRACE 2: Dog was moved to the end when her bracemate scratched.

BRACE 3: Sigbrit's Oh the Possibilities "Leia" handled by Bobbie L. Sigmund and Boudreaux's Scattergun Sue "Sue" handled by Darlene Dow. Leia started out slow, acted birdy at the 9-minute mark but this area is where Sue already had her first bird find. Leia keep the slow pace at spots along the course, yet still maintained a moderate run which resulted in a nice covey find at the big island of trees in the center of the big hay field after the coming through the woods at 26 minutes. Leia finished the brace moving forward handling kindly with her handler. Sue's first find found her standing tall at just 30 seconds into the brace. Along the tree line Sue had finds at 4 and 5 minutes while hunting hard down the tree row. At the 8-minute mark Sue was seen on an intense stylish point, a small covey was flushed and Sue was sent on. Sue continued running the edges nicely and was found at 9 in the first field from the back of the manor house looking good on point. Sue continued to hunt hard the entire time she was on the course, had a slightly shortened range, but handled well and finished strong going away.

BRACE 4: Cimmaron Trails the Drummer Beat "Ringo" handled by Rick Neff and Rebel flame Victory Bullet "Tori" handled by Mary Tyson. Ringo and Tori started out well on the course. Ringo's first bird was at the 5-minute mark and had him standing on a stylish point at the corner of the pines before the turn back to the start of the stake. At 11 Ringo had a very nice stop to flush, sent on to bring a bird back to the handler along the tree line on the left. His next find was 18 at the end of the big field along the fence with Ringo looking good on point. Casting out quickly to the front rewarded Ringo with his final bird at 20 standing tall on a good intense point. Ringo was still moving nicely but shortened up his race a bit at the end. Tori, running along the course had a stop to flush at 5 minutes, then bumped a bird and the chase was on. Coming back on course, Tori's next bird contact was at 11 minutes when she had a stop to flush. Hunting on the edge at 18, Tori was seen on an intense point with good bird manners. Continuing along the course on the left side of the pines, Tori, looking a bit tired, but stood well when the birds flushed up and away on their own. Tori ran a moderate pace for a very nice trained derby gun dog.

BRACE 1: Pursuits's Lil' Phoenix "Phoebe" handled by Jay Hallaron and Diamond Hill Magnum Martini "Lizzy" handled by Lisa Pollock. Both dogs started out well with Phoebe going to the front quickly. Phoebe was running the course mainly independent, but at 2 minutes her first find, she was found her standing tall and tight and stayed through the covey flushed by her handler. At 17 Phoebe was seen pointed very intensely at the tall tree spot on a single bird. Moving on to the front fast and making some very nice side casts Phoebe was running willfully along the course. At 18 minutes, Phoebe nailed a covey of 25 birds where they kept flushing, a few birds at a time, near the lane where the downed woodpile was located. Phoebe not sure which bird to watch as they flushed, still looking good on each point she made. Phoebe then continued to apply herself on the course hunting strongly the entire time, had a consistent race throughout the brace, and handled the Florida heat the best. Lizzy's range was a nice gun dog race but made some wide casts to have a good find at 2 minutes with a nice solid point. Moving forward and hitting the edges, Lizzy was found on a stylish point at 17 looking good. Going to the front, Lizzy had good application on the course, but a shorter range than her bracedmate. Lizzy ran with heart but the Florida heat took its toll on this young dog with a bright future.

BRACE 2: Kinwashkly Surprise 4 Sigbrits "Sunny" handled by Bobbie L. Sigmund and Diamond Hill Dangerous Dark Side "Borden" handled by Lisa Pollock. Sunny and Borden started off with Borden taking to the front fast. Borden was standing tall on point with great style at the 1-minute mark near the start, handler looked but no birds were produced. Borden was sent on the course where she quickly went forward hitting the edges and staying out in front with a very pleasing consistent race. Pointing intensely at 7, Borden handled her bird with good manners. At 27 Borden was seen with a very intense point in the woods on the left at the end of the long field before the water barrels. Birds were flushed and Borden hunted hard looking for them again just before time was called.

Borden had good all age forward reaching casts, very good range, very stylish on her birds, and was the most consistent throughout the all age braces. Sunny started slow and was short for most of the brace but opened up a bit toward the end. Taking an edge to the gap, Sunny crossed the big field and went on point for her first bird at 17 minutes near the palm tree area that held birds for most of the day. A single bird was flushed. Sunny opened up on the course and took the left side edge down the long field, stayed on it to the end, and at 29 minutes was seen intensely on point with a covey flushed by her handler just before pick up.

BRACE 3: Diamond Hill Dangerous Odds "Whit" handled by Lisa Pollock. Whit ran by himself which is always harder on derby dogs without competition. Whit ran forward and was on point at 2 minutes in a known bird spot, he was relocated but no birds were produced. Moving nicely on the course at 12 where the first pines are located, Whit went on a nice point, was relocated and hunted well, but was moved on with no birds flushed. Whit, then working hard on bird scent, slammed on a very stylish point, stayed on point while his handler flushed up a bird at the 17-minute mark. Whit's range was short for an all age race and was a bit tired at the end of the brace in the heat.

Following placements for both the Gun Dog stake and the All age stake, the points were tallied up for the Dual Dog Award. It was a close one, with many of the dogs who placed in the show event running and placing in the field. We were proud to announce that the winner of the 2020 ABC Eastern Futurity Dual Dog Award was Sovereign's Judge N Jury "JJ". Owner: Marcia Lawrence; Breeder: Dawn and Joe Droel. JJ was awarded 2nd Money Male in the Show and 2nd in the Gun Dog Stake. He was handled in both the show and field by his breeder Dawn Droel. It was an exciting moment for us all!

Versatile Brittanys in Action

Stay at Home Dog Dogsports?

With many dog competitions cancelled due to COVID-19, and classes either on hold or reduced in class size, many Brittany owners are looking for new ways to keep busy at home.

AKC FitDog, Trick Dog and Rally Novice Virtual Pilot Programs

The American Kennel Club has stepped up, making many resources available on the useful web page: <https://www.akc.org/press-center/covid-19-updates-from-the-american-kennel-club/>, ranging from informal games to remote titling in dogsports.

For example, if you live somewhere where it is safe for you and your dog to walk outdoors every day, check out AKC's Fit Dog program. Check your local regulations and maintain at least six feet of distance between anyone else you may pass on your walk. For the program you and your dog commit to walking each day either:

1. Walked at least 30 minutes 5 times per week for a total of at least 150 minutes per week for at least 3 months. For dogs and people in good shape.
2. Walked at least 15 minutes per session at least 10 times per week (e.g., two 15-min walks per day) for at least 3 months. For dogs or people who would benefit from a walk that is a shorter duration, e.g., senior dogs.

Small groups can walk together, for a fun outing where each dog and handler participate at their own skill level and achieve your fitness goals.

If you are staying inside your own home, check out the AKC Trick Dog Program. Watch videos showing how to train your dog to perform the tricks. For example, in the AKC Novice Trick Dog (TKN), applicants perform 10 tricks such as:

1. Balance beam	8. Down, Sit, or Come on Hand Signal
2. Bark on cue ("Speak")	9. High five
3. Crawl (dog on belly, crawls at least 3 body lengths)	10. Hold (3 seconds)
4. Fetch it (ball, etc., 10 ft. away, bring to handler within 2 ft)	11. Jump (thru a low hoop or over a low bar)
5. Find it (find treat or scent item hidden under 1 cup or object)	12. Kennel up (go in crate, stay in until released)
6. Get your Leash	13. Kiss (point to cheek or back of hand)
7. Sit in the Box)	14. Push-ups (sit, down, sit, down, sit, down)
	15. Spin in circle, etc.

Tape your dog performing the tricks and sends a video (via a link) to a Canine Good Citizen Evaluator for evaluation. If your dog already has their Canine Good Citizen (CGC) title, you only need to do 5 tricks.

If you are interested in obedience, the AKC Rally Novice Virtual Pilot Program allows you to set up a pre-designed AKC Rally® course in the safety of your own yard, record the performance and submit it to

AKC. AKC will assign a pre-selected AKC Rally Judge to virtually review and score your performance. Note this pilot program concludes at Midnight, December 31, 2020

At Home Agility League, Agility Association of Canada

The Agility Association of Canada has introduced a fun “at home” league with three levels and two courses at each level per week. Courses will be starters, advanced and masters equivalent on a 40x40 grid using one tunnel and three jumps.



Participants will have the option to pay to have their videoed runs judged or just purchase the course maps. We hope that everyone will choose to join in the fun. The championship was run at Lake Murray Field Trial grounds near Ardmore, Oklahoma. Lake Murray was the first state park in Oklahoma. Trials have been run on these grounds for sixty plus years. The lake was full and running over the spillway and the grounds were wet and muddy.

We had two competent judges to adjudicate the championship. Jon Humphrey and Austin Bryant, both are from the area around Claremore, Oklahoma. They have a lot of experience in training, running, and scouting dogs. Even if we knew how, we couldn't have "pulled the wool" over them.

The championship drew twenty dogs. Most were not up to the challenge but two excelled. The bottom dog in brace 3 was Sundance Kid's Rule Breaker, call name "Bud". He is a young dog owned and handled by Frank Campbell. The brace broke away at Lem Roberts road headed for the Girl Scout point. "Bud" handled the Girl Scout, across Pond Dam 1 and around Tent Pad point like an experienced hand. He maintained a forward moderate race notching several well-mannered finds. This performance earned him and Frank the Runner Up honors.

The last brace of the championship had A Trace of Bourbon With Diamonds with owner Rick Hastings handling braced with MK's My Little Ammo handled by owner Nick Blasi. This was quite a brace dominated by big moves and multiple finds by both dogs. The best find of the championship was by Diamond. He

was found standing to the front on a limb find on the west side of Rocky Crossing meadow.

This meadow later came into play again. After manipulating the difficult West Country, both dogs entered the meadow, Diamond established point on the east side of the meadow and Ammo 's brakes failed ending a strong bid. Diamonds quarry was flushed and Hasting fired his cannon. Diamond finished well and was named Champion.

We will take this opportunity to thank all of the people that pitched in to help make this championship a success: Scot Johnson, Ed Tilson, Richard Beaver, and all the participants. Last but very importantly, PURINA. THEY MAKE THE VERY BEST DOG AND HORSE FEED ON THE MARKET!!!!

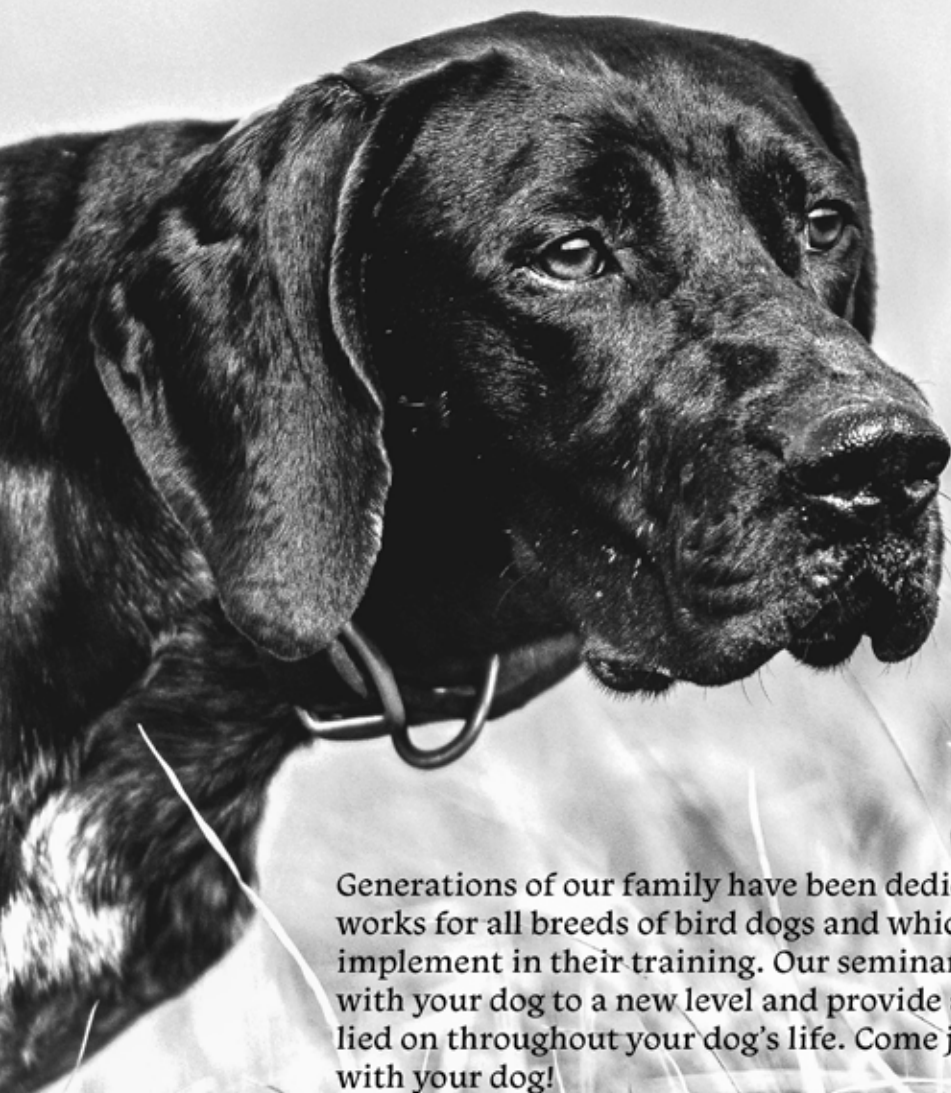

The *Brittany Bites* Recipe Collection

Grilled Pheasant with Raspberry Balsamic Vinaigrette

1 pheasant, split in half
1 tbs olive oil
Salt and pepper to taste
Raspberry Balsamic Vinaigrette (see recipe below)

Turn grill on to direct medium high. Rub pheasant all over with olive oil and sprinkle well with salt and pepper on both sides. Grill, turning occasionally for 20 minutes. Liberally brush Raspberry Balsamic Vinaigrette on both sides of pheasant and continue grilling 10 minutes, basting on more vinaigrette several times. Grill until pheasant is cooked through, and internal temperature is 165 when tested with a digital read thermometer.

Raspberry Vinaigrette

1 lb. raspberries, fresh or thawed
1/4 cup water
3/4 cups white sugar
1/4 cup apple cider vinegar
2 Tbs. balsamic vinegar
1 1/2 Tbs. Dijon mustard

Gently rinse then drain raspberries. Place the berries in a saucepan with the water. Bring to a boil then simmer uncovered for 10 minutes until very soft. Puree the raspberries – either manually, using an immersion blender, or in a food processor or blender. (Remove seeds if you wish using a fine sieve or food mill).

Measure the remaining ingredients into the pan with the raspberries. Heat on medium until the sugar has dissolved, whisking every few minutes. Bring to a gentle boil (bubbling steadily) and boil for 10 minutes. Remove from heat.

Immediately spoon the hot sauce into hot jars, leaving a 1/4 " head-space. Remove bubbles, wipe rims and seal.

Process in a boiling water bath canner for 10 minutes - start the timer once the water comes to a full boil. When the time is up, turn the heat off and rest the jars in the water for 5 minutes before placing on a towel on your kitchen counter-top.

Yield: Five (5) 4-ounce jars or two (2) 8-ounce and one (1) 4-ounce jar

Honey-Mustard Brussels Sprouts Salad

1 pound fresh Brussels sprouts, trimmed and shredded
2 medium tart apples, chopped
1 medium red onion, chopped
1 small sweet orange pepper, chopped
1/2 cup chopped walnuts
1/2 cup green grapes, sliced
1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese
3 bacon strips, cooked and crumbled
1/4 cup olive oil
2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
2 tablespoons honey mustard
1 garlic clove, minced
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper

In a large bowl, combine the first 8 ingredients. In a small bowl, whisk remaining ingredients. Pour over salad; toss to coat. 10 Servings

“Howard’s been running out west. I guess we’re coming east to run in a couple of championships. I hear you’ve been doing pretty good.”

“They’ve been talking about you around here, too. How’d you do today?”

“Couple of finds, a back and a non-productive.”

They discussed the location of their finds and of Alf’s non-productive.

Dusty continued, “I had a find right there and that bird jumped and flew about three feet. He should have still been in there.”

“He was. I had him from a long way off and Howard goes in there with one of his great flushing performances. I don’t know when he’s going to learn that he doesn’t have to see the thing. Just make it fly.”

I’m trying to concentrate in here, and besides, if it’s so easy, you get in here and find him. I’ve already had this bird pointed twice.’ You’re a lucky dog, Dusty. You’ve got a good handler.”

Suddenly, the parking lot was alive as an early pick up came in at the end of a check chord. Dogs stretched to the ends of their chains and Dusty and Alf joined in, their front feet bouncing up and down, barking with excitement.

It was time for chores. The two jumped up to the ends of their chains and greeted their human companions. They would lie out after dinner and listen to the laughter and applause from the clubhouse. Their owners would come out of the clubhouse with a ribbon or not and put them up for the night.

2020 ABC Health Survey

The Health & Genetics Committee invites your participation in the 2020 ABC Health survey. The last survey was done in 2003 so it is important to find out if any new health issues have arisen and if the previously recognized ones are still significant. In order to serve our breed, it is important that all Brittany owners participate.

The findings published in past studies have guided the research funds which the Foundation and the Health Committee commit to scientific studies. Only by surveying the current state of health in our breed are we able to determine which health issues are of most significance today.

This survey will be analyzed and recorded for ABC by the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA). All information submitted is confidential and numbers are used only in aggregate.

Please use a separate survey form for each Brittany you have owned, living or deceased. As you complete a survey for each dog, simply restart a new one for the next dog you are reporting.

In order to complete the survey you will need information regarding your dog's health. Your veterinarian will be able to supply you with a list of issues your dog has had diagnosed, so that you are able to use the diagnosis listed under each category. Whenever possible, please use a veterinary diagnosis. There is a box under every category where you can add a diagnosis if it is not listed. You will need to indicate which vaccines your dog has had, and what flea/tick and heartworm preventative you use. You will be asked what health clearances your dogs have, so have your certificates at hand for each dog.

This is a very comprehensive survey. It may take you 20-30 minutes to complete, especially for the first dog you submit. In many instances, if you answer "yes" there are other questions that will populate.

Please share the link to this survey with every Brittany owner you know. ALL Brittany owners are invited to participate in order to make this survey as valid, valuable and complete as possible. This is very important for the present and future health of the breed and we appreciate your efforts and contributions.
