2020 National Gun Dog Championship

December 5th - 9th, 2020

Booneville, Arkansas

As we gathered in Booneville for this year's National Championships, 2020 continued to be a year of challenges to say the least; rain, mud, a Covid-19 necessitated judging change and social distancing requirements, tried their best to complicate things. A quality event was achieved due to the extraordinary efforts and dedication of all involved! Bob Burchett and I are grateful to everyone who attended and supported this event as well as all who lent a hand to facilitate it's running.

We greatly appreciate the efforts and commitment of our judges to allow each dog and handler the best opportunity to showcase their abilities. Andrew Campbell, from Massachusetts and Chad Chadwell from Illinois spent their time in the saddle with an attentive eye and positive attitude in selecting their Champion and placing dogs. Their keen eyes honed by years of running Vizslas allowed them both to pick out dogs at times when even the handlers weren't certain of their charge's location.

This and many other events would not be possible if not for the continued support of our corporate sponsors, Purina and Garmin who

support our event and arrange for Robert Smith, the driver of the dog wagon to be on hand daily to transport our dogs and those wishing to see the event from its comfort and adventurously festive atmosphere; a place where “here’s mud in your eye” can have multiple meanings!

Brad Wells and Red Bailey from the Arkansas Game & Fish Commission work tirelessly throughout the year to groom the courses in the face of the challenges that mother nature often hurls their way at the J. Perry Mikles-Blue Mountain site. Again, this year, much of the course was under over 20 feet of water, which didn’t recede sufficiently to mow, until sometime in October. Evidence of this came in the form of multiple bobbers hanging high up in trees around the course along with a bait casting pole and reel combination that Steve Ralph recovered from climbing up a tree during the week prior! Red worked hard to play catch up on mowing that would normally have been completed before he was able to start; we cannot thank him enough and we will truly miss him when he retires this Spring.

If you’ve not spent a considerable time in Booneville, you might not know that there’s almost no options for purchasing a meal on a Sunday or Monday without driving almost into Ft. Smith.

Many thanks to Linda Thomas for undertaking the hospitality functions of the dog wagon and assuring that there were plentiful and varied snacks and beverages each morning and afternoon. Thank you to Donna Janulis and Kathy Gulembo for heading up the Calcutta records and collections tasks. We were blessed to also have the enthusiastic and skillful efforts of our auctioneer, Bill Hancock!

Our 2020 National Gun Dog Champion is Sniksoh Little Diamond – Kate; owned by Tom & Jane Wonderling of Wisconsin and handled by Scott Johnson. Kate ran in the 10th brace and was described as “having a consistent 60 mins. and 2 finds where others weren’t running. Her strong finish and impressive move leading to a find, buried up in the woods near time, completed an over-all package” which impressed our judges. Kate’s finds came at 28, 37, 39 and 55 minutes as she covered the course with a forward pattern and growing range over her hour.

Our Runner-Up Champion was K Nine’s Finale’s Way to Go – Allie, owned by Linda McDonald of California and handled by Paul Doiron. Allie ran in the 11th brace carding 3 beautiful finds, coming at 31, 37 and 43 minutes while staying forward with “impressive speed and ground work” as noted by our judges. She definitely holds your attention while on the ground and pointing her birds.

Third place went to Hope’s Chief of Crosscreek – Chief, owned by Dr. Barbara & Wayne Pepin of Indiana, along with Bob & Polly West of California, was handled by Bob Burchett. Chief also ran in the 11th



Jerry Oswald spends countless hours planting and feeding the birds from pre-release in late summer, until the last event is held in December. Without his knowledge and efforts, a quality event would be difficult to hold on these expansive grounds. At the start of our event, he released 350 birds over the 3 courses at 30 different covey sites and feeds the birds 2-3 times each week at those spots. Thanks to his consistent efforts there were multiple bird contacts in every brace irrespective of how the dogs might have handled them. He’s a gracious man who goes out of his way if necessary to make things happen; we cannot thank him enough!

We were blessed to be able to have Judi Tipton and her crew



brace, carding 3 finds and 3 gorgeous backs during his hour. His most impressive find came at 54 minutes at the conclusion of a "large move" along the 109 road grade where he was found standing with "great style and closed with a strong finish" as noted by our judges.

Fourth place went to Sonny's Hot Summer Breeze – Breezy, owned by Myra-Dawn Ellis of California, was handled by Paul Doiron. Breezy ran in the 2nd brace, carding 3 beautiful finds at 25, 47 and 53 minutes respectively. Her last stand found her dug into a mott few dogs ran to, being found with great style. She ran hard and fast, maintaining her speed throughout the hour, being very "biddable and stylish" for Paul, as noted by our judges.



The Running:

Brace 1: J&M Rodeo Romeo (Tuff) – Tillson and Blaze Away Bonita (Boo) – Burchett. This pair broke away into a frost glazed morning working independently with enthusiasm. Tuff made nice moves until he went out of pocket after the culvert crossing to not return to judgement – Ed pulled the tracker at 26 mins. Boo ran at a moderate pace and range making some really nice moves. Boo stood at 30 mins. with beautiful style and intensity through an extended flush with the covey erupting from a thin strip of cover right next to her; she finished the hour with similar pace and pattern.

Brace 2: Woodsong's Honky Tonkin Hank (Hank) – Johnson and Sonny's Hot Summer Breeze (Breezy) – Doiron. Hank ran hard with some very nice moves; his find came at 25 min. deep to the right side of the entrance to the Horseshoe section of Course 3 on a single. He continued to run fast and snappy until he dug deep into the woods after the second entrance to the Parrish Field not to return to judgement and was found way off the Wildlife Management Area. Breezy's 4th place performance is described earlier.

Brace 3: TJ's Black Diamond (Coal) – Perry and DP's Little Bit of Mayhem Mila (Mila) – Burchett. Coal and Mila took turns making nice moves, with Mila being forward and mostly on the edge, with a pleasing pattern. Coal was very flashy at times and finished several of the moves he started. Both dogs hunted hard at times though were birdless in spite of their efforts.

Brace 4: Godfather's F.N. Rockstar (Rocky) – Chang and Starlight's Mercury Out Ryder (Ryder) – Burchett. Rocky started with a very nice, early move that ended with a beautiful find at 7 mins. in an area few other dogs ran, exhibiting very nice style and intensity. While attempting to catch the front Rocky dug-in again, standing at 12 min. with similar style. Attempting to catch the front for a second time, Rocky dug-in not to return to judgement. Ryder ran well at times making some very nice moves; Bob called it a day at 38 mins. as Ryder was not giving his best effort.



Brace 5: Just Call Me Eli (Eli) – Merrill and Romence's Life of Riley (Riley) – Burchett. Eli was flying from the start and looked very nice on point and made very nice moves during the hour. He had a beautiful find on a covey at 30 min. and stood again at 45 when he experienced some lousy luck. After a long and thorough flushing attempt, Kyle spotted a hawk kill and elected to move on, flushing a covey as Eli was collared. Riley was fast and forward through the entire brace making many nice moves. She was found dug-in on point at 38 minutes with beautiful style and intensity throughout, with birds flushed over her head. Riley was posted by the judges for her performance.



Brace 6: High Hopes Jac's Original Spice (Spice) – Gulembo and Saradac's Dangerous Diamond Caper (Caper) – Pollock. Caper got to work immediately, establishing point at the first available mott at the 1 min. mark. Lisa produced birds after a lengthy flush and relocation effort. Caper had another covey find at 45 min. and stood again at 50 ending in a stop-to-flush on relocation. Caper backed Spice's covey find at 10 mins. on her own which was stunning; she made some nice moves during her hour. Spice exhibited beautiful style and intensity on her covey and her over-all run had an ebb and flow to it, adjusting to the cover. Her most memorable move was rimming the large field coming off Gas Well Hill all the way forward and across the road, then staying mostly on the woods edge in a winding

pattern from then until the end of the hour. Both of these dogs were posted by the judges for their efforts.



Brace 7: Sniksoh Hank's Hatch (Hatch) – Burchett and Marjo's Fille De La Bretagne (Brie) – Goldman. Hatch was slow to start, running well at times, with a pattern that was improving over the hour; he went birdless. Brie had a nice run, exhibiting speed and nice bird work at 13 mins. standing just past the culvert crossing. She stood again at 35 mins. suffering a breach of manners after an extremely long flushing effort, ending her bid.

Brace 8: Shailorville's Gunner (Gunner) – Merrill and Leona Valley's Sonny Red Side Up (Red) – Doiron. Gunner had his running shoes on, with a far flung pattern, making big moves and was out of pocket at times. He stood at 45 mins. to card a nice find, then went missing into the woods, popped out across the 109 road bed and dove into the woods deep again until after time. Red ran hard and fast across the front, coursing from objective to objective, carding a nice find at 37 mins. He suffered 2 non-productive stands in the final 15 mins. to end his bid.

Brace 9: Pretty Blue Eyes A Sweet Touch of Charlie B (Charlie) – Bakas and Lapat's Cody (Cody) – Cropek. Charlie was fast and forward, making some nice moves and digging deep into the cover when he was allowed to roll. Charlie went birdless for his efforts and this rookie pair of dog and handler will definitely be back! Cody had a nice run with some really big moves and 2 nice finds. His first at 15 mins. and his last coming at 40 mins. after a really big move after Gas Well Hill, being found standing high and tight along the bottom edge of the large field there.

Brace 10: Shiloh's Sailing The West Wind (Zee) – Foster and Sniksoh Little Diamond (Kate) – Johnson. Zee got off to a slow start with his pattern improving with time. He had nice back at 37 mins. and a beautiful find at 50 mins. before the Double Gates. After his find, Zee made a big move hunting along the river's edge and remained on an edge until time. Kate's National Championship winning performance was recorded earlier.

Brace 11: Hopes Chief of Crosscreek (Chief) – Burchett and K Nine's Finale's Way To Go (Allie) – Doiron. Both dogs' placing

performances are recorded earlier.

Brace 12: Waypoint Chancey Big White Cooper (Big White) – Merrill and Hoochie Coochie Man (Karl) – Tillson. Big White ran hard, fast and was far reaching in his pattern. After heading towards the Double Gates, he came around and stood beautifully at 12 mins. on a covey. Upon release he carded a non-productive at 14 mins. after which he remained forward for Kyle until a second non-productive ended his day at the 44 min. mark. Karl had 2 beautiful backs and carded 2 covey finds at 15 & 28 minutes respectively. His pattern improved with time & separation taking many flowing lines and edges to their completion. His day ended when he suffered a second non-productive at 52 mins.

Brace 13: Thomas' Dixie (Dixie) – Cropek and Cross Creek Sovereign Pop-A-Top (Jackson) – Burchett. Dixie was slow to start rolling then started making nice moves, one of which culminated in her only find at 26 mins. She took off after her find and dug deep into the left side requiring the tracker to find her ending her bid at 37 mins. Jackson made nice moves from the start; he carded a non-productive at 34 mins. and a beautiful find at 44 minutes. He ended his hour with a nice string of moves from before the Double Gates on the edge until time was called.

Brace 14: Son Yoti's Master of Illusion (Magic) – Doiron and Atos (Atos) – Burchett. Magic ran fast with a fluid gait and forward pattern, carding 3 finds at 33, 44 & 57 mins. with nice style. He made some big moves at times, though he hung up in a few spots; he's going to be a good one as he matures! Atos made a hard charge forward from the start, working fast into the far corner past the Buzzard's Roost, last seen diving deep to not be returned to judgement. Atos's owner loves to hunt Wood Ducks at his home in Georgia; Woodies were seen with regularity in the vicinity of the Buzzard's Roost.



Brace 15: Pretty Boy Floyd (Floyd) – Chang and Chattahoochee (AJ) – Cropek. Both Floyd and AJ ran hard from start to finish during their time on the ground. They ran from objective to objective together early on; each improving in pattern and application with time. AJ had 2 clean finds, sharing his last with Floyd at 48 mins. and each looking stellar on point. Unfortunately, Floyd succumbed to temptation ending his bid. AJ continued on only to suffer a breach of manners which ended his bid at 53 mins.



Brace 16: I'm Your Man (Gus) – Lorenson and Almaden's Under Lock And Key (Oudi) – Tillson. Gus ran hard at moderate range making nice moves and showing great speed and power. He stood at 54 mins. with beautiful style, though suffered an infraction on relocation ending his bid. Oudi ran beautifully the entire time he was under judgement, staying on the edges with a pleasing pattern and manner of covering the ground. He took the right edge of the field after the road crossing and didn't return to judgement; the tracker being called for at 44 mins.

Brace 17: TNT's Sirius Renegade Buddy Boy (Buddy) – Thomas and Dreamcatcher's Wind Storm (Windy) – Merrill. Buddy ran a solid pattern for the entire hour, start to finish, with a nice back and a covey find to his credit. His pace was steady the entire hour and it was a pleasure to watch. Windy ran fast and forward for Kyle and making some really nice moves, carding a stylish find at 40 mins. Kyle elected to pick her up at the 46 min. mark as her performance was no longer pleasing him.

Brace 18: St. Clair's Prince Rocco Vulcano Leo (Rocco) – Johnson and Simon's Standing Stone (Gus) – Tillson. Rocco got right to work taking off like a shot to stand at the 1 min. mark and carding a clean find for Scott. Rocco continued making some really nice moves, then became bullish; digging deep into the woods and thick cover. He carded a second find at the 56 min. mark with all in order. As time was called, Rocco decided that he wasn't ready to call it a day and took off evading capture! Gus was running fast, exhibiting a snappy gait while running lines; always flying in search of objectives. Gus dove deep into the woods prior to the creek before the Pavilion and required the tracker at the 27 min. mark.

Brace 19: DuBois Ridge Major Maverick (Major) – Merrill and Coos Triple Six (Boomer) – Perry. Both Major and Boomer took turns making nice moves during their hour, maintaining a forward pattern at a moderate pace and range. Major carded a find with style, just prior

to the culvert crossing at the 13 minute mark. Boomer stood in the right feed strip prior to the Double Gates with style at the 52 min. mark.

Brace 20: Turning Points Shenanigans (Shandi) – Burchett and Ramblin' Gamblin' Willie (Willie) – Cropek. Shandi showed very nice speed and application over the course of her hour. She backed at 48 mins. and unfortunately ended her day birdless for the rest of her efforts. Willie is a nice young dog who exhibited great speed and a forward application, though he showed his youth and inexperience at times trying to do battle with the trip briars. His day unfortunately ended early when he suffered his second non-productive at the 50 min. mark.

Brace 21: Quail Rock Too Tough (Duke II) – Doiron and Light-em Up Louie (Louie) – Chang. Duke exhibited some very nice moves with speed and intelligence; some moments of uncertainty as well. His 4 finds were nicely handled and well located, coming at 11, 30, 38 and 44 minutes. His last find was on a huge covey where he displayed great restraint and finished his hour going away. Louie ran some nice lines, exhibiting speed and good application, with his handler firing over him at the 8 minute mark, though no birds were observed. Louie shared a divided find at 38 minutes, though unfortunately ended his day on a breach of manners.

Brace 22: Nothin' But Trouble (Trouble) – Cropek and Sundance Kid's Rocky Mountain Renegade (Rocky) – Burchett. This pair broke away independently and with purpose; Trouble on the left and Rocky on the right. Point was called for Trouble at the 7 min. mark, and trouble it was for Rocky who failed to back her there. This was carded as a non-productive and as Trouble continued from there, she experienced some of her own with a 2nd non-productive at 10 mins. ending her day.



Brace 23: M&M's Grouse Gunning Gracie (Grace) – Merrill and Supernova (Nova) – Johnson. Grace took off with great speed and strung together some impressive moves from the start. She maintained speed and purpose and on the edge, hitting the river's edge near the 109 bridge and taking it forward out of sight. Nova took some time to get rolling and when she did, she hung the edge from the Buzzard's Roost forward, crossing the front from right to left, then took the thickest trip briar patch forward to the 109 bridge. She had slowed considerably, and Scott elected to pick her up. In a display of true Sportsmanship, Scott gave his horse to Kyle whose horse was played out and unable to continue much further. Riding forward after switching mounts, Kyle eventually called for the tracker at the 35 minute mark in the back loop section. Grace was eventually found there after fighting her way forward along the river's edge!



Brace 24: Just Call Me Lucky Ned Pepper (Ned) – Campbell and Kinwashkly King Louie (Louie) – Vater. Upon breakaway, Ned took off forward along the right edge and out of sight, Frank called for the tracker at the 20 min. mark as Ned had not to be seen since his opening cast. Louie immediately hit the left rivers edge and remained forward on that side until the first turn. Point was called at the 13 min. mark where Louie stood with style having a small covey produced for him there. He continued on, growing in pattern and application, showing some impressive moves over the final half of the hour, requiring nothing more than an easy handle and a whistle of encouragement.

Brace 25: JB's Hankering For A Bird (Hank) – Johnson and Dan-De Tyghten UP (Cinch) – Chang. Hank carded 2 covey finds during his hour, standing at 14 mins. & 25 mins. respectively. His pattern and application grew over time and after his second find, became quite impressive. Cinch stood early with great style at 7 mins. though he eventually carded a non-productive after relocation. His pattern and range remained moderate through the hour and he carded a nice find with style at the 59 min. mark.

Brace 26: Gun Creek Gangster (Doc) – Janulis and Sovereign's Legendary Cowboy (Duke) – Burchett. Doc made nice moves with moderate speed and a very pleasing application during his time, digging into the woods on occasion and coming out when Donna beckoned. Shortly after entering the Parrish Field, point was called for him at the 23 min. mark. After a lengthy and diligent flushing effort, Doc showed Donna the bird upon relocation. Duke was fast and forward hanging the edges of the course and was last seen driving forward towards the river near the 109 bridge. Bob requested the tracker at the 30 min. mark when Duke failed to reappear.



Brace 27: Starlight's Calisto Moon (Cal) – Burchett. Cal was directed to the left edge upon break away and worked forward nicely with Cal standing at the 10 min. mark for a stylish find on a covey pinned out in the open. Cal wasn't pleasing his handler with his effort or pattern and Bob pulled out the rope at the 28 min. mark, bringing the 2020 National Gun Dog Championship to an end.

THE JOURNEY OF A JUNIOR HANDLER

It is my pleasure to introduce you to a talented young man who is up and coming in the dog world. Meet Colson Shanto, human half of the duo, Team Dylan Pickle #teamdylanpickle. Colson is just 15 years old and has already accomplished so much.

Colson was born with a leash in his hand and has been interested in dogs since! Colson attended his first field trial in a stroller at the young age of just 6 weeks old out at the Red Rock Field Trial grounds. Colson was passed around from dog person to dog person while his parents planted birds, ran dogs and judged for the Northern Nevada Brittany Club.

Colson developed a deep love of dogs from a very young age and was constantly on the sidelines at dog shows and field trials throughout his childhood. He grew up in a house full of wild and crazy Brittans and assisted with his first litter whelping at just 5 years old. He loved those puppies and was a very good puppy caretaker.

After watching Mom in the show ring for years, at the age of 9, it was an easy step for Colson to become a Junior Handler through the American Kennel Club. Junior Showmanship is for children 9-18, and it is the perfect way for kids interested in dogs to showcase their own dog or one that is owned by a family member. Junior Showmanship is divided into 3 age categories, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior. There are also two divisions based on experience, Novice and Open. Juniors can also compete in other AKC events, such as Hunt Tests, Field Trials, Rally, Agility, Obedience, Farm Dog, Trick Dog, and Canine Good Citizen. Colson started his Junior Showmanship journey with Mom and Dad's retired dog, Bang. The very first time Colson stepped into the ring, he won his class! He was a natural from the start. Bang was a wonderful beginner dog who knew just enough to teach but was also stubborn enough to make Colson work for it.

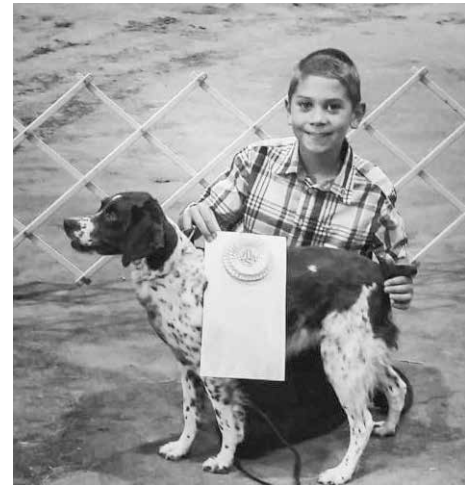
When Colson was 11, he started asking for a dog of his very own, and so the search began to find the perfect match. What is meant to be will always find a way, and so after a couple of dogs fell through for Colson, he was matched with the perfect dog for him, his beloved Dylan Pickle. Their journey together began the day after Christmas, 2016, when Dylan was just 6 months old, in the Sonoran Desert of Arizona. Longtime breeder friend Helen Riggie of Copper Canyon Brittans of Tucson, Arizona, gave Colson the gift of a lifetime. They have been inseparable since.

This young team had a rough start in both the breed ring and the Juniors ring. They had to get to know each other and become partners, rather than dog and handler. Once they figured that out, they have been unstoppable. Colson and Dylan have become a wonderful team, and so far, they have earned 5 American Kennel Club Titles: Champion, Grand Champion, Junior Hunter, Canine Good Citizen, and Farm Dog Certification. Dylan is only a few points away from being recorded as a Grand Champion Bronze, and they are working on Senior Hunter and Trick Dog titles as well. They were also awarded the 2019 Top Junior Achievement award from the American Brittany Club. They finished the very short 2020 show season Number One Junior Handled Brittany in the United States, as well as the Number Three Owner Handled Brittany in the United States. To date, they have competed together in the American Brittany Club National Specialty in Fort Smith, Arkansas, and the American Kennel Club National Championship in Orlando, Florida. Colson has set two ultimate goals for himself, the first goal is to compete with the top Juniors in the Country at Westminster, 2022. The other goal, the one that would mean the most to him, is to be awarded Best Junior Handler at the American Brittany Club National Specialty before he ages out.

To be the best, one needs to learn from the best, and Colson has had an amazing opportunity to learn from some of the best handlers in the United States, Jean Gauchat Hargis and Joshua Hargis of Summerwind Canines. Colson has assisted this team for the past year and a half. Colson has been fortunate enough to travel throughout the Western United States to learn grooming and handling from this amazing team. During COVID when there were no shows on the West Coast, they invited him to come and stay with them at their home kennel in the Sacramento Valley. During that time, he helped with landscaping, basic construction, kennel management, scheduling, training, and even helped with raising 4 litters of Pomeranian and Keeshond Puppies! It has been a wonderful and fulfilling opportunity for him, and he looks forward to continuing his education with them.

Colson has some advice to share with anyone interested in getting into dog sports. "Hard work pays off, but you have to be consistent, make it a point to spend time with your dog every day, practice something you like. You don't always win, but it feels good when you do, because all of your training comes together. The most important part of any dog sport is the connection and relationship you build with your dog. Have fun with your dog, and make sure he enjoys it. If not, try something else for a while. That's what it's all about! Good sportsmanship is also important, whether you win or lose. Always congratulate each other too. Make friends with other Juniors, because you end up relying on each other and it's like a big family. You can learn a lot from each other, and although you're competitive in the ring, it's the best to have a supportive group when you need help."

The Brittany community, the dog show world in general, and Junior Showmanship have all blessed our lives beyond measure! Thank you to everyone who has helped Colson along the way.

Fred Strawson:

Recipient of the 2020 American Brittany Club Member as an ABC Hall of Fame for Distinguished Members of ABC



Fred Strawson was selected, by the American Brittany Board Members, as an ABC Hall of Fame for distinguished Members of ABC.

In 1993 the Board of Directors for the ABC voted to form an ABC Hall of Fame for distinguished members of ABC.

Fred was nominated by his daughter, Phyllis Baker. Fred returned from challenging times serving our country in Korea in 1952 and re-started working with his beloved dogs his Brittanyes. In 1956 Fred purchased and registered his first Brittany and has registered Brittanyes for the following 64 years (and still coming).

When the quail population vanished Fred went from hunting to Field Trialing and has had many field champions since: including Second Place at the ABC National Amateur Championship in 2002.

Fred has had active leadership roles such as serving as an East Coast Director of the ABC. He also served as President and Field Trial Chairman of the Rappahannock and Tarheel Brittany Clubs.

Fred had a real skill for planning and running field trials. When he moved from Virginia to North Carolina the Rappahannock Brittany Club awarded Fred with a plaque that reads:

***“To Fred and Ester Strawson”
Lifetime membership are hereby bestowed
In the Rappahannock Brittany Club for your
exceptional contributions, unfailing enthusiasm, and
timeless dedication.
September 1995.***

The Tarheel Brittany Club created a rotating trophy in Fred’s name which reads:

Tarheel Brittany Club, Fred MacLeod Strawson Rotating Gun Dog Trophy

For several years Fred served concurrently as Field Trial Chairman of both the Tarheel and Rappahannock clubs.

Fred’s passion was to lie out and run field trials on different farm lands. While at Rappahannock Field trial Clubs Fred ran trials on their home ground and three other farms.

In 1995 Fred moved from Virginia to North Carolina to be near his grand children. He had swapped, traded, and bickered and now owns 350 acres in Caswell County, North Carolina. Over the years he has run Field Trials on his land and groomed the land for field trials all while improving the Quail population.

Fred would work all summer laying out his land to optimize if for a good field trial course. He would purchase special designed implements to help shape the land well – this was his passion and dedication to continuing the Field Trial sport in North Carolina.

Fred is in his nineties now and still runs his field trials. He is still training dogs, grooming his farm and field trial grounds holding his annual field trials on his property and enjoying every aspect of the dog world and insuring all participants at his farm are enjoying their experience competing on his farm.



Versatile Brittanys in Action

Petey Finishes His Tracking Dog Excellent Title

Let me tell you about my versatile Brittany, UCD, UAGCH, URO3, UCH, GCH DC AFC Havapal's Rev Me Up Repeat, VCD1, BN, RE, SH, OA, OAJ, OAP, OJP, NF, NFP, CGC, TKN, TDX. Petey is now almost 13 years old and still enjoys competing in a limited variety of events. His most recent achievement for which I am so proud is his Tracking Dog Excellent title accomplished October 27, 2019 at the age of 12 years.

The AKC TDX test consists of a human track that is 800-1000 yards long with 5-7 turns, aged 3-5 hours, has 2 sets of cross tracks, must have 2 obstacles/variations in terrain and 4 scent articles. This was a true test of our ability to work as a team.

Petey was doing a great job tracking and we had 3 of our 4 articles, when I noticed we were almost back to the parking area where we started. Petey was hot on the track and was getting ready to pull me across a road. I started to panic and thought maybe he was going too fast and we missed our last article, so I hesitated to follow him across the road. That confused him and broke his concentration and his spirit, my insecurity as the handler almost cost us the pass. But I calmed down gave Petey a drink of water and re-scented him hoping he would get back on track. Eventually he did and we found our final article across the road close to the parking lot. Big lesson learned that day... trust your dog! Petey has always seemed to have the natural ability to track. When he was a puppy training for the field, I watched how he was scenting where the dog trainer walked to plant the birds, and I thought he might be good at tracking. By the time he was 5 years old, he proved to be my tracking dog by earning his Tracking Dog title.

For practice I would lay tracks while waiting to run at field trials. Everyone thought I was going to confuse or "screw up" my field trial dog, but were proved wrong when he was ranked #11 in the Magnum's Masked Man standings, was an Open and Amateur National Gun Dog Qualifier, finished his Field Champion, Amateur Field Champion, Senior Hunter, and Dual Champion titles that same year. He earned his Open Agility Jumper, Novice Agility Jumper Preferred, Agility Fast Novice Preferred, and Novice Agility preferred and Versatile Companion Dog 1 titles,



for a total of 10 AKC titles achieved in 2012. (Of note Petey is the 6th Brittany to achieve the VCD1 title out of 9 Brittany's total as of 2019 – per AKC records).

I am Petey's only owner and his breeder is Robert Kossell. Petey's offspring are following in their father's footsteps with versatility: UAGCH, URO1 UGCH, AFC, GCH Repeat's Little 501 Blues, BN, RE, SH, OA, OAJ, OAP, NJP, NF, CAA, CGC,TKN "Levi" and UAGI, UCH, CH Red Granite's I am Rock, JH "Rocky".

For people who want to start tracking, my advice would be to find a tracking club or group in your area and check them out. Look at the AKC website for any tracking tests near you and go to one and observe and Network with people at the tracking test. Also finding a good book such as "Modern Enthusiastic Tracking" Step-by-Step Training Handbook by William Sanders. Then just start going out and doing it in small steps with your dog once your dog is good at tracking your scent, then find a tracking buddy and lay tracks for each other. Once you are fairly confident that your dog can track you will have to find someone to certify your dog to track before you can enter a test. That's where going to a test or finding a Tracking Club is useful to be able to find someone that can certify your dog. Once your dog has a TD or a TDU title you can enter any of the higher levels of tracking without certification.

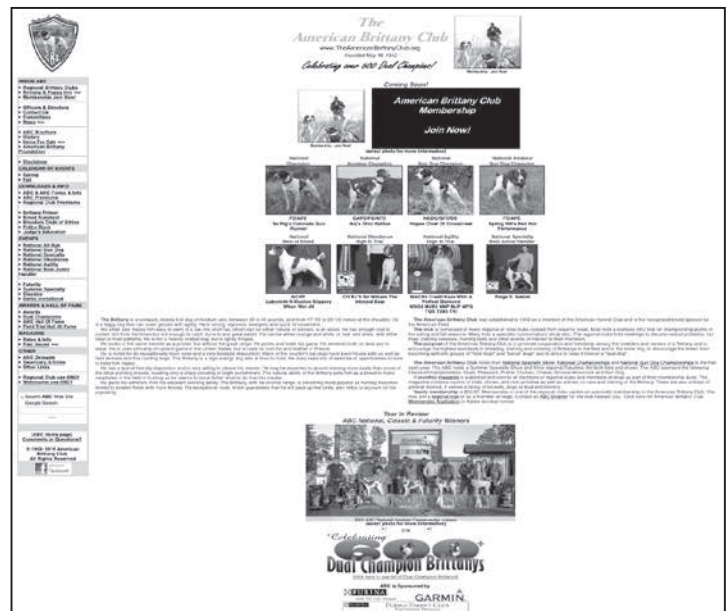

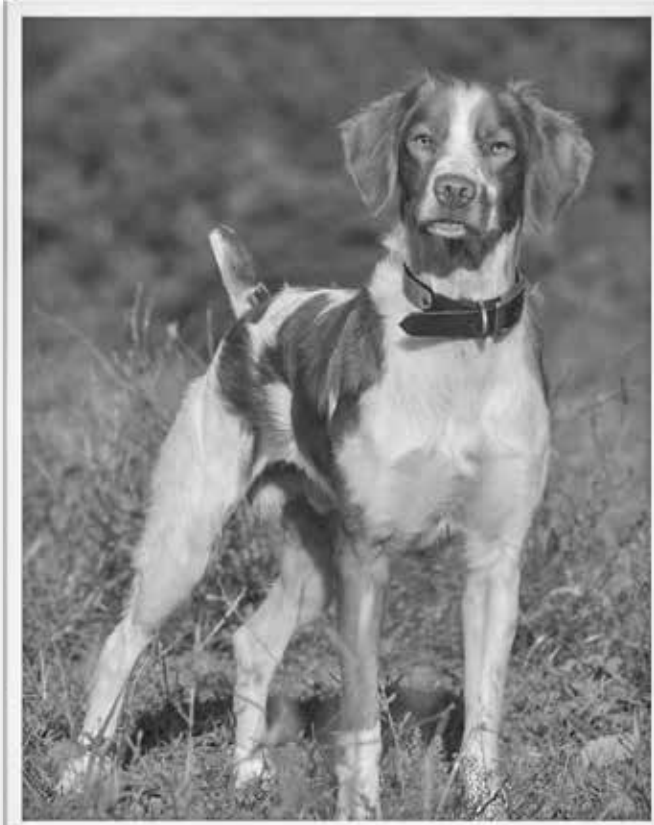

CONDITIONS AND RULES FOR FUTURITY ELIGIBILITY



- The 2022 American Brittany Futurity shall be open to every Brittany bitch and her progeny whelped during the calendar year of **January 1 - December 31, 2020**, who is owned or leased by a member of The American Brittany Club, and whose litters have been Futurity nominated with The American Brittany Club. Sires do not necessarily have to be owned/leased by an American Brittany Club member. All dams nominated and all sires bred to must be registered with AKC, CKC, or FDSB.
- The **nominating breeder** needs to be a current full member in Good Standing of the ABC when the litter is nominated and the closing dates of the of the Sectional Futurities in which puppies from their nominated litter compete. They must sign the Litter Nomination form, and any breeder purse checks will be paid to this designated nominated breeder. If their membership has lapsed at the time of the Sectional Futurity, the purse will revert back to the ABC Futurity Administrative Fees.
- Nominations of dams must be made within 60 days after a bitch has whelped, and a Nomination Fee of \$40.00 ("First Forfeit") must be paid at this time.** This payment will entitle each puppy of the nominated litter to be entered in the ABC Futurities (Field and/or Show) after the puppy has been properly registered with AKC or FDSB. Nomination Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors.
- Late litter nominations will be accepted with the following current fee schedule:** In addition to the Nomination Fee of \$40.00, late fees are \$60.00 for 61-90 days, and \$100.00 for 91-180 days. Nominations after 180 days will be accepted at the discretion and decision of the ABC Futurity Committee. The postmark will determine the fee for late nominations. The ABC Board of Directors may impose additional late fees from time to time.
- A Final Forfeit Fee, to be eligible to compete in the Sectional Futurities (Western/Central/Eastern), is due by October 1, 2021, and is submitted by the owner of the eligible puppy. Futurity Entry Fees will also be paid prior to 2022 Sectional Futurity events** by the owner of the eligible puppy for each Sectional Futurity event in which the eligible puppy is entered. Final Forfeit Fees as well as Sectional Futurity Entry Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors and subject to change.

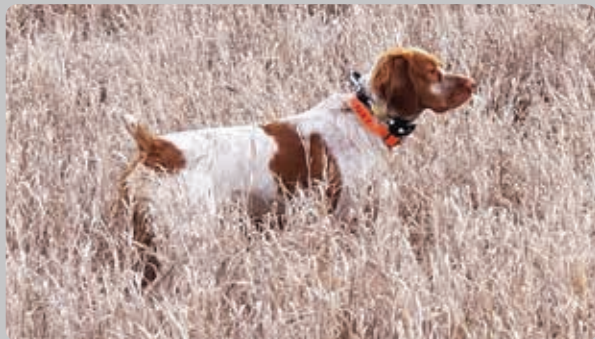
