The text of this book is brought to life with over 625 color and black/white photos, many of historical value, and as many as could be obtained of the modern-day dogs mentioned in the book.



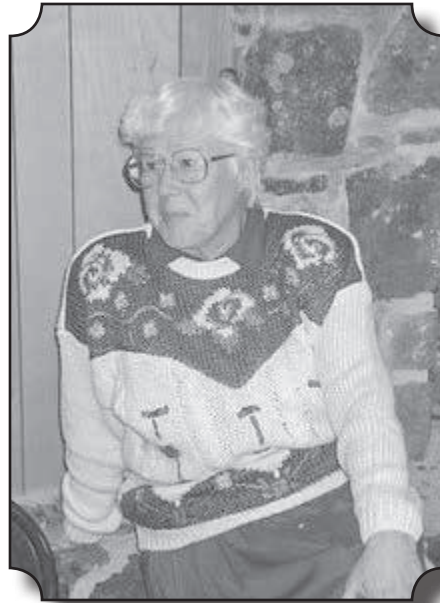

Remembering Rheta Cartmell



The Brittany breed has lost a lifetime supporter and promoter with the passing of Rheta Cartmell on August 28, 2021. Rheta, along with her husband Bill, who passed on August 23, 2016, worked for years to promote and improve the breed. Rheta's influence and dedication went far beyond that of most members.

Rheta met Bill while at "Ole Miss" in Oxford, MS and they were married in 1954. After Bill completed his education, they moved to New York where he began a 36 year career with IBM. After Bill retired in April 1994, they purchased property at the breakaway on the national championship grounds in Booneville, AR and were permanent residents.

Rheta has had an impact on the Brittany since she first joined the ABC in 1961. In the 1960's and 1970's, she and Bill were active in trialing on the east coast and principals in the running of the Upper New York club's field trials. In those days the upper New York club trial was the premier event on the east coast. Tyoga Teddy Bear was their winning hour dog and was campaigned and handled by Loyd Budd. He was named Champion (40 starters) in 1989 in the prestigious U.S. Open Brittany Championship along with other hour wins. Tyoga's Miss Judy Judy was also campaigned.

Rheta and Bill were advocates of one-hour stakes and promoted the International Brittany Championship held near Watertown, NY. They also became involved in the U.S. Open Brittany Championship at Ardmore, OK. Over the years they compiled statistics, wrote articles and pushed for endurance Brittany stakes. They set up computer record keeping for the ABC to coordinate records and produce

charts of wins for Brittanys, which led to her becoming the ABC statistician. All of this was done to help the owners, breeders and the breed.

1981 Rheta became Editor of the American Brittany magazine and held the job for five years. She was one of a group of people who worked to finish the Book of the American Brittany that Nicky Bissell could not complete because of her health. After researching and assembling information, Rheta wrote the Book of the American Brittany, 80's Edition.

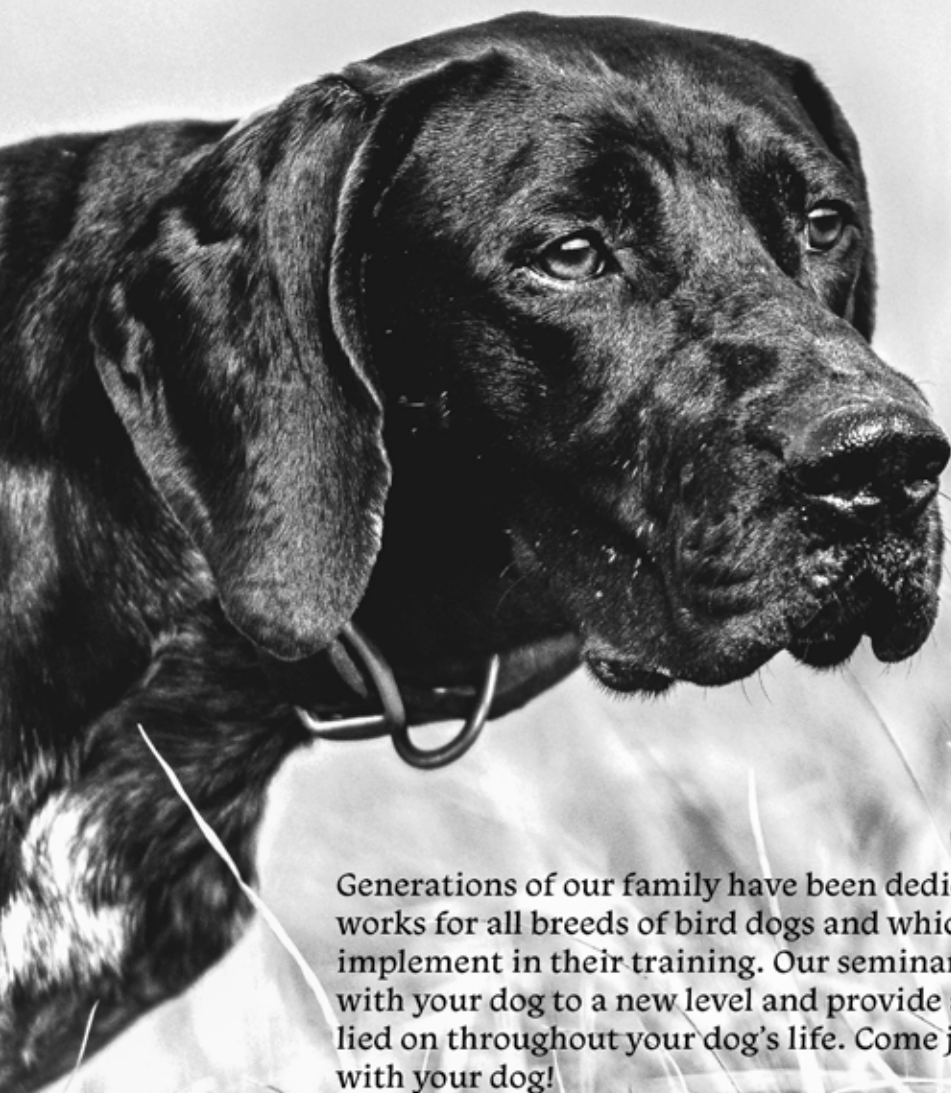
Over the years, she served the ABC as the National Field Trial Secretary and served on the National Show Committee, National Field Trial Committee and the Trophy Committee.

Rheta and Bill were a driving force behind the creation and formation of the Brittany Field Trial Hall of Fame and museum located at the Bird Dog Museum in Grand Junction, TN. They managed this organization for many years, conducting the nomination process, balloting, election and the induction ceremonies. This organization gathers and preserves the history of the Brittany in the museum, starting from their introduction into the United States in the 1930's and continuing up to the present day. Both Rheta and Bill are members of this Hall of Fame.

There will be a celebration of Rheta's life later in the year and arrangements will be announced. Donations in her memory should be sent to the Bird Dog Foundation, Brittany Fund, at Bird Dog Foundation, 505 Highway 57W, Grand Junction, TN 38039.

To Train and Teach

The first Brittanys brought to this country were from the Province of Brittany in France, came to hunt. Since the 1930's, when the breed was brought to Central and North America, the Brittany has also developed into an excellent field trial and with positive performance in show competition. According to the AKC (American Kennel Club) what is unique to the Brittany breed is the fact there are more dual champions than any other pointing breed. Further consider a specific characteristic of the Brittany; they have many natural abilities – to point game, to retrieve, and most important to be with people and please them.

This later characteristic “to please” makes the Brittany very trainable. It is important to also consider that at all times a certain type of person is necessary to teach and refine those natural characteristics. To train and teach the dog, those are necessary requirements for the Brittany to achieve success in the field, agility, and show arena.

This story has been given previously in the Gazette as to how our family now 50 some years ago brought the first Brittany into our household. With three boys, it just was important for them to have a family pet; it was the Brittany. All dogs need to be “house-broke” along with obedient when outside the home and in the field during hunting.

Before further discussing those who “train and teach”, this writer thought it should be consider what these two words – “train and teach” – actually what they mean by consult the Merriam-Webster Dictionary. In the world of the Brittany, one usually understands what is meant by either of these two words. The dictionary definition only created a whole lot of confusion:

- several definitions that referred to locomotives (trains),
- to trail, drag, train,
- to cause to grow as desired,
- to form by interaction discipline or drill,
- to make or become prepared for a test of skill,
- to aim or point at an object.

Unbelievable! Guess our Brittanys due “point at an object” – most of the time it should be a quail or one of the other upland game birds.

The dictionary definition for the word “teach” was just as ambiguous and confusing as the word “train”. Nuf Ced!

Let's go back to discussing those “train and teach” individuals in “our world” of the Brittany, who has worked with the breed – often on a full time bases. It does take a special person. It's someone who has had years of experience working with and also had close association with all sporting dogs. These individuals have given to the field trial, agility, and conformation sports and asked for nothing in return; a trainer, teacher, and friend not wanting any credit. Also there has been a “lasting” positive effect on many Brittanys and their owners.

These trainer/teachers have been willing to share their knowledge and experience of the Brittany with any and every one.

Further this breed is so extremely versatile. As stated previously, the Brittany is the only breed that has more “dual champions” than any other pointing breed. Besides the field trial and show competition, owners of the Brittany also participate in agility tests, hunting dog tests, and NAVHDA (North American Versatile Hunting Dog Association).

Now this article will return to the earlier discussion about my own

personal experience with several trainer/teachers, who can be called professional friends. These individuals have spent years working – training and teaching – specifically the Brittany.

This first individual worked with our second Brittany, FC Just Dew It (aka, Dewey), who's sire was FC Flatwoods Tiger. Dewey was in his “prime” as a field trial dog just about the time of the turn of the Century 2000. Time marches on and the association with that trainer/teacher has been there for the past 25 years. He is such a humble and knowledgeable individual with regard to pointing dogs



and the Brittany.

Which lead to the second trainer/teacher, who also campaigns the Brittany. He is probably the top winning Brittany handler, who is more than willing to share his techniques with anyone who asks. His knowledge about being a train/teacher of this field trial sport is impeccable. He is the reason that our Brittany, Glade Run Irish (aka. Irish) became one of the top field trail Brittanys during the years 2015—2019 after which he was retired and now is a part of our breeding program.

The third individual worked with Dewey in the show arena. She also competed with another of our Brittanys, Nuf Ced Herb Score (aka. Herby). He completed his championship in a major event at the Tidewater Kennel Club, May 2001. The significances of this event is that Herby was also a great hunting dog and performed well in the field trial completion, which has led to him also being a part of our breeding program using frozen semen. However even more important is the fact that the individual who handled Herby has devoted her life to the Brittany world. Her knowledge and humbly willing to share it has elevated to the important position of teaching judges, who perform their duty in the show arena. She also continues to train and show Brittanys and will be doing so with our liver/roan, Glade Run Shadow. She welcomes the challenge showing a Brittany with this type of color appearance.

In conclusion it is hoped that those who read this article will understand the importance of trains/teachers for the Brittany and effect they have had on the breed and its owners. This article is meant to be a tribute to three special people who have a passion for the Brittany. Thank you to each of you!

TRAININ' DOGS

Maintenance

Hunting season is over in some places and winding down to a close in a few others. We're hoping everybody had a good one, with plentiful birds and fine dog work. Whether it was the last season for that old campaigner, the very first one for the new recruit, or you're enjoying that seasoned and reliable middle-aged dog, there are things to think about as another year draws to close.

Old dogs, young dogs, and everything in between will need maintenance during the off-season. It's not like cleaning your favorite hunting boots and packing them in the closet or oiling your shotgun before tucking it back into the safe. A well-trained dog is an ongoing project, for life. Think back over the last few months. Was your dog's performance better at the beginning of the season? How about at the end? It's pretty common for young dogs to come unraveled during the excitement of actual hunting compared to training; experienced dogs will often do that, too. We can hardly blame them because it's more exciting for us as well – and that makes us the bigger part of the problem when a dog does come unglued and forgets his training.

When we say "maintenance," we're not talking about the obvious stuff, like feeding and health care. That stuff should be a given and something you automatically stay on top of. You adjust your dog's feed to the level of work he's doing and maintain good body condition, usually putting on a few pounds if the dog has been hunted hard and has run off some weight. Any health needs are seen to, and some well-earned rest is in order. That's standard procedure when we finish up our season.

The kind of maintenance we're talking about is training maintenance. There is always something to work on during the off-season. With a dog just finishing up his rookie season, there may be quite a few things to put back together, while the more experienced dog may have had a few lapses in judgment but nothing too serious. Even if winter is harsh and the snow is deep in your part of the world, don't fret. A lot of the simple things can be worked on at home during normal, daily life.

If you recall from previous columns, we've talked about the three foundational skills every good bird dog needs to know. Almost every problem in the field will trace back to one of these three simple skills, which the

dog must consistently do: go with you, come to you, and stand still.

Go with you refers to the dog walking with you until released to hunt, and then hunting out in front of whatever direction you choose, searching for birds while still being aware of your position and direction. Come to you is a pretty obvious one. All dogs need some level of recall so they can bring you a downed bird, come in for a drink of water or rest break, and at some point you've got to load up and head home. Standing still comes into play when your dog is on point, because his job is to stand still while you walk in to flush the bird. It's nice in a few others, too, like standing still until released when coming out of a kennel or through a door. It's all about patience. Maintain and continue to refine these three simple skills, and both hunting and day-to-day life with your dog gets better and better.

For post-season maintenance, let's start with the rookie, that wonderfully enthusiastic youngster just finishing up his first season afield. All the time you spent training paid off in the first few times afield, but as time went on and the anticipation and excitement grew, the dog made some mistakes. It's typical rookie stuff and mostly happens from sheer excitement. That's not the worst think; we'd worry more if the dog wasn't happy to be hunting. It's how we deal with it that sets the tone for the balance of the season and the years after.

The most common skill to come undone is standing still, or whoa. A dog that breaks and chases is a dog in danger of being shot by accident. It's also a dog that, if allowed to continue breaking and chasing, will clear a field of birds and give you zero shot opportunities. Ideally, this needs to be well-trained prior to the start of actual hunting, and then that standard of steadiness needs to be upheld as the young dog gets into the real-world situations in the field. Dogs quickly learn the difference between training and hunting, and it's our job to make sure they

understand that the rules don't change.

How do we deal with it in the field? It's never a bad idea to run that rookie pup with the e-collar on the flank for the first season, assuming that's the way you've trained whoa, like we do. Doing that gives you a way to stop the chase if the dog breaks. That also means you've got to be willing to sacrifice some shots in order to impress the rules upon your dog – never shoot a bird that you dog has flushed and chased.

So if it seems steadiness is where the wheels fell off when hunting, how do you work on that during the off-season when you really can't get to the field or do much bird work? Again, the problem was the dog not standing still. There are chances every single day, many times a day, where you can ask your dog to stand still and not move. Make a routine of it. Going outside? Put the dog on a whoa, open the door, and make him wait. Only allow movement on your release command. You can do the same thing going in and out of the crate or kennel, and again at feeding time. Do it in the backyard or in the living room. Any place and every place is good and will help. Always make sure the dog stands still when asked and only releases on your command. Change up the length of time you make him remain still as well, since dogs have a rather accurate internal clock – if you always ask for 15 seconds, they will often start releasing themselves when time is up in their mind. Your body language can also be a “tell.”

The same stuff works with the older, seasoned dog. You probably won't have to do as much of it to keep the experienced, more finished dog tuned up. Still, maintaining a routine at home by using and always enforcing the same commands you use in the field is a great way to remind your dog that you are in charge and commands work everywhere.

What about the dog that tends to range well out of your comfort zone in the field and go off in a direction opposite of yours? Obviously, range isn't going to be a big problem in the house, but range isn't the only thing that factors in here. If a dog has forgotten you're part of the team, then he isn't going with you. If you're lucky you've got one of those dogs that wants to be where you are when in the house or yard. That makes maintaining the behavior easy. However, if you have a more independent dog that tends to wander away, make a point of keep the dog in the same room you're in. If you change rooms, the dog changes with you. If you're in the backyard, zigzag around and make him pay attention to your direction changes. Believe it or not, this will help strengthen the connection in the

field as well.

Last, but certainly not least, is making sure your dog always comes to you. For the most part, that's easy except for one little detail a lot of folks don't really focus on. It's important to give your dog a consistent target to come to. Just close by or circling around or doing a fly-by is not coming to you. Think about how you want your birds retrieved. If you want your dog to stop in front of you to deliver, then that becomes your “come to you” spot every single time whether you're in the field or in your house.

And you can solidify that further by combining the come-to-you part with the stand-still part by making your dog stand still once he gets to that spot. If you have a dog that comes directly to you and always stops in the same spot and stands still, you'll be way ahead of the game. A dog that comes directly to you without hesitation and stands still is a dog under control, and it's also a dog that doesn't have time to pull feather or play with a bird you've shot.

Do the maintenance during the off-season and you'll have a dog that is connected and ready to roll when it's time to dust off your hunting gear next fall.

CONDITIONS AND RULES FOR FUTURITY ELIGIBILITY



- The 2023 American Brittany Futurity shall be open to every Brittany bitch and her progeny whelped during the calendar year of **January 1 - December 31, 2021**, who is owned or leased by a member of The American Brittany Club, and whose litters have been Futurity nominated with The American Brittany Club. Sires do not necessarily have to be owned/leased by an American Brittany Club member. All dams nominated and all sires bred to must be registered with AKC, CKC, or FDSB.
- The **nominating breeder** needs to be a current full member in Good Standing of the ABC when the litter is nominated and the closing dates of the of the Sectional Futurities in which puppies from their nominated litter compete. They must sign the Litter Nomination form, and any breeder purse checks will be paid to this designated nominated breeder. If their membership has lapsed at the time of the Sectional Futurity, the purse will revert back to the ABC Futurity Administrative Fees.
- Nominations of dams must be made within 60 days after a bitch has whelped, and a Nomination Fee of \$40.00 ("First Forfeit") must be paid at this time.** This payment will entitle each puppy of the nominated litter to be entered in the ABC Futurities (Field and/or Show) after the puppy has been properly registered with AKC or FDSB. Nomination Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors.
- Late litter nominations will be accepted with the following current fee schedule:** In addition to the Nomination Fee of \$40.00, late fees are \$60.00 (total of \$100) for 61-90 days, and \$100.00 (total of \$140) for 91-180 days. Nominations after 180 days will be accepted at the discretion and decision of the ABC Futurity Committee. The postmark will determine the fee for late nominations. The ABC Board of Directors may impose additional late fees from time to time.
- A Final Forfeit Fee, to be eligible to compete in the Sectional Futurities (Western/Central/Eastern), is due by October 1, 2022, and is submitted by the owner of the eligible puppy.** Futurity Entry Fees will also be paid prior to 2023 Sectional Futurity events by the owner of the eligible puppy for each Sectional Futurity event in which the eligible puppy is entered. Final Forfeit Fees as well as Sectional Futurity Entry Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors and subject to change.
- Beginning 1/1/2020, all litter nominations will be acknowledged via both email and written notification sent**
