

The weather dawned cool, crisp and sunny. There was a fusion of fall colors that everyone enjoyed while watching the dogs. The grounds in Ionia, Michigan were impeccably groomed. Judges Andrew Campbell and Art Cohen had their pick of contenders chasing the iron dog. They were looking for a dog "that filled the hour". We can't thank them enough for their time in the saddle and rapt attention. We truly appreciate the continued sponsorship from Purina Pets and Garmin. An event of this stature takes a ton of organization, planning and a slew of folks to implement. Many thanks to course marshall, Ron Gulembo. Due to the heavy amount of rainfall the creek crossing on the derby course towards the gun dog parking lot was unusable. He brainstormed the way to make 3 one-hour courses without having to use the creek crossing. Sue Lehosky handled all the logistical paperwork, as field trial secretary. Carlos Gust and Dick Lipsky handled the bird care and planting with the help of Paul Renius, Dan Jolly and John Hall. Eileen Gust handled all the lunches and dog wagon goodies.

Champion: It's Five O'Clock Somewhere /owner/handler Rebecca Walters, Runner-Up Magnum High Velocity /handler Vince Anderson/owners Vince & Denise Anderson, 3rd Jolly's Runnin Rylee handler/Dan Jolly owners/Dan & Jacquie Jolly, 4th Romence's Life of Riley/owner/hander Julie Romence.

Tuesday, 10/26/21

Brace 1: Sigbrit's Evil Side of the Road "Ren", Eddie Manifold & Lapat's Cody "Cody", Al Cropek. At 6 minutes into the brace both dogs were seen standing on the hedgerow to the right with separate finds. Al fired for Cody with all in order. Ren had a non-productive. Cody and Ren were moved on. Ren moved up the hedgerow and pointed what turned to

be a dead bird. Cody moved forward on course and at 12 was standing staunchly just off a mott of trees into the first field. He ended his bid when the bird flushed right in front of his face. Ren came forward catching the front making nice moves on the lines. At 25 Ren established point on the hedgerow to the right of the gap into Hires field. This also turned out to be a non-productive. Mid-way through Hires field at 27 he was seen swapping ends and unfortunately went with birds.

Brace 2: Starlight's Mercury Out Ryder "Ryder", Teresa Richmond & High Velocity Copper Magnum "Colt", Denise Anderson. Both dogs broke sharply to the right with Colt going wider of the two. As scouts rode in that direction, Ryder was found standing mid-way up the hedgerow carding a find at 3. At 12 Colt had an indiscretion and Denise picked him up. Minutes later as Ryder caught the front he had a clean stylish find at the same location. At 30 Ryder established point just prior to making the turn down the hill towards the boy scout bridge. Unfortunately, it was a non-productive. Ryder was not seen while Theresa moved forward down the hill towards the Boy Scout bridge. She called for the Garmin ending Ryder's bid.

Brace 3: Blazing Spanish Bella "Bella", Gerald Barron & Diamond Hill Sonshine and Whiskey "Dani", Lisa Pollock. This brace broke away onto the derby course with Dani carding the first find with nice style at 6. At 15 Dani had another find to the right in the field past Sessions bridge. Bella found a lot of objectives to pursue. At 35 she has a nice clean find on the right side of the course with stylish manners. At 40 Bella and Dani had a divided find with all in order. The brace continued towards the dyke but cut left up the hill into Shangrala. After the deer hunter encounter, who had his successful deer on the ground, the dogs continued around the bowl without even stopping to say hi! At time Bella was gathered up by



her handler, but Dani was among the missing. After the allotted time, the Garmin was called for. This was a heartbreaker because Dani was found to the front.

Brace 4: Nalko de Sentiers du Ranier II "Nalko", Clint La Fary & Alder Zerandipity "Zera", Richard Johnson. Both dogs had a strong forward breakaway with both out-of-pocket for a time. Nalko was found standing on the first east/west hedgerow before entering Hires field. Zera took some time to be gathered up. Upon catching up she passed through the gap into Hires field cutting right where she had a successful find. At the same time Nalko was pointed to the left of the gap which turned out to be a non-productive after a lengthy relocation/ flushing attempt. Half-way down Hires field on the cross hedgerow Zera banged point but came up empty with a non-productive. Nalko was busy making a wide swing to the left before carding another find past the knoll. At this point the two dogs came back together through the gap in the field before you turn left to head down the hill towards the boy scout bridge. Zera headed backwards and was not seen in judgement again. Halfway down the hill Nalko carded another clean find. Nalko's last find was on the hedgerow to the right prior to crossing the Boys Scout bridge. Nalko finished the hour at a moderate range before the bridge.

Brace 5: Kip's Bay Dark N'Stormy Miss Maddie "Maddie", John Kipp & Alder's Sophie Brook "Sophie", Dan Campbell. Breakaway was into the derby course with Sophie carding a stop to flush at 4 while at the same time Maddie was found standing just a little to the right. Maddie had an extensive relocation with no bird produced. In the interim Sophie went forward and had a quality find on the right hedgerow before the bridge. After crossing the bridge Sophie had another find and followed it up with a non-productive father up the line. Maddie in the meantime carded a find on the right hedgerow at the top side of the derby course. After coming out the S turn Sophie took the right edge and was rewarded with a nice find. Maddie had a stop to flush on the left. The dogs continued forward at moderate range before heading up the hill into Shang-ra-la iust before time.

Brace 6: Pretty Blue Eyes Sweet Touch of Charlie B "Charlie", Bob Bakas & KDel's Eagle Magnum High Velocity "Shooter" Ken DeLong. Both dogs broke away with some far-reaching casts. Shooter was the first to score a find on the left side while Charlie continued forward at a nice pace. At 13 Charlie was standing stylishly and Shooter came in for a back. All was in order. As the dogs turned left towards Sessions bridge, unfortunately, Charlie ran headlong over a covey of birds ending what started out to be a very nice bid. Shooter was forward reaching, but not extreme. After Sessions bridge he reached for the objectives on the east side of the derby course. He pointed a rabbit at 24 and had a non-productive as 27. He continued his driving forward race which brought

him through the derby course and up Cardiac Hill. After Cardiac Hill he had a nice stylish find at 47 in a feed plot. Shooter finished his hour with determined forward motion.

Posted Dogs: Nalko 4A, Maddie 5A, Sophie 5B, Shooter 6B.

Wednesday, 10/27/21

Brace 7: Magnum High Velocity "Gauge", Vince Anderson & "Atos", Jackie Hutwagner. Both dogs broke straight away with Atos making a right at the apple tree. Unfortunately, he wasn't connecting with the handler and was called out of judgement at 25. Gauge broke right farther up and was standing at 5 on the right parallel hedgerow from the 2-track. After a lengthy flush and 2 relocations he ended with a non-productive. Upon release 100 yards farther up the line he slammed pointed and had a clean find. Moving forward towards Hires field at 19 he had a high tight find in the mott of trees to the right of the gap. At 26 he had another clean find to the left of the keyhole entering Hires field. At 30 Gauge stood at the start of the island. Vince relocated and all was in order. Gauge was well off this covey. Gauge worked the island and was standing in the cover at the far end. It appeared he lost the scent cone and had to be relocated. Upon moving up Gauge got them pinned and carded another clean find. Gauge's final find was on the left hedgerow before making the turn down the hill to the Boy Scout bridge.

Brace 8: Miss Behavin' "Ivy", AI Cropek & Jolly's Christmas Holly "Holly", Dan Jolly. Breakaway was at the top of the hill heading down towards the Boy Scout bridge. Both were covering some ground and at 7 lvy had a nice find at the mott of trees to the right at the entrance to the bridge crossing while Holly was working forward. Holly worked the feed strip half-way up the hill and slammed point. Ivy also was standing. The birds lifted and the temptation was too much for both of them.

Brace 9: Romence's Life of Riley "Riley" Julie Romence & Beech River's Light Em Up Lulu "Lulu", Travis Shuler. Breakaway was at the derby course. Lulu took off like a rocket ship. At 4.5 both dogs were standing separately in the left perpendicular hedgerow. Riley had a find, but no birds could be produced for Lulu. At 8 on the island on the right Riley was standing again. Lulu failed to stop ending her time. Gun was fired for Riley and she was moved on towards Sessions bridge. Riley made some wide casts after Sessions creek leading up to her next find on the cross hedgerow. At 36 she was on the right hedgerow parallel to the 2-track heading towards the old gun dog course. At 40 she had a find on the right hedgerow as you approach Shang-ra-la. At 55 Riley slammed point again in a clump to the left as you head up into Shang-ra-la. Gun was fired and she was moved on where she finished her hour at the bowl in Shang-ra-la.

Brace 10: Spring Hill's Red Hot Performance "Red", John Bell & Mt. View's Moloka'l Dawn Breeze "Glenn", Steward Morgan. Both



dogs broke away up the hill on course 1 with Red sweeping wide right. He caught the front while Glenn was on point to the right of the 2-track. It took some time for Glenn's handler to produce the bird because the cover was very thick. Upon release while catching the front Glenn had a stop to flush right before the gap into Hires field. Red had a find to the left of the keyhole heading into Hire's field. Red filled the field as we headed north and went on point in the left island that resulted in a non-event on a dead bird. Upon release he was rewarded with a find on the cross hedgerow at 34. Meanwhile Glenn worked forward on the right-side hedgerow before the knoll and pointed. The bird(s) was found for Glenn on a relocation. Red swung that field and pointed at the far north side past the knoll which resulted in a non-productive. Glenn was moved forward down the right line and had another find before the keyhole. Glenn moved forward to the left field heading toward the downhill to the Boy Scout bridge. Mid-way he slammed point and Red, catching the front, had an honorly back. All was in order and the dogs were moved on. At 55 Glenn buried into the left hedgerow halfway down the hill towards the Boy Scout bridge with all in order with his find. Red continued to run wider and forward down the hill and established point on the left before the Boy Scout bridge with a high and tight find. Glenn carded the final find of the brace in the mott of trees to the right before the Boy Scout bridge.

Brace 11: Starlight's Callisto Moon "Cal" Theresa Richmond & Overunder's Kick It Out "Holly" Carlos Gust. Breakaway was in the derby course. Cal was patterning nicely and had a find at 6 at the left of the first gap. Holly had been working forward, when handler noticed a change in her gait. He elected to pick her up. At the right hedgerow at the top of the derby course Cal had a nice stylish find. He continued working forward at a nice range to Session's bridge. After the bridge he cast straight to the front and was seen under a bird at the first hedgerow.

Brace 12: Detroit Rascal's Son of a Gun "Cobo" W. Burton McCandless & Kip's Bay Flat Out Ridge Run-N-Annie "Annie", John Kipp. Cobo was a scratch leaving Annie to run on her own. At 55 Annie had another beautiful find on the right at the first hedgerow after you get up the hill. She pressed forward and slammed point to the left on the next hedgerow. All was in order with time soon to expire.

2021 ABC Chicken Classic/ Championship

This September Classic has provided the Brittany world an opportunity to run on great grounds with wild Prairie Chickens to challenge the best of our breed. This year was no exception. 32 dogs came to the line for judges Bud Moore from Oklahoma and Keith Bryant from Colorado. They were able to pick the best of the best with almost all dogs experiencing some type of prairie chicken contact. Not all were able to resist the call of the wild, but those who did showed excellent race and bird finding ability which allowed our judges to have a lot to choose from.

None of this could happen without the cooperation of the town of Bassett and its surrounding landowners. The Rock County landowners, Ted Morton, Butch Fischer, Curtis Luther and Wade Dearmont have long been used to provide the bird dog world terrific grounds. Sponsors Purina Pet Care & Tri-Tronics also continue to contribute their products for the winners and financial support from Purina for the club. Chris Raymond of Plains Equipment in Ainsworth provided the John Deere UTV to pull the dog wagon. This trial could not happen without these sponsors. We also wish to thank first Claudia & Stan Truska who put this all together. Claudia was the dog wagon driver with Stan the course marshal. Between Stan and Tom Maneely, gates were opened and closed for all the handlers, judges & gallery. Claudia arranged for Rhonda Houkos to bring her food truck for great breakfast sandwiches and hearty lunches. Ray Trimble picked up donuts provided by Jeanna Harman who runs the Coral Bar in Bassett for our morning breaks.

After Ken Patterson ran his young Piney Run Hill Top Blew in the 7th brace, we all knew the standard had been set. That same 7th brace also

contained the Runner Up Jagoub's Spell Caster handled by Tom Tracy, Jr. Tabu's owner, Tom Jagelielski, was able to observe her performance. Unfortunately, John Hall & Jack and Crystal Alexander were not able to make the trip to watch their dogs take the winners stand with Blew & Tabu.

The Running:

Brace 1: County Line's Full Throttle (Mac) Stan Truksa & JWB's Arctic Cat (Kimber) Tom Tracy. Stan had his hands full with Mac. A cow chase slowed him down and knocked him out of contention. Kimber was out of sight the first 20 minutes or so. She pointed a skunk at 35 and caused a lot of anguish on the dog wagon and Tommy's trailer. However, the skunk did not slow her down or keep her from pointing birds down a fence line with 7-8 chickens in the air with all in order.

Brace 2: Maxwell's Prickly Pete (Pete), Todd Babbel & El Grande (Truman), Rob Meyers. Both dogs broke away with gusto and were not seen for about 15 minutes. Todd's Pete established point at 32 with Robs' Truman doing the same at the other end of the field. Neither handler could kick up birds. Todd elected to pick up and Rob relocated, with a nonproductive charged, thus ending Brace 2.

Brace 3: Cedar Valley Luke (Luke), Todd Babbel & Georgia's White Lightening (George), Tom Tracy. Neither dog was pleasing their handlers and were picked up at the fence crossing at :35 for an early lunch.

Brace 4: Cedar Valley Zeke (Zeke), Tod Babble and Georgia's Tiger 2.0 (Tiger), Tom Tracy was the first brace after lunch. Zeke handled by Todd had a good run, but no birds. Tom Tracy had to pick up Tiger after a

breach of manners on a chicken at :20.

Brace 5: CVK's Spartan King (Leo), Tom Tracy and Black Creek Whizki Skip (Skip) Chad Holman. Leo decided to leave Tommy and the tracker was pulled at :22. In the meantime, Skip pointed at :10 with a nice find. At :45 point was called again. After a relocation, no birds could be flushed, and he was charged with a non-productive. His last 6 minutes were a bit short (looking for that elusive chicken), but the first 50 were outstanding and earned him a berth on the awards stand.

Brace 6: Day one ended with Brace 6: Gangster's Secret Weapon (Sniper), Chad Holman and Prairie Wind Pistol Pete (PD), Tom Tracy. Donna Janulis was in the gallery to watch her Sniper perform with Ed in the dog wagon. Sniper stayed consistently to the front but couldn't find any birds for his handler.Pete was not pleasing his handler and was picked up at :33.

Brace 7: Day 2 started off with a bang. Our Champion, Piney Run Hill Top Blew (Blew), Kent Patterson, and Runner Up Champion, Jagoub's Spell Castor (Tabu), Tom Tracy were braced together, and both preformed at the top of their game. Blew had an excellent race with good range, handling, and anything else you would look for in the winners. We were all rooting for a bird, when Blew went on point at :55. Kent handled the find like the expert handler he is and all was in order. Meantime, Tabu was putting on a show for the gallery following Tommy. At :45, point was called. Tommy relocated the dog but had to settle for a nonproductive. Just 10 minutes later she pointed again at :55 with a solid find. Both dogs were well ahead of their handlers at time. It was a very enjoyable brace to watch (although a bit cold for Sept).

Brace 8: Countyline's That Guy (Guy), Stan Truksa and Kashmir (Kash), Tom Tracy. Guy was having trouble getting lined out and Stan picked him up at :35. Kashmir also started slow and erratic. At 15, Kash had a covey pointed on the fence line. Tommy was able to flush a 6-8 bird covey with all in order. Kash finished strong, with no more bird work the balance of the hour.

Brace 9: Piney Run Jake (Jake), Kent Patterson and Ru-Jems Dirty Dingus McGee (Dingus) Tom Tracy. Kent's Jake had fair range with no birds. Dingus was running well for his owner, Jerry McGee who watched from the dog wagon. At :47, Dingus went on point. Tommy relocated and ended up with a nonproductive.

Brace 10: Jac's Ray of Sunshine II (Ray), Chad Holman and Blazin E-Z Mac (Mac), Tom Tracy. This was a pretty quick brace. Ray headed for the fences and chased a couple of birds on the way. When Chad picked him up, he had a very apologetic look on his face, knowing he did wrong. In the meantime, Mac chased a bird at :9 before Tommy could get to him to call point. Short brace this afternoon.

Brace 11: Roustabout's All In (Al), Tom Tracy and Black Creek Summit (Chip), Chad Holman. Last year's national champion was not performing up to his ability and Tommy picked up Al at 28. Chip chased early thus ending Brace 11.

Brace 12: CVK's Jungleland (Clarence), Tom Tracy -Bye. Clarence was picked up early, not pleasing his handler; thus ending Day 2.

Brace 13: WW's Gin and Tonic (Ginee), Burton Wice and Brendi Brooks Cowboy UP (Tuff) Tom Tracy. Ginee got a chicken up at :10 and was put on the dog wagon. Tuff was put up at :06 as he started limping soon after the breakaway. Ray Trimble was disappointed Tuff's pulled muscle was not healed yet.

Brace 14: Jagoub's WhoDat Say WhoDat When I Say WhoDat? (Dat), Tom Tracy and TJ's Black Diamond, (Coal), John Perry. Dat rode up a covey of chickens and could not stop himself. He was picked up at :20. Coal had a good race with John guiding him through the course with ease. Unfortunately, no birds were found.

Brace 15: WW's Miss Wendy Peffercorn, (Wendy) Tom Tracy and Marjo's Fille de la Britcigre (Brie), John Perry. Wendy established point at :22 but no birds produced. Brie bumped a bird at :28 and was picked up.

Brace 16: Roustabout's Freddie M (Fred), Tom Tracy – Bye. Fred broke away strong despite not having a bracemate. At :22 point was called. Tommy relocated for several minutes and finally picked up at :30 without producing a bird.

Brace 17: Been There (Tip), Tom Tracy – Bye. Tip bumped a chicken at 1:30 and was picked up.

Brace 18: Big Mac XIV (Big Mac), Tom Tracy – Bye. The lack of a bracemate did not slow down Big Mac but the sun coming out and wind dying down did. At :40 he stopped for water and was picked up.

Thus ended this year's running of the ABC Chicken Classic/Championship. Although we missed a few of the professional trainers who normally attend, the quality of the dogs far outweighed the quantity. I am sure that all four placed dogs will make a fine showing at the ABC National Championship.

As a side note, we want to mention that we certainly missed Mary Karbiner's whit and knowledge of the history of the Chicken Classic this year. Hope to see her back next year.



A moist tongue licks my chin and brings me out of my trance. The dog's gaze is again fixed on mine. The eyes have it.





Unofficial Minutes By Exec. Secretary Mary Jo Trimble The Meeting Place, Booneville, Arkansas

Sunday, November 21, 2021

Meeting was called to order by President Ed Janulis at 8:20 AM. Members present in the room were East: Darlene Dow, John Perry, East Central Jack Alexander, Vince Anderson, Ron Gulembo, Central Joe Droel, Burton Wice, Midwest Mary Karbiner, Bret Lindback, Ed Tillson, West Robin Tomasi. Directors attending by Zoom TV were: Leslie Hunt, Bernie Crain, Jim Hammett, and Mary Brown. Pres. Ed Janulis, Exec. Sec. Mary Jo Trimble, Finance Chair Judy Graves were in attendance. 3rd VP Bryce Novotny and Futurity Chair Leslee Masolotte were in attendance for their reports.

President Janulis thanked everyone for the 35 Agenda Reports that were received.

Motion #1: Motion by Gulembo, Seconded by Alexander: I move to approve the 2020 BOD Meeting Minutes. 14 Yes, 1 No (Karbiner). Objection will be discussed later in the meeting. Motion Passed.

Membership Report: Gulembo would like someone to help him and other Directors to simplify a list of his regional membership so he could contact them to increase communication. Tomasi suggested using Survey Monkey so people could opt out. Other suggested how to copy emails from member list or ask an IT person to do so for him.

Executive Secretary's Report: Trimble relayed some of the requirements an Executive Secretary should have to fill that position. Those included computer skills and the time they are willing to devote to the job. Lindback suggested that Mary Jo and a couple of other people form a search committee to find a candidate.

Futurity Report, Leslee Masolotte: Cost issues of birds were discussed. Futurity managers are encouraged to read policy book requirements. Discussed if someone other than breeder could make nomination. Page 34 of Agenda Book. Lindback suggested that Policy Book committee study every suggested motion for conflicts before including in the Agenda Book. Duty of Policy Book Committee was explained they put in policy what the BOD approves.

Futurity Motion #2: by Gulembo, Seconded by Tillson: I move to add the words "OR AGENT" be added anywhere the term breeder is used to define the breeder's responsibilities to nominate puppies or the Futurity Committee's responsibility to the breeders in the ABC Policy Book. #5 Page 34 Agenda Book 1 yes vote, 14 No votes (all Directors except Hunt), Motion Defeated.

Futurity Motion #3: Motion by Perry:, Seconded by Dow: I move to add the word "stake" to the last sentence under Dual Futurity Award Point System on page 123. Sentence to read "A dog cannot win points for getting a ribbon in a class or STAKE unless he defeats at least one dog." 13 Yes Votes, 2 No Votes (Droel & Lindback). Motion Passed.

Futurity Motion #4: Motion by Tillson, Seconded by Karbiner: I move that the Futurity has permission to reevaluate the entry fees and forfeit dates as needed to keep the futurity budget viable. Any changes would be submitted for approval to the ABC BOD prior to their Modification. This motion was withdrawn as it is already in effect in the Budget Process.

Futurity Action item #7, page 35 dealing with the wording dealing with Measuring dogs at the Futurity was also withdrawn as the present rule was left standing.

Futurity Action Item #9, page 35 to create a Futurity Handbook was not proposed as there is already one in existence.

National Specialty Show Chair Bryce Novotny was recognized by President Janulis. Due to the hurricane in New Orleans and lack of power, Bryce presented and oral report to the Board as his home in New Orleans had dealt with the devastating storm damage and lack of power. Show went very well this week.

Invitational Derby: Discussion took place regarding issuing points to dogs based on the length of the derby to qualify for the Invitational Derby.

Legislative Report Mary Jo Trimble: Mary Jo reported on what had been done in regard to The American Field Being sold to United Kennel Club. Brittany member questions had been submitted to Steeple Bell who was to be on a podcast with UKC in hopes of getting questions answered as to their intent and future of American Field. (As it turned out, the Podcast with Steeple Bell did not materialize. AKC does send clubs alerts on national legislation. Trimble spoke with Sportsmen's Alliance just before coming to Booneville. Our contribution to them is included in the budget.

Motion #5 page 31: Motion by Jim Hammett and Seconded by Gulembo: I move that for 2022 and all future years, the point calculation for the Derby Invitational shall include any horseback derby run for 20-30 minutes as follows: Ist-6 points x

dogs run, 2nd-4 points x dogs run, 3rd 2 points x dogs run. 3 yes votes, (Hammett, Brown, Tomasi) and 12 No votes, Motion Defeated.

Insurance: Tom Milam has resigned as ABC insurance chair. The Executive Secretary and Treasurer have been working with him and will continue to deal as we have with insurance until such time as a new Insurance Chair is announced.

Statistician Mary Karbiner reported on trial stats and asked that people would be more careful of the completion of these reports.

Motion #6, Webmaster: Motion by Tillson, Seconded by Dow: I move to add an "Auto-Renewal" option to the ABC Website PayPal Process, i.e., Membership-on-line. 14 Yes Votes, 1 No Vote (Hunt). Motion Passed.

Finance Committee makeup discussed. Finance Committee Chair also presented the Budget for 2022. Committee has one member from each region plus a Chairperson from one of the 5 regions. The formation and Member at Large Chair were discussed by Ms. Graves. The need for another East Coast member was discussed due to the resignation of Lucille Sawicki. The Committee submitted a name. Additional names were submitted by Director Tomasi. The Finance Chair said she would take the names back to the Committee to consider along with their current recommendation.

Motion #7: Finance committee makeup: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Gulembo: I move to change the (Finance) committee members from 6 to 5. Each region should only be represented once. Currently there are 2 committee members representing the central region. When the first term of a central region member expires (2022) this will bring the committee to one member per region. 7 Yes Votes, 8 No Votes (voting NO: Hunt, Alexander, Crain, Wice, Droel, Karbiner, Lindback, Tillson). Motion Defeated.

Motion #8 Budget Motion by Alexander, Seconded by Lindback: I move to accept the budget with proposed changes discussed. 8 Yes Votes, 6 No Votes, 1 Abstained. (Voting no: Dow, Perry, Anderson, Gulembo, Droel, Tomasi, Abstaining: Brown). Motion Passed.

Motion #9: Action Item #14, page 37 two parts: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Perry. Part one "Delete any revenue neutral request will not require BOD approval unless such request exceeds \$5,000". (PART ONE WAS TABLED).

Part two: Add: I move that "Money cannot be taken from a restricted use fund without board approval unless the total is under \$1000." 10 Yes Votes, 5 No Votes, (No votes from Hunt, Alexander, Crain, Lindback, Tillson). Motion Part two Passed.

Motion #10: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Lindback. Item 16, page 37. I move that we add the President's discretionary Fund of \$1000 be added to the Policy Book appendix. 15 Yes Votes, 0 No votes. Motion Passed.

National Magazine Cover Photo: After a discussion of how and what should be used for National Event Cover photos, the following motion was reached.

MOTION #11: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Perry: I move that cover photos will be the official win photo as provided by the ABC event chair or a candid photo submitted by the owner and approved by the Magazine Committee. Photo is to be submitted within 20 days after the National ABC event. 14 Yes votes, 1 No Vote, (Hunt voting NO). Motion passed.

Discussion involving rotation of National All Age and National Gun Dog Championships. Discussion went back and forth on how policy outlines the awarding of dates process is to be handled.

Motion #12: Motion by Lindback, Seconded by Karbiner: I move that we stop the proposed rotation of the National All Age and National Gun Dog championships at Booneville. 6 Yes Votes, 9 No Votes (Voting No Dow, Hunt, Perry, Anderson, Gulembo, Crain, Hammett, Brown, Tomasi). Motion Failed.

Motion #13: Motion by Perry, Seconded by Gulembo: See page 42 of Agenda Book, proposed motions #24, #25 and #26. I move to add the words "and dates" after the words "Site selection" in Policy book as well as also for the National Specialty Show. 10 Yes Votes, 5 No Votes (voting No Alexander, Wice, Karbiner, Lindback, Tillson.) Motion Passed.

Discussion of pros and cons of a certified Audit vs an Internal Audit done by the Finance Committee was discussed. Finance Chair Graves explained that the current process actually goes deeper than a certified audit. It would also cost in the range of thousands of dollars depending on who had checked with auditors near them. Several auditors reported that we were too small to need a certified audit. Gulembo withdrew his action items #29, 30, and 31 page 44 of the Agenda Book dealing with finances. No motion was heard on Action Item #32 for ANY monies or stipends paid to anyone with no amount of expenditure specified. It was pointed out that stipends are in the financial statements already.

National Qualifications Discussion: Perry

withdrew action item #27, page 43 of the Agenda Book at the Nationals regarding Field Trial Chairman's Checklists. As to Action Item #28 page 43 dealing with Drawings at the Nationals, this issue was tabled until there is a discussion with 1st and 4th Vice Presidents prior to the summer meeting in 2022. Qualifications had been relaxed the past few years due to Covid restrictions and cancellation of trials.

Motion #14: Motion by Dow, Seconded by Karbiner. I move that we remove from all the National Field Trial Championship Qualifications the reference to Covid in 2019 – 2021. 15 Yes Votes, 0 No Votes. Motion Passed.

Motion #15: Motion by Alexander, Seconded by Dow: I move to change the number of dogs needed to qualify in all 30 minute stakes as follows: ... Has placed in a (name stake) 30 minute stake in an AKC Licensed trial held by a Brittany Club in which the following (or more) dogs started: Ist place with 13 starters, 2nd place with 15 starters, 3rd place with 17 starters 4th place with 20 starters 12 Yes Votes, 3 No Votes (voting No Hammett, Brown, Tomasi) Motion Passed.

Motion #16: Motion by Perry, Seconded by Tomasi: I move to delete E-Mail Guidelines from the Policy Book, page 153. 14 Yes Votes, 1 No vote (voting No Karbiner.) Motion Passed.

Duties of the First Vice President:

Motion #17: Motion by Tomasi, Seconded by Perry. I move to adopt the proposals on page 47-48 of the Agenda Book with the following changes. Proposal #1 is tabled. #4: ADD C. With the Field Trial Secretary, review and approve all communications/documents to be provided to the membership and participants as it relates to the National All Age and Derby Invitational Events.

#5 Delete current paragraph in policy book. Change to Prior to the running of the National Championship and the National Amateur Championship, the 1st VP shall meet with the judges to discuss possible dog posting protocols. The final decision may change year to year based on the judicial panel's preference. The final decision as to how, or if, dogs will be posted will be announced at dinner the night before each event is to start.

#6: Delete current wording. Add: 6. Oversee or designate the purchase, receiving, and planting of birds for the National Championship and the National Amateur Championship as necessary to achieve a fair and quality event.

#7. Be responsible for the welfare of the Judges while they are in attendance at the National Stake, through coordination with the respective Stakes Manager and Field Trial Secretary.

No changes to #9 - 16. Remove "National" before any mention of Derby.

28 Add "ABC" before Garmin Coordinator.

#29 Add Contact the ABC contracted Saddle Company during the summer prior to the event to insure delivery of saddles for the National Championship and the National Amateur Championship.


