

The National Amateur Walking Championship was a class event following the Open Walking Championship. Ionia has some of the best gun dog courses in the country and the efforts of the folks committed to the grounds showed in the superb grooming. The running was delayed the first day until the afternoon due to rain. Light rain continued on and off for much of the championship, but it did not dampen the spirit of the handlers or the efforts of the dogs. There was a revised running order due to scratches and a bitch in season. Dogs scratched were Jolly's Christmas Holly and Detroit Rascal's Son of a Gun.

Many thanks to judge Ken Windom for filling in at the last minute to replace Kevin Remmers. Ronald Harling, Jr. was the other scheduled judge. Both gave their rapt attention being helpful and attentive. Continued support by Purina Pets and Garmin is most appreciated. This class event would not be possible without the willingness of many to give of their time. Dick Lipsky was able to plant birds after his hip replacement surgery due to the generosity of John Hall and his UTV. Carlos Gust and Dan Jolly also helped with care of the birds. Thank you to Eileen Gust for making sure that everyone was fed. Chuck Langstaff drove the dog wagon for his thirty-something year. He says he's retiring, but we'll see.... Thank you, Ron Gulembo for serving as course marshall, and Sue Lehosky for being



a superb secretary.

Brace 1: Atos, Jackie Hutwagner & Alder Zerandipity "Zera" Richard Johnson. Both dogs broke away forward and out of sight. At 5 Atos returned with a bird in his mouth. Zera was wide right and out of touch with the handler for a few minutes. She returned to the front and passed through the gap into Hire's field. She worked the left island with strong forward momentum. At 22 she was found standing on the back side of the island. Upon release she headed along the line to the right on the cross hedgerow. She headed north on the right side and at 30 she established point. It took some time for the handler to get to her and all was in order. She drew out towards the knoll field and established point to the right of the keyhole, but as the handler and judges started in her direction while still quite a distance away, she released and moved forward. Heading down the hill toward the Boy Scout bridge she made game on a left hedge row and pointed. All was good and she moved on to her final find on the right before the Boy Scout bridge.

Brace 2: Kip's Bay Flat Out Ridge Run-N Annie "Annie" John Kipp & Magnum's High Velocity Top Gunn "Gunnar" Vince Anderson. Breakaway at the derby course. Both dogs head raced to the right, with Gunnar returning toward his handler first. He cut across the gap and at 4 pointed in the left cross hedgerow with all in order. Annie joined her handler and headed forward. She pointed on the right hedgerow at the end of the derby course. She handled it with finesse. As Annie moved forward, scout called point for Gunnar in the woods to the left of the gap. He took steps as the bird circled under his belly. Unfortunately, Gunnar returned to the wagon. Annie continued across Sessions Creek bridge. At 19 in the 2nd field she was pointed again with all in order. At 25 a bird popped and Annie left point ending what started out to be a very nice run.

Brace 3: Starlight's Calliston Moon "Cal" Bob Bakas & Kdel's Eagle Magnum Hotshot "Shooter" Ken DeLong. Breakaway after the



dyke heading towards the shooting range. Cal headed left but then was brought forward. Shooter cut across and established point at 2 minutes at the first cross hedgerow. Cal cut across the field and backed Shooter. Unfortunately, he then moved up a little too close to Shooter, ending his bid. Handler fired for Shooter with all in order. Shooter moved on and carded another find at 8 at the top of the shotgun range. Shooter took off quickly and was next seen standing to the left of the entrance to the orchard where he was rewarded with another find. He worked methodically through the orchard and at 19 was found standing in some scrubby brush on the left side. This resulted in a non-productive. He drew down the hill to the right before the levy and snapped point at 21, carding another clean find. Moving towards the levy crossing he slammed point again at 26. He stood long and tall as it took the handler quite a while to reach him. He was rewarded for another clean find. At 37 he was standing on the right-hand side after crossing the levy with all in order. At 45 Shooter was standing on the right edge heading towards the derby course and again at 49 at the cross hedgerow scoring two more successful finds. After being released he swung wide right heading towards the bridge. He finished his hour at the top of Cardiac hill.

Day 1 posted Dogs: Zera 1B, Shooter 3B.

Brace 4: Romence's Life of Riley "Riley" Julie Romence & Blazing Spanish Bella "Bella" Gerald Barron. Both dogs broke away quickly up the hill and swung right with Bella being more forward. Bella hit point at 7 and Riley came in, but failed to stop and was picked up by her handler. All was in order for Bella. Upon release Bella moved farther up the hedgerow and pointed again. Unfortunately, the birds were moving and proved too tempting for her.

Brace 5: Miss Behavin' "Ivy" Dan Dodson & Magnum High Velocity "Gauge" Vince Anderson. Breakaway was at the first left turn on course one. Gauge had the first find of the brace in the feed strip to the right before entering the gap. Meanwhile, Ivy was moving forward and had a stop to flush on a 20-30 bird covey that were just to the right of the two-track. Gauge had his next find to the left of the gap heading into Hires field with Ivy coming in to back. When the dogs moved on farther down the south line, Gauge had a stop to flush. Gauge moved on to work the island and had a find at 14. Meanwhile Ivy started lining out in the next field and swung wide right and had a nice stylish find at 20. At this point in the brace Gauge had caught up and the dogs worked the left edge past the knoll. Gauge was on point three quarters of the way up the edge and Ivy failed to back ending her hour. Gun was fired for Gauge and he was moved on down the hill towards the boy scout bridge. He carded 3 successive finds working down the hill. At 49 Gauge established point at the right side before the bridge crossing. After a lengthy flushing attempt handler elected to move Gauge on just as the judge pointed out the birds. After the bridge crossing Gauge worked forward and established point at the top of the feed strip. Time was up and handler relocated Gauge, however, no birds were produced.

Brace 6: Nalko des Sentier du Ramier II "Nalko" Jackie Hutwagner

& Starlight's Mercury Out Ryder "Ryder" Teresa Richmond. Breakaway was at the derby course. At 4, Nalko was found standing on the back side of the left hedgerow while Ryder cast wide right. Nalko's handler fired with all in order for him. Ryder pointed on the opposite right hedgerow with all in order for him too. Nalko cast wide left upon release taking the edge almost to the end before jumping into the woods. Point was called for Nalko in the woods. After a lengthy flushing attempt and relocation, he came up empty and was moved on. After the Sessions Creek bridge crossing, Ryder made a huge cast towards the right and finished heading back towards the handler on the next hedgerow. Ryder turned on the backside of hedgerow and established point with Nalko backing. All was in order and the dogs were moved forward. Nalko pointed at 21 on the right edge. Ryder was leashed for not honoring. Handler of Nalko attempted a long flush, however, Nalko lost his intensity and handler leashed him as well.

Brace 7: Alder Whiskey Rebellion "Whiskey" Dennis Sloan & Waypoint Deacon of the Hunt "Deke" Thom Christnagel. Whiskey had his running shoes on for this brace. He went up and over the breakaway hill, that was the last he was seen. After being out the allotted time, the handler called for the Garmin. Deke worked left and jumped in the woods. At 10 he stopped establishing point. Handler made a flushing attempt and then relocated Deke, however, this resulted in no birds being flushed. At 18 in the feed strip to the right of the gap he pointed and was rewarded with his first clean find on an enormous covey of birds. While moving forward toward the gap to Hires field he was working wide left. While cutting back to handler scout called point for him in an island of trees to the left of the 2-track. Another clean find in the books. Moving forward towards the gap into Hires field Deke had another clean find to the left of the gap. At 30 Deke pointed on the island edge with all in order. Moving forward he worked the far-right edge in the next field after hires field and had another clean find at 36. Deke worked the left edge in the next field before the turn to the hill leading to the Boy Scout bridge. He broke off the edge and cut clear across the field to the far edge. He hit it, hooked left and followed it all the way around which brought him back towards the gap to the hill. A very nice cast. Heading down the hill, Deke pointed on the 2nd cross hedgerow for his final find of the brace.

Brace 8: Diamond Hill Storm Cat "Storm", Lisa Pollock & Mt View's Moloka'ls Dawn Breeze "Glenn" Stewart Morgan. Glenn and Storm broke away on the derby course. Glenn had a find almost immediately on the back side of the left hedgerow. Meanwhile, Storm was on the right parallel hedgerow, established point with handler relocating 3 times before Storm staunchly pinning the running birds. Moving farther down the hedgerow Storm slammed point and had a clean find followed up closely with three more successful finds with a final total of 7 finds for the brace. In the meantime, Glenn also carded three more finds and ended up with a total of 7 finds. Both dogs were bird finding machines throughout the brace although their range was somewhat limited.

Brace 9: Sigbrit's Evil Side of the Road, "Ren" Eddie Manifold &



High Velocity Copper Magnum, "Colt" Vince Anderson. Breakaway was into the shotgun range field. Colt broke strong and forward. Unfortunately, heading into the orchard he had a bird encounter which resulted in him being leashed. Ren filled the orchard and worked the edges wide and forward. After the levy crossing Ren continued with wide ranging snappy casts. He was gathered up and brought across Sessions Creek bridge. Moving forward at 27 Ren had a clean stylish find on the right, as you break into the derby course. With all in order. He was moved on, racing to the next objective. Ren had another clean find at 32 in the right perpendicular hedgerow heading towards Cardiac hill. Upon release, he had a stop to flush. He continued across the bridge and up and over Cardiac hill, meeting his handler on the downside of the hill. On the right grass strip in the field after the hill he slammed point. Handler relocated, but no birds were produced. Ren finished the hour searching out all the objectives the course presented him.

Posted dogs: Gauge 5B & Ren (A.

Day 3: There was a slight flog delay before braces could commence on the final morning.

Brace 10: Kip's Bay Dark N'Stormy Miss Maddie "Maddie", John Kipp & It's 5 O'Clock Somewhere "Cooper", Rebecca Walters. Both dogs broke strong heading down the backside of the right hedge row. A divided find was called with both handlers firing. All was in order with both dogs moving on. Cooper made a nice forward move along center hedgerow of Hires field. Both dogs broke into Hires field with Cooper working right and Maddie working wider to the left. Maddie worked her way down the island edge and pointed at the end of it. Handler flushed for Maddie with all in order. Both dogs broke into the next field and patterned in front of handlers at decent range. Coming through the gap after the knoll at 31 Maddie was on the back side of the hedgerow standing and Cooper came in for the back. All was in order and the dogs were moved on. Maddie worked the left edge at moderate range, while Cooper went wide right. Cooper cut back to his handler, went through the gap and had a buried up find on the first left hedgerow. At the same time Maddie had proceeded down the hill to the next left hedgerow and was standing. Handler attempted a lengthy flushing and relocation, but no birds were produced. Cooper had gone forward and at 47 had a clean find in the mott towards the end of the hill on the right. He was moved on towards the Boy Scout bridge. Maddie buried herself deep in that same right hand mott and carded a clean find. Both finished going forward after the bridge crossing.

Brace 11: Shirley's Britt for Saratoga "Toga", Paul Shirley & Jolly's Runnin Rylee, "Rylee" Dan Jolly. Breakaway at the derby course. Both dogs broke away with great ground speed. Rylee cut left down the 2nd cross hedgerow and established point at 2. Toga raced down the same hedgerow and failed to back. A real heartbreaker. Rylee's handler flushed with all in order. Rylee moved forward and took the right edge at the top of the derby course where she again pointed at 7. Handler elected to move her on after a modest flushing attempt. Upon release, Rylee moved to the end of that hedgerow and slammed point at 11. This find was fruitful and all was in order. After Sessions creek bridge, she swung wide left and would have finished the whole cast had she not ran into a couple of bicycle riders. She swung in front of handler, went through the gap and hit point on the right hedgerow. Handler flushed and fired with all in order. When she was released, almost immediately she wacked point in the middle of the field. Surprisingly, a bird was produced and Rylee stood high and tight through the shot. Continuing on, she cast down the right hedgerow and pointed. All was in order and she was moved on. As the course got tighter, Rylee handled to all the objectives. On the left side prior to the dyke crossing, Rylee pointed again and was rewarded with another clean find at 36. After the dyke crossing at the



cross hedgerow, Rylee hit point at time. After multiple relocations, no birds were produced ending Rylee's hour.

Brace 12: Pretty Eyes A Sweet Touch of Charlie B "Charlie", Bob Bakas & Spring Hill's Red Hot Performance "Red", John Bell. Breakaway towards the stand of oaks below the shotgun range field. Twenty seconds into the brace both dogs locked on point in separate locations along the oak hedgerow. Both handlers produced birds for their dogs. Moving forward to the shotgun range field, Red worked the far left edge of the course while Charlie worked the right. Red cast out to the far left in the orchard hunting the objectives. At 11, he had a stylish clean find. Upon release at 27 he had another clean buried up find in the little hill to the right of the 2-track heading to the levy crossing. Charlie continued his ground covering style through the orchard towards the levy crossing. At 23 after the levy crossing, Red pointed high and tight into the thicket. Birds were produced with all in order. Charlie was still utilizing all the course gave him. Red arrived in the derby course before his handler and established point in the hedgerow to the left. Charlie came up the hill from the lower side and his handler was unable to get him to go forward. Charlie didn't stop to back and the birds lifted. Red stood for a time but opted to leave the scene.

Brace 13: Alder's Sophie Brook "Sophie" Dan Campbell & Bark River Fresh Water Pearl "Pearl", Jeff Stanton. Breakaway at the top of the derby course heading back towards the Boy Scout bridge. Both dogs cut right with Sophie establishing point and Pearl backing. Handler elected to relocate Sophie and Pearl was moved on. Pearl doubled back, returned to the find, and was leashed. A dead bird was in front of Sophie so she was taken on. Sophie worked her way over the bridge and up cardiac hill with moderate range searching all the objectives. In the feed strip heading towards the sand pit, she was found with a dead bird and was leashed.



ABC Grouse & Woodcock Classic

October 7-8, 2021 By Tom Goltz







The American Brittany Club Grouse Classic started in 1954 and ran each year until 1970. According to The Book of The American Brittany Eighties Edition, "Declining entries caused the Classic to cease running following the 1970 trial." The Classic was not held from 1971-1985.

Don Didcoct was an innovator and forward-thinking person in the Badger Brittany Club, and he took the initiative with some members of the Minnesota Brittany Club to reorganize the format of the Classic. They added the Woodcock as a named bird to the trial. In 1985, the Minnesota Brittany Club request to reinstitute the Grouse Classic as the Grouse and Woodcock. In 1986, the Classic was run at the Mora Minnesota grounds and Don's dog FC/AFC Hominy Grits II was named Winner. Thirty-Five years later the American Brittany Club Grouse and Woodcock Classic is still running showcasing class bird dogs. The Classic is run on native grouse and woodcock continuous courses through the forest.

For many years the Classic rotated between our friends at the New England Brittany Championship Association, Michigan Brittany Club and Badger Brittany Club in Wisconsin. Most recently it has been just New England and Badger in the rotation. Badger was the host in 2018. In 2020, Badger was asked host it due to Covid restrictions on the East Coast and this year the East Coast was not able to hold it. We hope a return to a normal schedule will happen next spring in Rhode Island.

Preparation for a continuous course trial always involves clearing trails for handlers, judges, marshals and gallery. This year our sister club Chippewa Valley Grouse Dog Association handled most of the hard work of preparing nearly 13 miles of trails. We thank them for their effort!! Prior to the ABC Classic two other Championships were held on the Eau Claire County Forest grounds - North Country Championship and Wisconsin Cover Dog Championship.

We always appreciate the support of our sponsors Purina and Garmin. Their support adds greatly to the overall success of the trial. It's very evident that the owners and handlers believe in their products as most the dogs were collared with Garmin GPS units and many owners feed Purina to fuel healthy and winning dogs. The winner received a Garmin Pro 550 Plus/TT15 system, and all winners received multiple bags of Purina Pro Plan Performance. Purina also provided all participants in the event with 2 lb. bags of Pro Plan Performance. A huge thank you goes to Eau Claire County without our partnership with them we would not be able to host these trials. The collaborative cooperation relationship we have the Eau Claire County Parks Director Josh Peterson and his staff Jody, Gindt, Jake Tumm and others is outstanding and much appreciated. Eau Claire County has over 50,000 acres of public forest and we are very fortunate to be able to be one of the many groups utilizing this fine resource.

Quality judges are a very necessary ingredient when it comes to evaluating class cover dogs. We were blessed to have two of the finest. Tim Kaufman who runs primarily English Setters was up to the task of walking nearly 10 miles and very attentively watching the dogs. Tim has been quite successful in the grouse woods winning multiple championships and the prestigious Don Didcoct Memorial Championship on these grounds. Tim is always a pleasure to be around and carries a smile at all times. Our carry over judge Brent Sittlow has judged numerous championships and is highly regarded throughout the Midwest. Brent has a quiet demeanor and gives his utmost attention to the dogs and always helpful suggestions to the handlers if requested. Brent has had successful string of Pointers however family obligations has him currently busy with other activities we are pleased to have a judge as highly regarded as Brent evaluate our dogs.

I'm not sure if its global warming or what but the temperatures this fall have been abnormally warm. With warm temperatures come mosquitos in the forest and we had them. Fortunately, all courses parallel the Eau Claire River so the dogs can take a dip and get wet. Multiple birds were moved on all courses and most dogs had opportunities on grouse or woodcock. The woodcock flight had not quite arrived yet but there were adequate local birds for the dogs.

The Running

The day started with a light mist and 60 degrees and warmed as the day went on.

Brace 1: (Gasline Course) Bark River Fresh Water Pearl /Stanton and Rib River Tough Enough Two /King. The action was off to a guick start as a grouse flew out at 1. No dogs were involved. From 3 to 12 Tuffy laid out a nice forward race, then both dogs worked a winter holly/ alder patch hard for a few minutes. At 31 Tuffy returned from a deep cast to the right along a promising edge. At 33 Tuffy was again forward and in heavy alder cover when he hit scent and slammed on point. Judge Sittlow heard, then saw a grouse run out, Roger put it to flight and shot. Tuffy remained tall and focused throughout. At 41 and 47 Tuffy stopped briefly, then moved on close to the end of the brace, Tuffy pointed again to the right of the course in heavy tags. Roger flushed and shot when a woodcock flashed. The bird was not visible to the judge. Overall Tuffy had a hard charging race, mostly forward and in good cover. His bird work was flawless on a difficult running grouse. Pearl worked the course hard until 48 when she hit scent and pointed Jeff flushed the grouse exploded from cover and Pearl chased, ending her quest for another placement. Two woodcock were flushed shortly after the grouse was pointed.

Brace 2: (Highline Course) MJ's Box of Rain /Daley and Red Granite's I Am A Rock /Asmus. Both dogs broke away well and got down to business. We crossed the first logging road at 8, both dogs well forward. Rocky made two more big casts to the right along the river. Rainy

was the slower of the two but worked good cover with enthusiasm. She was sometimes difficult to pull back unto the course. At 57 Rainy pointed, Mike and judge went in, no bird was produced.

Brace 3: (Horse Creek Course) It's 5 O'clock Somewhere / Walters and Bark River Queen Of Diamonds /Stanton. Cooper is a promising young male who prior to today, had no experience on the grouse or woodcock. He has done quite well on pen raised birds so Rebecca decided to enter him in a cover dog trial. Cooper rewarded her confidence in him with several good finds and a reasonable race. Cooper suffered an unproductive at 10. The judge spotted Cooper on point at 27, just 10 yards off the trail, he alerted Rebecca who walked in to flush a woodcock all in order. At 39 in a woods opening, Rebecca called the flight of a grouse and shot. Cooper was credited with a stop to flush. At 41 Cooper hit scent while still on the trail, Rebecca flushed then sent him on. Cooper made a fine relocation on a running woodcock all in order. Daisy ran hard but was a bit hard to handle Jeff called for the tracker at 35. Both handlers moved several grouse on the way out.

Brace 4: ("H" Course) Clarice Havapal's Pocket Pistol /Holtz and MJ's Sweet Sugar Magnolia /Daley. After a short lunch break the dogs broke away. Clare ran a snappy but brief forward race in good cover. Maggie ran exceptionally well for a 13-year-old. She has regularly placed in this event and won it in 2019. She may have lost some of her speed but hasn't lost her enthusiasm and ability to find birds. Just after the bridge crossing at 6 both bells were silent. Maggie was found honoring Clare, both doges intense, Maggie four feet behind Clare. Bill flushed a welllocated grouse and shot. Mike, confident it was a divided find, quickly shot over his dog. Maggie stayed steady Clare did not. Clare's effort for the day ended. Maggie hunted hard from 19-23 to the left of the trail. Maggie pointed; Mike flushed but couldn't produce a bird. Maggie was sent on to relocate but couldn't find the bird. At 41 Maggie established an intense stand 20 yards to the left of the trail. Mike flushed a grouse and shot. As he went in to release Maggie a woodcock flushed four feet to the front of the dog's nose. As time was called, Maggie was working some turkeys at the top of a bluff. It took Mike about 10 minutes to get her back.

Brace 5: (Diablo Jake Course) Repeat's Little 501 Blues /Asmus and Hy Steppin Ali's Got Attitude /Sennott. These two dogs laid down some of the strongest races of the day as the temperatures climbed into the 70's. Both dogs were forward and covered the best ground well. At 45 Levi was becoming a bit erratic and Julie picked him up. Ali only got stronger as we got closer to the finish. At 58 Ali established a solid point. Chris walked in, the well-located grouse flushed, and Ali went with the bird. Had her manners on the flush been sterling, she certainly would have been considered for the Classic.

- The 2023 American Brittany Futurity shall be open to every Brittany bitch and her
 progeny whelped during the calendar year of January 1 December 31, 2021, who
 is owned or leased by a member of The American Brittany Club, and whose litters
 have been Futurity nominated with The American Brittany Club. Sires do not
 necessarily have to be owned/leased by an American Brittany Club member. All
 dams nominated and all sires bred to must be registered with AKC, CKC, or FDSB.
- The nominating breeder needs to be a current full member in Good Standing of the ABC when the litter is nominated and the closing dates of the of the Sectional Futurities in which puppies from their nominated litter compete. They must sign the Litter Nomination form, and any breeder purse checks will be paid to this designated nominated breeder. If their membership has lapsed at the time of the Sectional Futurity, the purse will revert back to the ABC Futurity Administrative Fees.
- Nominations of dams must be made within 60 days after a bitch has whelped, and a Nomination Fee of \$40.00 ("First Forfeit") must be paid at this time. This payment will entitle each puppy of the nominated litter to be entered in the ABC Futurities (Field and/or Show) after the puppy has been properly registered with AKC or FDSB. Nomination Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors.

- Late litter nominations will be accepted with the following current fee schedule: In addition to the Nomination Fee of \$40.00, late fees are \$60.00 (total of \$100) for 61-90 days, and \$100.00 (total of \$140) for 91-180 days.  Fees as well as Sectional Futurity Entry Fees are set by the ABC Board of
 Directors and subject to change.

It's Only a Barrel

by Dave Webb

To train and teach a dog it's important to consider that there are tools, techniques, and procedures used during the time it takes to have a dog ready for competition, which may be field events, agility, obedience, or in the show arena. In addition there are specific objectives to achieve during this process.


The writer has a background in wood products and the research and development of specific projects to achieve a finished product; meeting a goal. Same applies to taking a pup to be a finished Brittany, "steady-to-wing and shot" as a field trial dog. This also applies, as stated above, to dogs

that will compete in the show arena, agility, and obedience compete in those events. However for the first seven to eight weeks, it is the breeder and then the new owner, who have control in development of a pup.

Thus a plan develops as follows:

- A puppy from the day it's whelped needs to be given a "hands-on" approach. The goal is to socialize the pup, which starts just a few days after birth. Pups eyes open and hearing starts usually between day 12 and 15.
- The next several weeks are a time pup will continue to be with littermates. They share food, play fight, and sleep; as
 - research has shown there is not much in the way of learning.
- It starts in about week seven or eight pup is often off to a new home when their mind becomes a "sponge". Pup learns so quickly; name, commands of come, whoa, stay, no, etc. and recognizes the master's voice. The use of our voice is so important; it should be the only method of disciple for pup.
- As previously indicated, this is the time pup will have a new home. For the next weeks and months formal training should start with the pup. Initially it can continue being taught simple commands. Training

- at this time should be simple and brief with no punishment; everything should be fun. When pup is called by name to "come"; it should be running to you with tail wagging. A treat may also be in order, but a positive greeting toward pup is most important.
- Specifically at three to four months formal training will include basic "yard" work obedience including heal, whoa, stay, and come. If pup is going to be hunting or compete in field trial, this is the time for exposure to birds. Let the pup go after the bird, chase and have fun it's all about instilling desire for game birds.



The barrel is a significant new dog training tool. In recent years trainers have begun to use the barrel as a training tool. The barrel is unique, positioning a pup on the barrel, even at the age of two or three months, will have a positive outcome. The barrel is a safe place for pup. It has a carpeted surface so pup will not slide off. There is a lead attached to the collar to maintain control. Most

important pup has complete control over what happens while it's on the barrel. Whether pup is competing in the field or show arena, it will learn including how to stand with style, to whoa, and stop to flush. The barrel with brief/short sessions will help pup learn under a minimum amount of pressure. It's only a barrel, which is an important new tool to be used in training pointing dogs.

The ultimate goal is to have a Brittany that is a great member of the family, a finished show dog, performs with places consistently in field trial events, and goes hunting for upland game birds with other family members on Thanksgiving Day.



Also, thank you to the committee and members for all of their endeavors.

The morning was cloudy and cool, the afternoon heated up with warm temperatures in the high 70s.

Champion: TJ's Black Diamond (Brace 5), Runner up Champion: Kips' Bay Flat Out Run-N Annie (Brace 6), Third place: Marjo's Fille de la Bretagne (Brace 3), and Fourth place: Magnum's High Velocity (Brace2).

Brace 1: Black Magic Belle of the Ball (Belle) - Rick Taglang and Kip's Bay Dark N' Stormy Miss Maddie (Maddie) - John Kipp. Both dogs were close working to the front. 47 dogs came to the line for this year's running, with judges Bob Barker and Howard Burbach in the saddle to adjudicate their performances. We thank them for their time in the saddle and their attention to each performance. Many members of the Southern Kansas Brittany Club were on hand to make the running of this event possible – Herb Rhea, Terry Gowin, Matt Harris, Nathan Hopper and Scott Johnson worked hard all week to keep things rolling along; we thank them all for their efforts!

These events would not be possible without the support of our sponsors, Purina and Dogs Unlimited. Purina provided their Sport Formula Dog Food for each placing dog as well as continued financial support to make this sport that we love possible. Dogs Unlimited provided generous Gift Certificates to the handlers of each placing dog to select some of the many quality products from their catalogue. We are truly grateful to both of these fine companies and their continued support of our events.

Tuesday evening, the club arranged a private dinner in Eureka; an incredible meal of Prime Rib prepared by Deanna Jensen, owner of Cake Batter, Batter. Deanna and her assistants, Georgia and Zoie, presented us with one of the finest Prime Rib Dinners that I've ever eaten. Deanna's bakery is a high end sandwich and sweets shop that creates wonderful baked good, ice cream and other sweet treats that are as beautiful to look at as they are to eat; they can ship them too!

We could not begin to have a competition of this quality, without the generous hospitality of our hosts, Marilynn & Bill Oliver. Their beautiful ranch is a combination of wide-open fields, wooded draws and rocky mesas, presenting challenging courses for the dogs to search for game under challenging atmospheric conditions. Blowing winds and low humidity, made finding and pointing game difficult and caused the birds to be fairly jumpy at times. Multiple covey finds on released and wild quail provided regular excitement as handlers went to flush for their

charges.

This year's winner, Willie Make It, ran Wednesday morning, in the 14th brace and was handled by Scott Johnson. Willie had his first find at 2 min. in trees below the NW mesa with nice style and intensity. His second and final find came at 30 min. on a pair of quail prior to the tractor tire crossing. Willie efficiently worked the wooded draws in continuous moves with a self-directed, pleasing flow and pattern; his hour ended before the high post gate in the canyon section.

Runner-up honors went to Sniksoh Hank's Hatch who ran Wednesday afternoon in the 18th brace and was handled by Bob Burchett. Hatch had his first find at 37 min. far to the front on a covey in the cedars at the base of the mesa of the hayfield section. At 47 mins. he was found dug up on a pair, below the high post gate, east of the fence with handler and judges needing to cross the fence and walk to the find. Upon release, Hatch ran downhill 50 yards to stand again at 51 min. on a huge covey in the open field of the bowl area. Hatch ran hard, wide, fast and forward for his hour with big moves and an efficient pattern.

Third place was awarded to Wild Will Willie, handled by Ed Tillson on Wednesday afternoon in the 17th brace. Willie carded 3 nice finds; the first at 23 min. near the watershed on the SW end of the course, his second came at 40 min. before the flat rock crossing; his final and most memorable find came at 46 min. deep in the draw leading towards the Custer Battlefield sign. He had nice style and intensity on his finds, a forward run, was hunting hard the entire hour and making moves. Willie was out of pocket as time expired but was found and returned to judgement within the allotted time frame.

Fourth place went to Almaden's Under Lock and Key, handled by Ed Tillson in the 19th brace which ran Thursday morning. Oudi carded his first find at 30 min. with a relocation being necessary below the watershed of Sycamore Canyon, his second at 50 min. on a nice covey near the gate below the mesa east of camp and his 3rd and final find at 59 min.; each displayed style and intensity. Oudi's run was forward and consistent in pace, pattern and range, consistent hunting and requiring minimal effort to handle. Oudi displayed exceptional manners by backing his bracemate on his own at 20 min. and previously carded a crisp stop to flush at 15 min.

The running:

Brace 1: WW's Miss Wendy Peffercorn

Hastings. Wendee was away fast and forward
to stand at 4 min. on a pair with all in order.
She was out of pocket at the rock crossing and

regained the front at 22 min. with a nice move along the draw to stand in the middle of the mesa field there at 28 min. where a kerfuffle occurred to end her bid. Arrow was off hard to the wooded sections of the breakaway field and worked along them, being last seen around the 9 min. mark; the tracker was requested at the 22 min. mark just past the rock crossing.

Brace 2: Kashmir - Tom Tracy and JJ's Levi the Lion Heart - Joe Williams. Breakaway was before the head of Sycamore Canyon with Kash standing at 3 min. with all in order. Levi was well forward of the find moving nicely with good moves early and stood at 31 min. Levi continued to remain forward with his range and pattern fluctuating at times. His second find came below the High Post gate at 48 min. with all in order. After Kashmir's find, he worked forward at a moderate pace and range, getting out of pocket as we passed camp returning at the gate due east before the pond. Kash stood along the cedars on a large covey at 54 min. below the mesa of the Hayfield area with all in order.

Brace 3: JagOub's WhoDat Say WhoDat – Tom Tracy and Sniksoh Hank's Gypsy Cruise – Bob Burchett. Breakaway was at the "Stupid Loop" section affectionately named by So. Kansas Club Members and headed south towards the crossing below the Watershed. WhoDat was away fast and furious along the mesa's edge, then shot far to the east. Cruise worked forward and handled well working the likely spots until an errant encounter with game at 18 min. WhoDat returned at 17 min. working forward nicely and along the woods of the draw to end his day at 25 min. on an errant encounter with game.

Brace 4: Trio's I'm Finn-Tastic at Campbell's – Bob Burchett and SS Rig's Colorado Gun Runner – Tom Milam. Both dogs were away fast and forward and working well for their handlers. Riggs carded a stop to flush at 10 min. and then upon release carded a find at 11 min. with all in order. Both dogs were wide and sweeping in their moves after the crossing with Riggs standing at 20 min. on a small covey below the Derby course mesa. He worked uphill as had Cruise who stood at 26 min. with beautiful style but ended his day with a breach of manners. Riggs stood just 100 yards past there, at 28 min. with a similar breach ending his bid.

Brace 5: SKF Miss Cheap Bourbon Whiskey – Steven Foster and Been There – Tom Tracy. KD broke away heading for the head of Sycamore Canyon and worked forward there with good range and application. She continued to hunt edges and tree motts, applying herself in a pleasing, forward manner the remainder of the

hour without any bird contact for her efforts. Tip also worked well for his handler making reaching moves at times and hunting the likely places without any contact with game until his handler elected to pick him up at 45 min.

Brace 6: Urban American Legend – Steve Chang and JoWill's Daniel in the Lion's Den – Joe Williams. Urbi was away with speed making some nice moves early with his speed and application not pleasing his handler who ended his bid at 27 min. Daniel was away running forward and taking edges, hunting hard through the country until he dug in approaching the Watershed area and was lost at 18 min. requiring the tracker.

Brace 7: Maxwell's Prickly Pete – Tom Tracy and Dogwood's Fireball Whiski – Bob Burchett. Pete broke away fast and hunting from the start, carding a stop to flush at 4 min. Upon release, he drove north to parts unknown, requiring the tracker at 18 min. Whiski made a huge opening move, forward north and across to the front continuing forward to stand at 15 min. in the trees at the base of the NW mesa with all in order. Upon release, he worked the woods along the entire base of the mesa and into the draw leading down towards the crossing to have an errant encounter with game at 20 min. ending his bid.

Brace 8: Treasure States Toby Mac Daddy – Ed Tillson and Georgia's White Lightning – Tom Tracy. Toby broke away fast working the trees along the creek, crossed and swung wide left, across to the draw taking it up to and across the Derby mesa field and dropped into Sycamore Canyon to disappear there requiring the tracker at 17 min. George ran forward making some nice moves at moderate speed and range throughout the hour. He carded a stop to flush at 12 min. and a find on a large covey at 14 on the mesa near Sycamore Canyon. George carded a 2nd covey find at 30 min. and a baren stand at 52 min. and his hour ended near the high post gate.

Brace 9: Warbonnet & Campbell's Skye's the Limit - Ben Campbell and McChesney's All Down the Line - Scott Johnson. Both dogs were away with speed and purpose, driving forward at distance. Nearing the "Loop", Ranger crossed the draw heading southwest where he was last spotted by the judges going over the rise heading towards Beaumont and retrieved near there by Scott. Skye had her first find at 36 min. in the draw leading towards the cabin. Afterwards, she was fluid in her run making many nice moves that needed more completion as mentioned by the judges. She was hunting hard most of her hour, evidenced by her dug up find at 52 min. on a wild covey of 20+ birds. Her hour ended near the base of the bowl area

heading west towards camp.

Brace 10: Sigbrits Not in Kansas Anymore - Scott Johnson and Ru-Jem's Dirty Dingus McGee - Tom Tracy. This pair split up right away with Doti running big and forward on the right staying forward up to her find at 12 min. near the trees below the NW mesa with style. After release, she wasn't herself and shortened considerably; her handler ending her day at 22 min. Dingus headed for the wooded section at breakaway and worked there forward along the creek to be found standing at 20 min. in the wooded area of the creek near the crossing on a small covey with nice style and intensity. He worked at moderate speed and range, nicely hunting along the draw at the top of the Derby course and headed towards Sycamore Canyon were his handler picked him up at 27

Brace 11: Wiyanna – Terry Gowin and Big Mac XIV – Tom Tracy. Annie and Mac broke away into a stiff wind heading down Sycamore Canyon with Annie staying consistently forward and hunting diligently over her hour. She dug deep and showed well in the bowl and hayfield courses finishing in the draw along the bottom of the "Loop" without a bird for her efforts. Mac worked the bowl section well staying forward and hunting the likely spots without a bird as well. Having shortened, his handler elected to end his day near the High Post gate at 45 min.

Brace 12: Godfather's Red Feather Gunslinger - Steve Chang and Coos Triple Six - Scott Johnson. Gunnar broke away wild and far flung to the east along the mesa's edge eventually slipping over the top headed towards the bowl section. Boomer broke away to the front dropping down to hunt hard along the draw leading towards the Watershed and the crossing near the road. Boomer continued working well for Scott until reaching the bowl section heading towards the Red Gate, where having shortened up Scott ended his day at 48 min. Gunnar rejoined Steve just before the Flat Rock Crossing and hunted well there and throughout the Windmill Draw. Upon dropping into the Bowl area, Gunnar worked due east into the trees there requiring the tracker at 45 min.

Brace 13: Rodeo Romeo – Ed Tillson and JWB's Artic Cat – Tom Tracy. Tuff and Kimber broke away in a hurry; Kimber stretching across the front to pick up the wooded drainage heading north. Deer and Kimber were spotted crossing onto the adjoining ranch at 6 min. with handler and scout in pursuit. Tuff ran a moderate race, hunted hard in all the likely places to stand stylishly at 11 min. enthusiasm getting the best of him, ending his day. Tommy called for the tracker at 25 min.

Brace 14: Roustabout's All In - Tom

Tracy and Willie Make It – Scott Johnson. This pair broke away towards the NW corner of the course with Willie's winning run detailed earlier. Al immediately headed back downhill to stand with style at 3 min. on a non-productive. He caught the front as we crossed unto the Derby course unto the mesa top where he worked the field toward Sycamore Canyon to stand again at 14 min. on a small covey; a breach of manners ended his bid there.

Brace 15: Georgia's Tiger 2.0 – Tom Tracy and Arrow's Tequila Rustler – Richard Beaver. Tiger and Rusty broke away towards the High Post gate, with moderate range and speed. Tiger carded a baren stand at 2 min., after which he stretched nicely dropping into the Hayfield section working the base of the mesa until picked up by his handler at 20 min. Rusty put down a consistent run with a pleasing pattern. He efficiently hunted the cover presented him, carding a wild covey at 4 min. He made several nice moves up to the west side of the Watershed where he stood again at 34 min.; a breach of manners ended his bid.

Brace 16: TNT's Handsome Harry – Bob Burchett and Roustabout Freddie M – Tom Tracy. Harry and Freddie broke away west of the Watershed with Harry being forward, fast and reaching. He hunted hard his entire hour with a baren stand at 7 min., he slowed some over the last half and ended his time without a bird. Freddie worked nicely at moderate speed staying forward to stand at 17 min. ending as a non-productive. Reaching the mesa his pattern wasn't pleasing his handler who ended his bid at 25 min.

Brace 17: Wild Wild Willy – Ed Tillson and Prairie Wind Pistol Pete – Tom Tracy. Willy's 3rd place performance is detailed above. PD ran fast and hard with a forward pattern hunting many of the likely places. He made some very nice moves and caught the eye at times, though went bird less, despite these efforts during his hour.

Brace 18: Sniksoh Hank's Hatch – Bob Burchett and Quanah – Tom Milam. Hatch's runner-up performance is detailed above. Chief took some work to get lined out early, settling in and working well for Tom as we approached the Red Gate. There, Chief dropped down into Sycamore Canyon, below the cabin, working it uphill west of the course. His scout and handler had quite the adventure retrieving their charge after calling for the tracker at 15 min.

Brace 19: Godfather's F.N. Rockstar – Steve Chang and Almaden's Under Lock and Key – Ed Tillson. Oudi's 4th place performance is detailed above. Rocky was away forward and fast at the start to stand staunchly at 14 min. amongst the trees below the NW mesa. He

stood again with beautiful style at 20 min. near the rock wall leading to the crossing. His pattern ranged from very pleasing to challenging at times for his handler over the course of his hour. He showed his class by executing a stop to flush when he popped around the cover as Oudi's last find was flushed near there. This occurred right at 60 min. while his handler was searching for him elsewhere.

Brace 20: R&H Dark Nite - Bob Burchett and CVK's Jungleland - Tom Tracy. Mack and Clarence broke away at the gate leading to the High Post gate portion of the bowl, with both dogs away with great speed. Mack made big moves with a fluid gait and attractive manner of eating up the country. He swung far and wide yet responded to his handler's calls. At the SW corner of the course on the west side of the Watershed, Mack experienced a kerfuffle ending his bid at 30 min. Clarence's application grew with separation, and he made nice moves into the Hayfield area and stood nicely at 20 min. off the cedars below the mesa, marking the flight of the birds. After catching the front near the Watershed crossing, he hunted well to stand again at 45 min. where a breach of etiquette ended his bid.

Brace 21: CVK's Spartan King – Tom Tracy and Alder Grand Hopes Penny Ante – Bob Burchett. Leo and Penny took off with purpose heading toward Windmill Canyon. Leo stood at 3 min. with Penny supplying plenty of pressure ending her day there at 3 min. He was credited with a find and made nice moves from there, across the mesa and dropped back into the Bowl section. Leo dug deep into the wooded areas there amongst the trees. Tommy elected to pick him up near there at 25 min.

Brace 22: Osage Fork Slick – Bob Burchett and Tequila Scorcher – Ed Tillson. Slick broke away flying forward way to the front, worked across the course at great distance to be found standing far forward at 11 min. where he proceeded to end is day with unsanctioned activities. Lincoln moved nicely and worked well for Ed, staying to the front and hunting well. He stood at 14 min. near the pond past the NW mesa, where temptation got the better of him ending his bid.

Brace 23: ANJ's Ohio Hellion – Bob Burchett and Cedar Valley Zeke – Tom Tracy. Hank and Zeke broke away working within close proximity of each other initially. Upon separation, Hank hunted well along the trees of the draws and through the entire bottom of Sycamore Canyon to stand briefly at 25 min. Zeke worked well upon separation, running fast and animated down the trees on the left draw of the Derby course where proximity of birds, both dogs, and handlers ended their brace at 25 min.

Brace 24: Sundance Kid's Rule Breaker – Frank Campbell, BYE. Bud started slow and unsure, improving over time and growing considerably the last 30 min. When working in the Hayfield section, he stood at 41 min. below the mesa there, dug in the cedars. Frank relocated him and flushed diligently to no avail. After this baren stand, Bud worked the "loop" section down along the draw amongst the trees there where he established point repeatedly at 49 mins. without a definitive stand being carded. Bud's hour ended just before the Watershed.


