The ABC National Championship commenced November 22, 2021 at J. Perry Mikles WDA, Booneville, Arkansas. 42 dogs were drawn to compete in this prestigious event.

The ABC Championship was established in 1951 and has been held at J. Perry Mikles WDA grounds for the past 35 years. This superb venue is equipped with a spacious club house and is a great place for lunches, dinners and meetings. A nice horse barn with approximately 40 stalls along with outside horse pens and a horse washing station adds to comfort of one's equine. 60 or so dog kennels are in place as

well. Limited camp grounds fill up quickly as attendees from all across the nation come to enter this event. Thanks to the Arkansas Game And Fish Commission, manager Brad Wells and crew, the grounds were groomed to perfection.

It takes a village to put on a trial and keep it running smoothly. Making this happen was President Ed Janulis, 1st VP/Field Trial Chairman Kent Patterson, Field Trial Secretary Steve Ralph, Stake Manager Claude Kilpatrick, Course Marshalls Paul Doiron and Ed Tillson. Gallery Marshall Brett Lindback, Dog Wagon Coordinator Tom





White, Wrangler Scott Johnson and caterer, Judy Tipton.

Sunday evening Field Trial Chairman Kent Patterson made announcements and introduced the reporter Rita Ornsby, judges, Johnny Ornsby, Greenbrier, AR and Harold Woodward, Vilonia, AR.



Following the announcements and introduction of the judges, a dinner and Calcutta was held kicking off the trial.

On Tuesday night, Norm Ahl hosted a great prime rib dinner for his 2020 National Amateur Champion, Blew Me Away (Bud). Handled by Joe Gower, the clubhouse was decorated in Southwest flair with all in attendance enjoying the dinner and dance floor afterward.



Judges Johnny Ornsby and Harold Woodward are seasoned and supremely qualified adjudicators. Both have a rich history in the sport and successfully trained and campaigned their own dogs. They set a wonderful pace throughout the running, giving each contender their undivided attention. Their decisions were well received by all.



The Champion Piney Run Hilltop Blew, four and half year old white and orange Brittany male owned and handled by Kent Patterson, Franklin, TN ran in the 10th brace, number one course. Blew started strong and up front, taking in the country going down the feed strips while checking the available cover in search of the elusive bob white. His efforts paid off as point being called at 6 with Blew standing staunch along a line of cover on the left margin of the course. Handler put birds to air as Blew demonstrated perfect manners through flush and shot. Sent on, Blew continued to roll through the country holding a far-flung pattern. He was seen in flashes as he hit the cover. Hat was in the air for Blew at 15, but this proved to be a pile of feathers. More than likely an avian predator enjoyed a partridge for lunch. Sent on, Blew



continued to eat up the country requiring very little scouting. He made a big swing in the old corral and was found standing at 37. Handler didn't have any luck putting birds to flight in an area known to hold an elusive covey. Released, Blew hunted the area nicely to no avail. As the gallery neared the double gates, Blew was seen deep on the river bottom where he faded out of sight. As the party neared the bridge, he was seen coming back from course 3 where he was gathered up and

The Running

Brace 1: Glade Run Bookers Shadow (Rush) and Maxwell's Heavy Hitter (Rogers). Booker had a find at 10. After an extended flush, birds were put to flight, all in order. Booker's race was not up to par this day. Gabe was disappeared from judgement early and failed to return.

Brace 2: Jagoub's Spell Caster (Alexander) and Tequila Chica Bonita (Beaver). Tabu had a wreck on birds at 35 and was harnessed.



sent up the river bottom to complete an exciting hour. He finished the hour as strong as he started in near 80-degree temperatures.

The Runner-Up Champion was Tequila Scorcher, eleven-year-old white and orange Brittany male, owned by Charles Crain and handled by Richard Beaver was named Runner-Up Champion. Lincoln, (call name) ran in the 12th brace course number three. Lincoln broke away strong to the front taking in the country carding a find at 10, with everything in order at flush and shot. Released, Lincoln headed for the front slamming on point at 12. Handler again put birds in air and all was good at flush and shot. Lincoln hung on the edges making nice casts hitting the cover in pursuit of old bob white. Handler had hat in the air 42. Lincoln was standing stanch for the flush and shot. Sent on Lincoln settled into a moderate race going to the right places hunting the edges. Point called at 52, but nothing could be produced. Released to relocate, Lincoln hunted the area but his effort was fruitless as old man bob white wasn't home.

JJ's Levi the Lionheart owned and handled by Joe Williams was awarded third place. Levi ran in the 13th brace course number one. Levi ran a wide forward race hitting an edge and taking it to the end,



Chica had finds at 20, 30, and a stop to flush at 46. She ran a moderate race finishing the hour.

Brace 3: CVK's Spartan King (Alexander) and Magnum High Velocity (Anderson). Leo was lost at 25. Gauge had an unproductive at 4, a stop to flush at 14, unproductive at 26 and was up at 30.

Brace 4: Firestarter Born Among the Stars (Macleod) and Lambachs Blew By You (Rogers). Handler picked Glory up at 45. Blue carded two unproductive and was up at 52.

Brace 5: Skf Jr's Straight Shooter (Foster) and WW's Miss Wendy (Wice). Colt was picked up at 42. Wendy had unproductives at 29 and 57.

Brace 6: B&T's Sonndance Kid Rock (Fowler) and Sundance Kid's Rule Breaker (Campbell). Rocky had a skunk encounter at 4, point called at 26 but this was a fist full of feathers only. Sent on, Trasa had her hat in air at 55 but after an extended relocation no birds were



then showing to the front, he maintained this throughout most of his hour with a find at 53 everything in order at flush and shot.

Piney Run Jake owned and handled by Kent Patterson was awarded fourth place. Jake ran in the ninth brace course number three. Jake ran the edges making consistently nice casts. His first find was at 10 as a single bird was flushed with everything in order. Taken on, Jake hung on the edges hunting all the likely places. Point called at 57

produced. Rocky ran a nice front race with very little scouting. Bud knocked birds at 42 and ended his bid.

Brace 7: Skf Miss Cheap Bourbon Whiskey (Foster) and ANJ's Ohio Hellion (Poehler). KD ran a nice race but finished the hour with no birds. Hank had the outer limits in sight, was gone at ten returned at 30, wasn't seen much throughout the hour.



Brace 8: Ss Rig's Colorado Gun Runner (Milam) and Wild Wild Willie (Cosgriff). Rigs ran a nice up-front race but had unproductives at 35 and 50, up at 55. Willie ran a wide race early but was done in at 20 by a covey near the Parish Field.

Brace 9: WW's Gin And Tonic (Wice) and Piney Run Jake (Patterson). Ginee had a wreck and was up at 55. Jake was previously reported.

Brace 10: Piney Run Hill Top Blew (Patterson) and TJ's Black Diamond (Perry). Blew's hour was summarized previously. Coal had a stop to flush at 25 and ran a moderate race.

Brace 11: Roustabout All In (Ralph) and Marjo's Fille De La Bretagne (Perry). Al had a wreck at 4 and got the roading harness. Brie had finds at 24 and 32. She was had a front running race but an erratic pattern. At pick up Brie went on point but handler did not attempt to flush.



Brace 12: Tequila Scorcher (Beaver) and Jwb Arctic Cat (Alexander). Lincoln has been previously reported. Kimber was gone at breakaway with an absence of 16 minutes, tracker at 57.

Brace 13: Spanish Corral's Big Iron (Gower) and JJ's Levi the

Lionheart (Williams). Colt was up at 42 as he wasn't pleasing his handler. Levi was previously reported.



Brace 14: High Velocity Copper Magnum (Anderson) and Carpe Diem (Lincoln). Gunnar was up at 46. Carpe was last seen at 7, tracker at 27.

Brace 15: Sniksoh Hanks Hatch (Freemen) and Sigbrits Not In Kansas Anymore (Blasi). Hatch knocked birds at 44 to end his hour. Dottie required quite a bit of scouting and stayed on the horse path a little too much. She finished with no birds.

Brace 16: Magnum's High Velocity Top Gun (Anderson) and Georgia's White Lightning (Tangen). Gauge just wasn't up to par this day picked up at 28. George was picked up at 15.

Brace 17: Arrow's Tequila Rustler (Beaver) and Sr's Blew By Typhoon (Gower). Rusty had an unproductive at 13, a find at 53 and ran a nice up-front race. Ty had an absence of 15, a find at 30 and missing at pick up time.



Brace 18: Rusty Ridge Where U Been (Kilpatrick) and Mtb Lets Have A Fee-Esta (White). Been knocked and chased birds at 12 to end his hour. Esta had an encounter with deer and was hot on their heels not to be returned in time.

Brace 19: Mtb Louree's V-0-2 Max (White) and MK's My Lil Ammo (Blasi). Max was up at 40 just couldn't put it together today. BB had a find at 48, was gone from judgment 20 minutes, settled in the last 12 minutes.



Brace 20: Gun Creek Gangster (Janulis) and Blew Me Away (Ahl). Doc finished the hour but no birds. Bud had a wreck at 46 to end his hour.

Brace 21: High Hopes Jac's Original Spice (Gulembo) and Just Call Me Lucky Ned Pepper (Campbell). Spice was gone at 41, came from behind at pick up. Ned had a find at 29 and was aggressive early but shortened late, ran out of course and had to finish in some pretty high cover to his disadvantage.

Brace 22: Tnt's Raise'N A Leprechaun (Thomas) This wasn't to be Dexter's day as he was under birds at 10 with handler reaching for his harness.

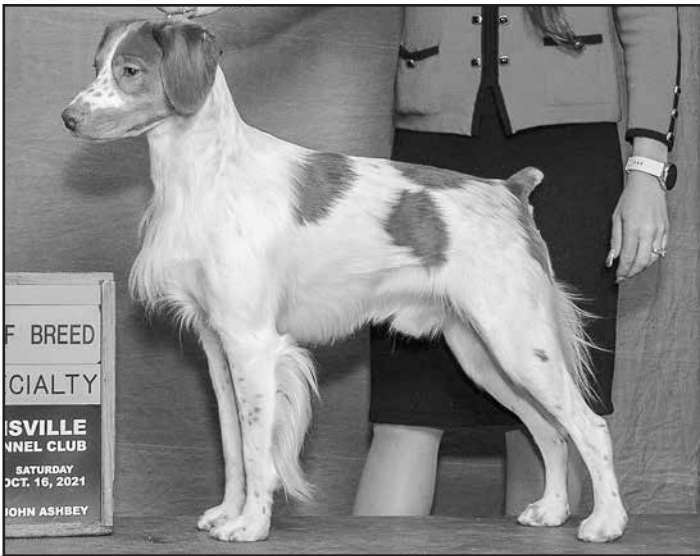

CONDITIONS AND RULES FOR FUTURITY ELIGIBILITY



- The **2023** American Brittany Futurity shall be open to every Brittany bitch and her progeny whelped during the calendar year of **January 1 - December 31, 2021**, who is owned or leased by a member of The American Brittany Club, and whose litters have been Futurity nominated with The American Brittany Club. Sires do not necessarily have to be owned/leased by an American Brittany Club member. All dams nominated and all sires bred to must be registered with AKC, CKC, or FDSB.
- The **nominating breeder** needs to be a current full member in Good Standing of the ABC when the litter is nominated and the closing dates of the of the Sectional Futurities in which puppies from their nominated litter compete. They must sign the Litter Nomination form, and any breeder purse checks will be paid to this designated nominated breeder. If their membership has lapsed at the time of the Sectional Futurity, the purse will revert back to the ABC Futurity Administrative Fees.
- Nominations of dams must be made within 60 days after a bitch has whelped, and a Nomination Fee of \$40.00 ("First Forfeit") must be paid at this time.** This payment will entitle each puppy of the nominated litter to be entered in the ABC Futurities (Field and/or Show) after the puppy has been properly registered with AKC or FDSB. Nomination Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors.
- Late litter nominations will be accepted with the following current fee schedule:** In addition to the Nomination Fee of \$40.00, late fees are \$60.00 (total of \$100) for 61-90 days, and \$100.00 (total of \$140) for 91-180 days. Nominations after 180 days will be accepted at the discretion and decision of the ABC Futurity Committee. The postmark will determine the fee for late nominations. The ABC Board of Directors may impose additional late fees from time to time.
- A Final Forfeit Fee, to be eligible to compete in the Sectional Futurities (Western/Central/Eastern), is due by October 1, 2022, and is submitted by the owner of the eligible puppy. Futurity Entry Fees will also be paid prior to 2023 Sectional Futurity events** by the owner of the eligible puppy for each Sectional Futurity event in which the eligible puppy is entered. Final Forfeit Fees as well as Sectional Futurity Entry Fees are set by the ABC Board of Directors and subject to change.
- Beginning 1/1/2020, all litter nominations will be acknowledged via both email and written notification sent**

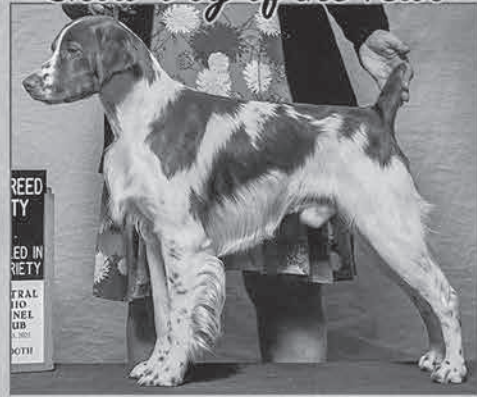

AKC Delegate Meeting Minutes

March 7 & 8, 2022

The AKC Delegate meeting was held in Newark, NJ on March 7 & 8, 2022.

The report of the committees and the President of AKC for this meeting was that registration is greater than 800,000, which is the most since 2008. Litter registrations are up to greater than 300,000, which is the greatest since 2007. All sports are at or exceeding the number of events in the first quarter of 2021. 2021 was the second highest of number of events in AKC history.

AKC Reunite has a unique program for clubs to support communities by sponsoring a police dog. If a club raises \$200.00, Reunite will fund \$7500.00. To date 100 dogs have been funded for police departments in several communities.

Juniors with Canine Partners (American Dogs) program for Juniors to show in confirmation has been in effect since January. AKC is encouraging clubs to not opt out of that opportunity for Juniors.

AKC has provided \$25,000.00 to be donated to Equvent, a company that operates in Poland and Romania that will assist dogs from Ukraine. AKC is also selling T shirts in the AKC store and all proceeds go to helping Ukraine with the abandon pet program and shelters caring for those animals.

ABC needs to approve a Juniors Coordinator for our club. Anyone interested should contact Bob Rankin. We need to support our Brittany Juniors in all their endeavors.

Companion events showed an increase of 61% in Obedience, 31% in Agility, 57% in Rally and 15% in Tracking.

COVID provisions have been extended by AKC till the end of 2022.

Tripod dogs will be allowed to compete in obedience and rally events that do not require jumping. A group of veterinarians as well as obedience and rally judges were involved in a committee that made that decision based on the health and welfare of the animal.

Doug Lundgren explained to the Field Trail/Hunt Test Committee the ramifications of the dissolving of the American Field and the purchase by the UKC. He stated to the committee that the Britnany's will be the most affected since our breed has the most dual sanctioned events. No longer will the clubs be able to have the dual sanctioned events or be able to register dogs in both the AKC and the UKC. Talks are ongoing with the President of the ABC and Doug setting up new rules and championships and Regional events. Doug stated the talks are going well.

Twelve young contenders from around the country were invited to compete in the 6th running of the American Brittany Club Derby Invitational held Thursday, December 2, 2021, at the Blue Mountain-J. Perry Mikles WDA, Booneville, AR. Congratulations to all the dogs, their owners and handlers who earned the right to participate this year. Judges this year were Tom Milam and Dr. Robert Rankin who we thank for their time and thoughtful consideration of each of these fine young hopefuls. Thanks goes out to Purina for their continued support and for the Pro Plan dog food awarded to the winners and placers. This day's weather was mostly sunny and warm. It was dry with low humidity and unreliable variable winds making scenting conditions tenuous to say the least. Still this group of youngsters were eager and a pleasure to watch. The three contestants rising to the top were:

The Recognized: First place: Jowills Sweet Mandolin Music, "Manny". Second place was Sniksoh Sonic Boom, "Sonic". Third place went to Piney Run White Lightning, "Buzz".

The Running

Brace 1: Sniksoh "Sonic" Boom, Handler Bob Burchett, Owner: Dawn and Joe Droel and Dogwoods Quick Cate, Handler/Owner: Todd Paramenter. And so the games began at a coolish 8 am with Sonic and Cate breaking away in a joyful foot race before separating as the whistles to get to work overcame their glee. Sonic made a big circular

cast before rejoining the front at 10 where he settled into a fast forward application. Cate worked the front with a moderate 10 to 2 range making sure no logical objective went unchecked. At 26 birds were seen soaring above an excited Cate but no point had been observed. At 47 Sonic slammed on point before moving a small covey with acceptable derby manners. Both dogs continued their search and finished their hour with energy to spare. Sonic's solid all age performance earned him 2nd place.

Brace 2: Noble Southpaw, Handler: Steve Chang, Owner: J. Muljana and Jowills Sweet Madolin Music, "Manny", Handler/Owner: Joe Williams. After a little head-start by Manny's accidental escape before the official breakaway these two boys started putting it down fast and forward. Noble was a handful from the start and went missing early and never returned to judgment. When we caught up with Manny at 17 he was far to the front and had us leaning forward in the saddle watching his big forward intelligent casts as he made his way over Course 2 in his quest for birds. At 37 handler called point as Manny stood tall and tight in an overgrown strip on the left side of the road. Handler dismounted and moved in front of his dog before putting up a nice covey of birds with Manny staying mostly still through the flush and shot. There was no drama rounding him up and he continued his hour making impressive all age moves to the front as fresh as he started. Certainly an impressive well deserved 1st place performance.

Brace 3: Piney Run White Lightning 'Buzz', Handler: Scott

Johnson, Owner: John Chejne and Hi Knob Pancho, Handler: Bob Burchett; Owner: C. Compton. Buzz and Pancho were thinking birds from the get-go. Both dogs pointed with style at 3 but no birds could be produced. Pancho couldn't get it together after this nonevent and was picked up by handler at 28. Buzz exhibited intense focus, natural physical and mental ability throughout his strong fast forward race. Buzz was awarded a well-deserved 3rd place based solely on his superior ground efforts searching for birds.

Brace 4: Hehi Rambling Roscoe, Handler: Bob Burchett, Owner: T. Healey and Diamond Hill Big Bong, Handler/Owner: Lisa Pollack. A cool breeze was welcomed for this first afternoon brace even though the temperatures had risen into the high 70's. Roscoe and Bong took off enthusiastically each doing their own thing. Roscoe whirled on point at 13 as he was running briskly down the right-side tree line. As handler approached Roscoe dove in the cover sending a huge covey to flight with all in order. Both dogs made steady progress hunting hard when Bong locked up tight at 35 down a lateral tree line. Handler dismounted and began the bird search with Bong standing tall and tight until given the signal to relocate. Birds were still not produced so handler chose to ride hard to regain the front. Both dogs continued hunting though the heat took its toll on their ground efforts.

Brace 5: Black Creek Augustus, Handler: Chad Holman; Owners: Ed & Judy Graves and Sovereigns Indecent Exposure, "Flash",

Handler: Bob Burchett; Owners: Dawn & Joe Droel. Augustus scored early with a small covey find at 3. Sent forward he went to an unknown destination and retrieval device was requested at 30. Flash could not figure out which direction he wanted to run so handler picked him up at 22.

Brace 6: Wichita Hope, Handler: Scott Johnson; Owner: C. Roberds and 6b Sovereign's Sweeter Than Honey, "Clover", Handler/ Owners: Joe Droel & Dawn Droel. Hope and Clover broke away at the double gates on Course 2. The temperature had risen into the high 70's with no breeze left. These girls hunted hard but conditions were not in their favor and neither had bird contact.

Bits About Brittanys

The following stories and cartoons have been reprinted from a manuscript that was intended to become a published book. This work was titled "BITS ABOUT BRITTANIES" and was written by Clarence Goering from Newton, Kansas. Clarence bought his first Brittany in 1942 it was a male he named Marquette Allamuchy. He was very active with Brittanys from that point until the 1960's. Being an active, well-known breeder during that era his kennel "TRIUMPH BRITTANIES" was nationally sponsored by Ralston Purina feed company. A copy of this manuscript was assembled into book form and is on display at the Brittany Field Trial Hall of Fame museum in Grand Junction, TN.

Another Time, Another Day

We had just finished walking a field. It was getting close to quitting time. So when we got to the car which was parked on the road, we decided to call it a day. I put the dogs in the crate and we were putting our guns away when we heard a cock pheasant squawk in a soil bank patch just beside the road. I said, "Listen to that bird scolding us." I hadn't anymore than gotten the words out of my mouth when he squawked again. So I said, "Twice is enough. If he squawks again, I'm going out there and put an end to his squawking." So he obliged. I took Mitzie out of the crate and we had only walked a few steps when she went on point ahead of us. As we walked up to her the cock took off, but Borger, who had gone with me, dropped him with a fine shot. Mitzie retrieved the bird and we started back to the car. Mitzie made just a little circle and soon went on point on another bird. I told Borger, "You go over and get that one." As he came up to Mitzie he stopped, looked and called to me, "This bird is sitting here in plain sight." I answered, "Are you sit it isn't a dead bird?" He said, "No, he's alive." I said, "I'll have to see this, wait till I get over there before you flush him." When I got there, sure enough, the bird was sitting there as if he were frozen.

His head was high and his eyes looked as big as silver dollars. Upon seeing the bird, I realized that this would make a good picture, so I called the professional photographer who had been with us for the afternoon. He came over and took the picture which you have seen earlier in the pages of this book.

After he had taken the picture, I told Borger to get ready and I would flush the bird. As I walked up to the bird, he was set so tight that I could have bent over and picked him up. I stood there for a few seconds and then actually had to kick the bird to make him flush. Borger's shot connected and we had another bird. But we all said it was definitely time to end the day's hunt.

Other South Dakota Hunting Incidents

One year when we went to South Dakota, I took two of my Brittanys and a big German Short Haired Pointer I called Don with me. When we arrived at the Callies farm where we were to

stay and hunt, I wanted to let my dogs out of the car for a bit of exercise. So I asked Mr. (Lloyd) Callies where he would suggest I take the dogs to turn them loose. He told me to follow the lane along the end of the corn field and I would come to a 40 acre field of alfalfa. There I could let them run and they might even put up a pheasant or two.

We drove to the field and it was an ideal place to exercise dogs. After the dogs had run around for about 30 minutes, I called them in and was putting them in the car when about ten young pigs that weighed about 150 pounds each came walking out of the corn field. I had all the dogs in the care except Don and when he saw the pigs he took out after them. They didn't seem too scared, so Don picked out one of them and went to work on him.

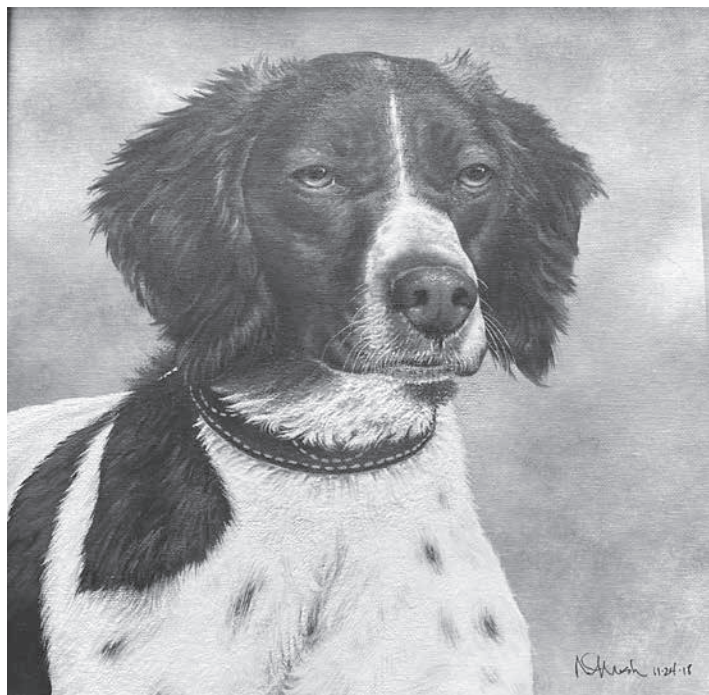
I don't know if Don thought he could retrieve the pig, but he grabbed it on the side of the neck and tried to bring it to me. Of course, he couldn't lift it and the pig was squealing something fierce. I ran over to try to get my hands on Don but just before I could catch him, he would turn loose only to let the pig run a few steps and then he would grab it again by the side of the neck or by an ear. Well, by the time I finally got my hands on Don, he had really slashed the pig's neck and ears. The injuries weren't too serious but that pig sure looked a sorry mess.

My buddies, laughing, thought that was some performance, but I said, "You guys can laugh, but I'm the one who has to go tell Lloyd that my dog chewed around on his pig. I can't think of a more likely way to lose a good hunting connection."

So that evening, as we were eating supper, I told Lloyd what had happened. I was expecting the worst, but when I finished by story, Lloyd began to laugh. Not a little giggle, but a big bell laugh. I was dumbfounded. Then Lloyd said, "Those aren't my pigs. They belong to my neighbor. I have told him several times to keep them penned up and out of my corn but he hasn't done anything about it. Now maybe the pigs will be scared to come back and won't be eating my corn." So we all had a good laugh and my dog Don was a hero in Lloyd's book.

It's Important

It's an usually mild sunny day the first week in February, temperatures in the mid-fifties and no snow. It's not really bird hunting season; however, the shooting preserve is open to its members until the middle of April. The grounds are often used year around to train our Brittanys. However, there are specific times when we use the facility to hunt birds.

Training and hunting are pursued according to weather conditions. Rain, sleet, snow, muddy and hot weather conditions limit those times to train. The same goes for when we hunt. This particular day in February definitely was important, a chance to get out from having been "cooped-up" in the cold freezing Western Pennsylvania winter weather. We currently only have one Brittany, a tri-color. She is a fourteen year old, to be later this year to be fifteen; she has a memorable life story. Glade Run Nutmeg (aka Meg), AKC FC, AmFld 3X Champion, AmFld 4X RunUp Champion, Winner Gun Dog Classic (2012); plus over the years most often during Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday seasons, hunted, pointed, and retrieved probably over 150 upland game birds – chukers, quail, and pheasant.

To digress, for a moment because it is important, looking back in time, our grandson, Ben, who had just turned twelve earlier in the year, was bird hunting with a family group the day after Thanksgiving. Meg, at that time was about one year old. Even at her young age, she had had significant exposure to quail, was pointing, but not steady; once the bird moved, she would flush and chase.

The hunt with Ben was to be at the above mentioned game preserve. Meg cast along a tree-line, stopped at one edge and pointed. She was on a twenty-foot lead, but not

restrained. She was about 50 yards away as we quickly moved into position. We could see the quail move, flushed and she chased; Ben did not shoot. "Papa, afraid I might hit Meg." Moving on, next bird pointed and flushed; she was restrained. Ben had his first bird – with many more to come.

Meg, as previously mentioned, with a focus on that particular day in February was ready to hunt. It was a Monday, temperatures predicted to be in the low 50's, no snow or rain; thus a good day to bird hunt. Last time Meg hunted was during Thanksgiving week, she just seemed to know this morning "we're going hunting". There was concern because she had had little conditioning since that festive holiday week, but she always let it be known when she "had enough". Early in the morning we were out the door and loaded into the truck with a couple of other hunting partners.

What's ever more significant was the fact that Meg was scenting, pointing, and retrieving them with just one visual eye. Two years ago she had a "small pea-sized" lump develop on her eyelid. The local Veterinarian removed the growth, which proved with pathology testing to be a "malignant melanoma". This tumor type has moderate to high potential for recurrence; recommendation was close observation for possible it to return.

A year ago in June the tumor was back, larger on the same eyelid. Recommendation was removal of the eyelid; because the eye cannot function without the cover, removal of the eye. The surgery took place in August; recovery was unbelievably positive; Meg hunted that Fall season. However, because the tumor was a malignant melanoma, it has reoccurred two more times with surgery following. Meg has recovered each time. This last surgery seems to have "taken a toll". She has not been eating well; thus, lost weight. Recently though eating has improved. She has an unbelievable desire to hunt. It's important to Meg; next few weeks she will be strong enough to start training for the upcoming hunting season.
