- Request information on status of Marv Nelson Fund.and withhold funding until we receive that information and a contact for the Foundation.
- \$25 of the National Entry fee currently going to Future Grounds Fund will now go into the general fund starting in 2010.
- Appoint a committee to establish a 501-C 3 foundation.
- Approved putting the \$500 donation to AKC PAC to the list of donations given on a yearly basis.
- Add to Code of Ethics the recommendation that Breeders will take back or handle the proper placement of any dog they have produced.
- Voted to no longer order futurity patches.
- Accepted Futurity Changes to Policy Book (see agenda report)
- Moved to suspend Policy Book pages on Magazine Policy until the Committee can make suggestions for changes to the BOD.
- Moved to donate \$3000 to Ionia Fence fund if that amt. is matched.
- Approved the Washington BC to host the 2013 Summer Specialty.
