Camping:

Points:

Points will be awarded to Brittanys placing in the Amateur Gun Dog stakes for the Northeast Amateur Gun Dog Trophy and to all placing dogs for the New Jersey Field Trial Dog of the Year for stakes open to all AKC pointing breeds.

Waiting List:

In the event your entry is put on a waiting list you will be notified by e-mail or phone if you include the information with the entry. You will automatically be drawn for the stake if entries allow, unless you notify the Field Trial Secretary before the drawing that you wish to cancel. It is your responsibility to contact the Field Trial Secretary to find out if your entry was drawn.

Directions

The English Setter Club is located on Route 541 between Lumberton and Medford. From the North, take the NJ Turnpike to Exit 5, turn right out of the exit and follow Rt 541 thru Lumberton. Watch for the English Setter Club driveway on the right immediately after the soccer field. From the West, take the Pennsylvania Turnpike east to the NJ Turnpike south, Exit 5, then see above. From the South, use I-295 or the NJ Turnpike. Take exit 4 from the Turnpike onto Rt 73 south, then east on Rt 70 (from I-295, exit at Rt 70). Follow Rt 70 east to Rt 541 (Medford) intersection and turn left onto Rt 541 north. The English Setter Club will be on your left side, just after the tack shop.
