

We are pleased to note that the Grand Open Limited All Age Stake (*Open All Age Championship*) is held in honor of long-time Michigan Brittany Championship Association member, Wade Haines. Wade is also an American Brittany Club Hall of Fame member.

All horses on the grounds need current coggins and health certificates.

NO WRANGLER WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR HORSE RENTALS

Dogs need a current rabies vaccination certificate.

STATE PARK PERMIT – The Michigan DNR require all vehicles on State grounds to display a Recreation Passport. These will be available for purchase at the grounds for \$18 (resident annual) or \$11/\$39 (daily/annual) for non-residents.

PARKING/CAMPING – Camping is permitted on Headquarter grounds. Only campers desiring electricity should park in the area with electrical outlets. Camping fees, with electricity (\$20 per day), without electricity (\$15 per day) are paid directly to the Michigan Brittany Championship Association. There is no parking anywhere along the park service road or highway. Use designated parking lots only. Park perpendicular to posts in the Headquarters Parking Lot. There is no parking in the middle of the lot.

COURSES & BIRDS

Multiple courses without bird field. Native and/or released quail.

Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes. Horses will not be provided by the Michigan Brittany Championship or American Brittany Club.

Firearms: .32 caliber blanks or larger must be used and only manufactured solid barrel firearms, with blank shells or crimps, which prevent a projectile of any kind from leaving the barrel, permitted. .22 caliber blanks pistols may be used in the Open Derby.

Tracking Collars permitted in accordance with AKC guidelines, however not supplied by the Michigan Brittany Championship or the American Brittany Club.

PRIZES

Standard AKC Rosettes to all placed dogs; Trophies to Winners and Runner-ups in Grand Open Limited All Age and Grand Open Limited Gun Dog stakes.

Guaranteed purse, subject to reduction
